- Title of Incident: PRISON BREAK/ARMED ATTACK
- Scale of incident: Low
- Date of Occurrence: 12/9/2021
- Description of Incident: Two (2) security operatives were reportedly killed in an attack carried out by unidentified armed gang at Kabba Medium Security Correctional Centre in Kabba/Bunu LGA of Kogi State. 240 inmates at the correctional facility reportedly escaped during the attack while two (2) officers of the Nigeria Correctional Service (NCoS) have been declared missing in the incident. Preliminary investigations have revealed that the attackers used explosives to destroy the perimeter fence in a bid to gain access to the facility.
- Location: Kabba/Bunu LGA of Kogi State.
- Casualty [Male & female]: Two males killed, two males missing, 240 inmates escaped
- Property damaged/Affected population: Several prison properties destroyed/inmates and prison security
- Coping Mechanism/Responses: The Crisis Response Centre have been activated and a Special Taskforce have been mobilized to recapture the escaped inmates. Also, 114 inmates have returned to the prison while security operatives are in search of 126 inmates.1

Incident N*02:

- Title of Incident: ARREST OF SUSPECTED INTERNET FRAUDSTERS
- Scale of incident: Low
- Date of Occurrence: 12/9/2021
- Description of Incident: The operatives of the Economic and Financial Crimes Commission (EFCC) reportedly arrested thirty-one (31) suspected internet fraudsters at two separate locations in Benin City area of Edo State. Thirteen (13) vehicles, laptops, phones, and several documents were reportedly recovered in the incident.
- Location: Benin City area in Edo State.
- **Casualty [Male & female]:** No casualty reported, thirty-one males arrested.
- Property damaged/Affected population: No property damaged/suspected internet fraudsters. 4
- Coping Mechanism/Responses: The suspects are in the custody of the EFCC for further interrogation.

- Title of Incident: ARMED ATTACK BY SUSPECTED FULANI MILITIA HERDERS
- Scale of incident: Medium
- Date of Occurrence: 12/9/2021
- Description of Incident: Eleven (11) people were reportedly killed and two (2) others injured in an attack carried out by suspected Fulani militia herders at Apiyejim-Kibori Community in Atyap Chiefdom, Zangon Kataf LGA of Kaduna State. Several people have been declared missing in the incident. Attacks by suspected militia herders remains prevalent in the State.
- Location: Apiyejim-Kibori Community in Atyap Chiefdom, Zangon Kataf LGA of Kaduna State.
- Casualty [Male & female]: Eleven people (6 females and 5 males) killed, two people injured.
- Property damaged/Affected population: No property damaged/community members. 4
- Coping Mechanism/Responses: The injured victims have been taken to the hospital for medical treatment.

- Date of Occurrence: 12/9/2021
- **◆ Description of Incident:** Four (4) commuters were reportedly abducted in an attack carried out by suspected kidnappers along Ayetoro Ekiti-Otun Ekiti Road in Moba LGA of Ekiti State. Kidnapping for ransom has largely been attributed as the motive behind the criminality in the State.
- Location: Ayetoro Ekiti-Otun Ekiti Road in Moba LGA of Ekiti State.
- Casualty [Male & female]: Four people abducted.
- **♣ Property damaged/Affected population:** No property damaged/commuters.
- **Coping Mechanism/Responses:** The operatives of security agencies and local hunters have been deployed to rescue the victims.

Incident N*05:

- Title of Incident: ARMED ATTACK BY SUSPECTED HOODLUMS
- **Scale of incident:** Low
- **Date of Occurrence:** 12/9/2021
- **Description of Incident:** Nine (9) members of The Osun Progressives (TOP), a caucus within the All Progressive Congress (APC) were reportedly injured in an attack carried out by suspected hoodlums at Oke Atan Area in IIe-Ife axis in Osun State. Preliminary investigations have revealed that the hoodlums were linked to an APC chieftain in Okerewe Ward 2 in the State. The motive behind the attack is unknown.
- Location: Oke Atan Area in Ile-Ife axis in Osun State.
- Casualty [Male & female]: Nine males injured.
- **Property damaged/Affected population:** No property damaged/members of the TOP.
- **Coping Mechanism/Responses:** The State Police Command has commenced investigations to apprehend the perpetrators of the crime. Also, the injured victims have been taken to the hospital for medical treatment.

