- Title of Incident: ARMED ATTACK/ABDUCTION
- Scale of incident: Low
- **Date of Occurrence:** 19/9/2021
- Description of Incident: One (1) person was allegedly killed and three (3) others abducted in an attack carried out by suspected armed gang at the premises of the ECWA Church in Okedayo-Kabba, Kabba/Bunu LGA of Kogi State. Several people were reportedly injured in the attack. The motive behind the attack is unknown.
- Location: Okedayo-Kabba in Kabba/Bunu LGA of Kogi State.
- **Casualty [Male & female]:** One male killed, several people injured, three males abducted.
- **Property damaged/Affected population:** No property damaged/Christian worshippers.
- Coping Mechanism/Responses: The operatives of security agencies have been deployed to apprehend the perpetrators of the crime.

### Incident N\*02:

- **4** Title of Incident: PHYSICAL ASSAULT/THREAT BY SUSPECTED HOODLUMS
- Scale of incident: Low
- **Date of Occurrence:** 19/9/2021
- Description of Incident: Suspected hoodlums reportedly invaded the venue of a political party meeting at the Enugu West Senatorial District in Enugu State and assaulted several people with several vehicles destroyed in the incident. The attackers also threatened that no election will be held in the South-East Region of Nigeria.
- Location: Enugu State.
- **Casualty [Male & female]:** Several people injured.
- Property damaged/Affected population: Several vehicles destroyed/political party members in the State.
- Coping Mechanism/Responses: The State Police Command has commenced investigations to apprehend the perpetrators of the crime.

### Incident N\*03:

### **Title of Incident: ARSON BY UNIDENTIFIED ARMED GANG**

- **Scale of incident:** Low
- **Date of Occurrence:** 19/9/2021
- Description of Incident: The office of the Independent National Electoral Commission (INEC) in Awgu LGA of Enugu State was reportedly set ablaze by unidentified armed gang. The motive behind the attack and the identity of the attackers is unknown.
- Location: Awgu LGA of Enugu State.
- **Casualty [Male & female]:** No casualty reported.
- **Property damaged/Affected population:** INEC office building set ablaze/electoral officers.
- Coping Mechanism/Responses: The officials of the State Fire Service in collaboration with security agencies were deployed to douse the fire. Also, the State Police Command has commenced investigations to apprehend the perpetrators of the crime.

- **Title of Incident: ARMED ATTACK**
- Scale of incident: Low
- **Date of Occurrence:** 19/9/2021

- Description of Incident: Three (3) police officers were reportedly killed and two (2) other police operatives injured in an attack carried out by unidentified armed gang at a security check-point along Ukaegbu/Ezeiweka road in Onitsha, Anambra State. A patrol vehicle was also burnt down in the incident.
- Location: Ukaegbu/Ezeiweka road in Onitsha, Anambra State.
- Casualty [Male & female]: Three males killed, two males injured.
- **Property damaged/Affected population:** One vehicle burnt/ police operatives.
- Coping Mechanism/Responses: The State Police Command has commenced investigations to apprehend the perpetrators of the crime.

### Incident N\*05:

- **Title of Incident: ARMED ATTACK/MOB VIOLENCE**
- Scale of incident: Low
- **Date of Occurrence:** 19/9/2021
- Description of Incident: Community residents reportedly burnt to death eight (8) criminal suspects following the abduction and killing of two (2) male residents in Isoko Community of Delta State.
- Location: Isoko Community in Delta State.
- Casualty [Male & female]: Eight males killed.
- Property damaged/Affected population: No property destroyed/community residents and suspected kidnappers.
- Coping Mechanism/Responses: The State Police Command has commenced investigations to apprehend the perpetrators of the crime.

### Incident N\*06:

- **4** Title of Incident: RIVAL CULT CLASH/ARREST OF SUSPECTED CULT MEMBERS
- Scale of incident: Low
- Date of Occurrence: 19/9/2021
- Description of Incident: The operatives of the State Police Command reportedly arrested fifteen (15) suspected cult members following a violent clash between suspected cult gangs at Mushin axis in Mushin LGA of Lagos State. Preliminary investigations have revealed that the suspected cult members also stole several valuables from community residents and traders during the clash.
- **Location:** Mushin axis in Mushin LGA of Lagos State.
- **Casualty [Male & female]:** No casualty reported, fifteen males arrested.
- Property damaged/Affected population: Several valuables stolen/community residents, traders, and suspected cult members.
- Coping Mechanism/Responses: The suspects are in the custody of the State Police Command for further investigation.

### Incident N\*07:

- **4** Title of Incident: MOB ACTION/VIOLENT DEMONSTRATION BY COMMUNITY YOUTHS
- Scale of incident: Low
- Date of Occurrence: 19/9/2021
- Description of Incident: Two (2) males (including a youth and pastor) were reportedly killed during a violent demonstration conducted by community youths in Ebyia Unuhu, Abakaliki LGA of Ebonyi State. Two (2) houses were also reportedly burnt down with a hotel destroyed in the incident. The community youths went on rampage following the death of a community resident who died in the custody of the State Security Outfit 'Ebubeagu' in the State.

Preliminary investigations have revealed that the pastor was hit by stray bullets fired by security operatives deployed to disperse the irate youths while the other victim was beaten to death by the irate youths.

