Incident N*01:

- Title of Incident: ARSON
- Scale of incident: Low
- **♣ Date of Occurrence:** 22/8/2021
- Description of Incident: Aggrieved students of Government Secondary School in Tse-Agberagba Community in Konshisha LGA of Benue State reportedly set their school ablaze over the failure of the school management to register them for the 2021 West African Senior Certificate Examination (WASSCE) in the State. Preliminary investigations have revealed that the school's registration was cancelled because the school did not have enough computers to cover the number of registered students for the examination.
- **Location:** Tse-Agberagba Community in Konshisha LGA of Benue State.
- Casualty [Male & female]: No casualty reported.
- Property damaged/Affected population: Several valuables, documents and properties burnt down/students and teachers.
- **Coping Mechanism/Responses:** The State Police Command has commenced further investigations into the incident.

Incident N*02:

- **Title of Incident: PHYSICAL ASSAULT**
- Scale of incident: Low
- **Date of Occurrence:** 22/8/2021
- **Description of Incident:** One (1) person was reportedly injured with machete in an attack carried out by a community resident at Zazika Village in Birnin-Kudu LGA of Jigawa State. The motive behind the attack is unknown.
- Location: Zazika Village in Birnin-Kudu LGA of Jigawa State.
- Casualty [Male & female]: One male injured.
- Property damaged/Affected population: No property damaged/community resident.
- **Coping Mechanism/Responses:** The injured victim has been taken to the hospital for medical treatment. Also, the State Police Command has arrested the suspect in connection with the crime while investigations have commenced to ascertain the cause of the attack.

Incident N*03:

- **Title of Incident: ARMED ATTACK/ABDUCTION BY SUSPECTED ARMED BANDITS**
- **Scale of incident:** Medium
- **Date of Occurrence:** 22/8/2021
- **Description of Incident:** Eight (8) people were allegedly killed with fifty (50) others abducted in an attack carried out by suspected armed bandits in Goran Namaye Town in Maradun LGA of Zamfara State. Attacks by suspected armed bandits continues unabated in Zamfara State.
- Location: Goran Namaye Town in Maradun LGA of Zamfara State.
- **Casualty [Male & female]:** Eight people killed, fifty people abducted.
- **Property damaged/Affected population:** No property damaged/community residents.
- **Coping Mechanism/Responses:** The operatives of the security agencies have been deployed to rescue the abducted victims and to maintain peace and security in the affected community.

Title of Incident: ARREST/DRUG TRAFFICKING

Scale of incident: MediumDate of Occurrence: 22/8/2021

- **Description of Incident:** The operatives of the National Drug Law Enforcement Agency (NDLEA) reportedly arrested four (4) trans-border drug traffickers with packs of Tramadol concealed in noodles carton recovered at Kolere Village in Mubi North LGA of Adamawa State. The suspects were arrested while attempting to cross over the Nigerian land border with Cameroun on a motorcycle.
- **Location:** Kolere Village in Mubi North LGA of Adamawa State.
- **Casualty [Male & female]:** No reported casualty, four suspected drug traffickers arrested.
- Property damaged/Affected population: No property damaged/suspected drug traffickers.
- **Coping Mechanism/Responses:** The suspects are in the custody of the NDLEA for further interrogation.

Incident N*05:

- **♣ Title of Incident: ARMED ATTACK BY SUSPECTED FULANI MILITIA GANG**
- **♣ Scale of incident:** Medium
- Date of Occurrence: 22/8/2021
- Description of Incident: Nine (9) people (including five females) were reportedly killed and one (1) female injured in an attack by gunmen suspected Fulani militia gang at Ungwan Dooh (Mado) Village of Zangon Kataf LGA of Kaduna State. Several properties were reportedly destroyed in the incident.
- Location: Ungwan Dooh (Mado) Village of Zangon Kataf LGA of Kaduna State.
- **Casualty [Male & female]:** Nine people (5 females and 4 males) killed, one female injured.
- **Property damaged/Affected population:** Several properties destroyed/community residents.
- **↓ Coping Mechanism/Responses:** The operatives of security agencies have been deployed to affected Village to maintain peace and security while in trail of perpetrators of the crime.