Incident N*06:

- **4** Title of Incident: MURDER
- **Scale of incident:** Low
- **↓ Date of Occurrence:** 12/9/2021
- ▶ **Description of Incident:** A male resident was reportedly stabbed to death by another male resident following a fight at a drinking joint in Ifon town in Orolu LGA of Osun State. Preliminary investigations have revealed that the suspect who sold locally brewed liquor at the bar stabbed his customer to death. The reason behind the attack is unknown.
- Location: Ifon town in Orolu LGA of Osun State.
- Property damaged/Affected population: No property damaged/community resident.
- Coping Mechanism/Responses: The suspect is at the custody of the State Police Command for further interrogation.

Incident N*07:

- **4** Title of Incident: ARREST OF SUSPECTED INTERNET FRAUDSTERS
- **Scale of incident:** Low
- Date of Occurrence: 13/9/2021
- ♣ Description of Incident: The operatives of the Economic and Financial Crimes Commission (EFCC) reportedly arrested fifty-six (56) suspected internet fraudsters during a security raid at several locations in Abeokuta axis in Ogun State. Preliminary investigations have revealed that the suspect slapped the victim who slumped and died.
- Location: Garin Alimi/Asa Dam area in Ilorin West LGA of Kwara State.
- Casualty [Male & female]: One male killed.
- **Property damaged/Affected population:** No property damaged/tricycle operator, suspected murderer.
- Coping Mechanism/Responses: The suspect is at the custody of the State Police Command for further investigation.

Preliminary investigations have revealed that suspect who is the son of the landlord hit the victim (tenant) with a plank during a fight for insulting his father.

- **♣ Property damaged/Affected population:** No property damaged/community residents.
- Coping Mechanism/Responses: The suspect is at the custody of the State Police Command for further investigation.

Preliminary investigations have revealed that suspected armed bandits fleeing their enclaves have been attacking communities in the LGA.
- Location: Zurmi LGA of Zamfara State.
- Casualty [Male & female]: No casualty reported.
- **Property damaged/Affected population:** Several houses and properties burnt down/community residents.
- **Coping Mechanism/Responses:** There is an ongoing security clearance operation to counter armed bandits' attacks in the State.

- **Description of Incident:** Three (3) people (including a chieftain of the People's Democratic Party-PDP) were reportedly abducted in an attack carried out by suspected armed gang along Benin-Agbor highway in Edo State. Kidnapping for ransom has largely been attributed as the motive behind the criminality in the State.
- Location: Benin-Agbor highway in Edo State.
- Casualty [Male & female]: Three people abducted.

- Property damaged/Affected population: A bus and tricycle burnt down/commuters and tricycle riders.
- Coping Mechanism/Responses: The operatives of security agencies have been deployed to the affected areaS to disperse suspected IPOB members and to maintain peace and security.

- **4** Title of Incident: THREAT/ARSON BY SUSPECTED INDIGENOUS PEOPLE OF BIAFRA (IPOB)
- Scale of incident: Low
- Date of Occurrence: 13/9/2021
- **Description of Incident:** Hoodlums suspected to be members of the Indigenous People of Biafra (IPOB) reportedly prevented students from writing English Language paper in the ongoing West African School Certificate Examination (WASSCE) being written by senior secondary school students at the Comprehensive Secondary School in Nkume axis in Njaba LGA of Imo State. The attackers reportedly set ablaze several motorcycles belonging to staff members and students of the school in the incident.
- **Location:** Nkume axis in Njaba LGA of Imo State.
- **Casualty [Male & female]:** No casualty.
- Property damaged/Affected population: Several motorcycles set ablaze/students and teachers.
- **Coping Mechanism/Responses:** No reported intervention.