Incident N*06:

- **Title of Incident: ARSON/ARMED ATTACK**
- Scale of incident: Low
- **Date of Occurrence:** 22/8/2021
- **Description of Incident:** Two (2) people (including a female) were reportedly killed in an attack carried out by unidentified armed gang at a Fulani settlement in Kankada area in Madakiya District in Bajju Chiefdom of Zangon Kataf LGA of Kaduna State. The attackers also burnt down several houses in the community. Preliminary investigations have revealed that the attack on the ethnic Fulani settlement was in reprisal for the killing of community residents in Ungwan Dooh village in the LGA by gunmen suspected to be ethnic Fulani militia.
- **Location:** Kankada area in Madakiya District in Bajju Chiefdom of Zangon Kataf LGA of Kaduna State.
- Casualty [Male & female]: Two people (1 male, 1 female) killed.
- Property damaged/Affected population: Several houses burnt down/community residents.
- **Coping Mechanism/Responses:** The operatives of security agencies have been deployed to maintain peace and security in the affected areas.

Incident N*08:

- **Title of Incident: ARMED ATTACK BY SUSPECTED GUNMEN**
- Scale of incident: Low
- **Date of Occurrence:** 22/8/2021
- Description of Incident: Three (3) herders were reportedly killed and four (4) others injured in an attack carried out by suspected armed gang at Ribok, Tsoriyang and Kankada areas in Zangon Kataf LGA of Kaduna State. The attackers reportedly destroyed and burnt down one vehicle, three (3) houses and eight (8) herders' huts in the incident. Preliminary investigations have revealed that the attack was a reprisal for the killing of residents at Ungwan Dooh Village in the LGA.
- **Location:** Ribok, Tsoriyang and Kankada areas in Zangon Kataf LGA of Kaduna State.
- **Casualty [Male & female]:** Three herders killed, four people injured.
- Property damaged/Affected population: One vehicle, three houses and eight huts burnt down and destroyed/community residents and herders.
- **Coping Mechanism/Responses:** The operatives of security agencies have been deployed to the affected areas to maintain peace and security.

Incident N*09:

- **Title of Incident: RESCUE OF ABDUCTED VICTIMS**
- **Scale of incident:** Low
- **Date of Occurrence:** 23/8/2021
- **Description of Incident:** Two (2) abducted children were reportedly rescued in Benin-City, Edo State by operatives of the State Police Command. Preliminary investigations have revealed that the abducted children aged 2 and 4 years old were abducted at their residence in Surulere LGA of Lagos State.
- **Location:** Benin-City in Edo State.
- **Casualty [Male & female]:** Two abducted victims rescued.
- **Property damaged/Affected population:** No property damaged/community children.
- **Coping Mechanism/Responses:** The State Police Command has arrested three (3) suspects in connection with the crime.

Incident N*10:

- **4** Title of Incident: ARREST OF SUSPECTED ARMED ROBBER
- Scale of incident: Low
- **♣ Date of Occurrence:** 23/8/2021
- Description of Incident: The operatives of the State Police Command reportedly arrested a suspected armed robber with a locally-made pistol and ammunition recovered during security patrol at Akaba Community in Yenagoa LGA of Bayelsa State.
- Location: Akaba Community in Yenagoa LGA of Bayelsa State.
- Casualty [Male & female]: No casualty reported, one male arrested.
- **Property damaged/Affected population:** No property damaged/suspected armed robber.

- Date of Occurrence: 23/8/2021
- Description of Incident: Suspected armed bandits reportedly attacked a team of security officials escorting travellers from Gusau to Dansadau Town in Maru LGA of Zamfara State. Several people were reportedly injured in the incident. The attackers reportedly set ablaze a fuel tanker in the convoy to sabotage the supply of fuel to Dansadau Town in the State. Dansadau Town is one of the communities worst hit by armed banditry in Zamfara State.
- Location: Dansadau Town in Maru LGA of Zamfara State.
- Casualty [Male & female]: Several people injured.
- **Property damaged/Affected population:** Several vehicles vandalized/commuters.
- Coping Mechanism/Responses: The attack was repelled by security operatives in the incident.

Incident N*12:

- Title of Incident: ARMED ACTION/SHOOT-OUT BETWEEN SECURITY OPERATIVES AND SUSPECTED **GUNRUNNERS**
- Scale of incident: Medium
- Date of Occurrence: 23/8/2021
- Description of Incident: Six (6) suspected gunrunners were reportedly killed with several others injured during a joint-security clearance operation at Kwoi Village in Mangu LGA of Plateau State. The shoot-out incident also resulted in the death of two (2) security officers (including a police operative and a local vigilante member) in the incident. Several arms and ammunition were reportedly recovered in the incident.
- Location: Kwoi Village in Mangu LGA of Plateau State.
- Casualty [Male & female]: Eight people (including 2 security operatives and 6 suspected gunrunners) killed, several others injured.
- Property damaged/Affected population: No property damaged, arms and ammunition recovered/suspected gunrunners and security operatives.
- Coping Mechanism/Responses: The operatives of security agencies have commenced investigations to apprehend other members of the syndicate gang.

Incident N*13:

- Title of Incident: SHOOTING 4
- Scale of incident: Low
- Date of Occurrence: 23/8/2021
- Description of Incident: A commercial driver was reportedly killed by a local vigilante member at Onitsha axis in Anambra State. Preliminary investigations have revealed that the victim was killed following an argument over bribe to the vigilante member in the incident.
- **Location:** Onitsha axis in Anambra State.
- Casualty [Male & female]: One male killed.
- **Property damaged/Affected population:** No property damaged/commercial driver.
- Coping Mechanism/Responses: The State Police Command has commenced investigations to ascertain the cause of the shooting.

The attack was also repelled by military operatives resulting in the death of four (4) members of the terrorist groups. Several arms and ammunition were reportedly recovered in the incident.
- **Location:** Gambari axis along Lake Chad in Borno State.
- Casualty [Male & female]: One military officer injured, four suspected Boko Haram/ISWAP members killed
- Property damaged/Affected population: Arms and ammunition recovered/military officer and suspected Boko Haram/ISWAP members.
- **Coping Mechanism/Responses:** There is an ongoing security clearance operation to counter terrorist attacks in the State.

- **Location:** Kono-Boue and Gwara Communities in Khana LGA of Rivers State.
- Casualty [Male & female]: Six people killed.
- **Property damaged/Affected population:** No property damaged/community residents.

- **Location:** Tafatafa Village in Asa LGA of Kwara State.
- Casualty [Male & female]: Three people (2 males and 1 female) abducted.

- Coping Mechanism/Responses: The State Police Command has commenced investigations to apprehend the perpetrator of the crime.

- Title of Incident: RESCUE OPERATIONS BY THE NIGERIAN ARMY
- Scale of incident: Low
- Date of Occurrence: 23/8/2021
- Description of Incident: The operatives of the Nigeria Army reportedly rescued fifteen (15) people allegedly abducted by suspected armed bandits at Jagindi village in Jema'a LGA of Kaduna State. Preliminary investigations have revealed that the rescued victims were travelling in two separate vehicles when they were intercepted by armed bandits along the road.
- Location: Jagindi village in Jema'a LGA of Kaduna State.
- Casualty [Male & female]: No casualty reported, fifteen people (14 males and 1 female) abducted and rescued.
- **Property damaged/Affected population:** No property damaged/community residents.

- Location: Nigerian Defence Academy at Afaka axis in Igabi LGA of Kaduna State.
- Casualty [Male & female]: Two military officers killed, one military officer injured, one military officer abducted.
- **Property damaged/Affected population:** No property damaged/military operatives.
- Coping Mechanism/Responses: The operatives of the Nigerian Army have commenced investigations to apprehend the perpetrators of the crime and to rescue the abducted victim.

- **Date of Occurrence:** 24/8/2021
- Description of Incident: A landlord was reportedly stoned to death by his tenant at Ozoro Community in Isoko North LGA of Delta State. Preliminary investigations have revealed that the victim was hit with a stone following a misunderstanding with the tenant over electricity bills.
- Location: Ozoro Community in Isoko North LGA of Delta State.
- Casualty [Male & female]: One male killed.
- **Property damaged/Affected population:** No property damaged/Landlord.
- Coping Mechanism/Responses: The operatives of the State Police Command have arrested the suspect in connection with the crime.