- Location: Ebyia Unuhu Community in Abakaliki LGA of Ebonyi State.
- **Casualty [Male & female]:** Two males killed.
- Property damaged/Affected population: Two buildings burnt/community residents and a Christian cleric.

- **Title of Incident: ARREST OF SUSPECTED INTERNET FRAUDSTERS**
- **Scale of incident:** Low
- **Date of Occurrence:** 19/9/2021
- Description of Incident: The officials of the Economic and Financial Crimes Commission (EFCC) reportedly arrested thirty (30) suspected internet fraudsters during a security raid in Malete campus at the Kwara State University in Moro LGA of Kwara State. Six (6) vehicles, laptops, mobile phones were recovered from the suspects in the incident.
- **Location:** Malete campus at the Kwara State University in Moro LGA of Kwara State.
- **Casualty [Male & female]:** No casualty reported, thirty males arrested.
- **Property damaged/Affected population:** No property damaged/suspected internet fraudsters.
- **Coping Mechanism/Responses:** The suspects are in the custody of the EFCC for further interrogation.

### Incident N\*09:

- **4** Title of Incident: ABDUCTION/ARREST
- Scale of incident: Low
- **Date of Occurrence:** 19/9/2021
- Description of Incident: Two (2) including a male and female were reportedly abducted in an attack carried out by suspected armed gang along the Ilasa-Ayebode Road in Ekiti East LGA of Ekiti State. Kidnapping for ransom has largely been attributed as the motive behind the criminality in the State.
- Location: Ilasa-Ayebode Road in Ekiti East LGA of Ekiti State.
- **Casualty [Male & female]:** Two people (1 male and 1 female) abducted.
- Property damaged/Affected population: No property damaged/commuters.
- Coping Mechanism/Responses: The State Police Command has arrested three (3) suspects in connection with the crime. Also, the abducted victims have been released by the kidnappers after the payment of an undisclosed ransom.

### Incident N\*10:

- **Title of Incident: ARMED ROBBERY**
- Scale of incident: Low
- **Date of Occurrence:** 19/9/2021
- Description of Incident: A community resident was reportedly stabbed to death and one (1) other injured in an attack carried out by suspected armed robbers in separate incidents at Sharada and Panshekara Quarters in Kumbotso LGA of Kano State. The attackers also stole the victims' mobile phones in the incident.
- Location: Sharada and Panshekara Quarters in Kumbotso LGA of Kano State.
- **Casualty [Male & female]:** One male killed, one male injured.
- Property damaged/Affected population: No property damaged/community residents and suspected armed robbers.
- Coping Mechanism/Responses: The injured victim has been taken to the hospital for medical treatment. Also, the State Police Command has arrested three (3) suspects in connection with the crime.

### Incident N\*11:

- **4** Title of Incident: ARMED ATTACK BY SUSPECTED ARMED BANDITS
- **Scale of incident:** Low
- **Date of Occurrence:** 19/9/2021
- Description of Incident: Six (6) people were allegedly killed in an attack carried out by suspected armed bandits at Saminaka Village in Tangaza LGA of Sokoto State. Armed attacks by suspected armed bandits remains prevalent in the State.
- Location: Saminaka Village in Tangaza LGA of Sokoto State.

- Scale of incident: Low
- **Date of Occurrence:** 19/9/2021
- Description of Incident: Three (3) people (including a pregnant woman) were reportedly abducted in an attack carried out by gunmen suspected to be herders along Igbo Ora-Sokoto Road in Abeokuta North LGA of Ogun State. Kidnapping for ransom has largely been attributed as the motive behind the criminality in the State.
- Location: Igbo Ora-Sokoto Road in Abeokuta North LGA of Ogun State.
- **Casualty [Male & female]:** Three people (2 females and 1 male) abducted.
- **Property damaged/Affected population:** No property damaged/commuters.
- Coping Mechanism/Responses: The operatives of the State Police Command have been deployed to rescue the abducted victims.

### Incident N\*13:

- **4** Title of Incident: MOB ATTACK
- Scale of incident: Low
- **Date of Occurrence:** 20/9/2021
- Description of Incident: A Christian clergy was reportedly beaten to death in an attack carried out by community residents at Masu Community in Sumaila LGA of Kano State. The attackers also burnt down his house, church and school in the incident. Preliminary investigations have revealed that community youths targeted the cleric after a resident who converted to Christianity killed his brother in the area.
- **Location:** Masu Community in Sumaila LGA of Kano State.
- Casualty [Male & female]: One male killed.
- Property damaged/Affected population: A house, church and school burnt down/Christain cleric.
- Coping Mechanism/Responses: The state chapter of the Christian Association of Nigeria (CAN) has petitioned the Kano State Governor, Abdullahi Ganduje, demanding the immediate arrest and prosecution of the perpetrators of the act.

### Incident N\*14:

- **4** Title of Incident: SHOOTING BY POLICE OPERATIVES/DEMONSTRATION BY CONSTRUCTION WORKERS
- **Scale of incident:** Low
- **Date of Occurrence:** 20/9/2021
- Description of Incident: One (1) person was reportedly killed and four (4) others injured by gunshots fired by police operatives following the dispute between a construction company 'Julius Berger' and some construction workers at Gokana LGA of Rivers State. Preliminary investigations have revealed that the construction workers had conducted a peaceful protest to Gokana LGA over an alleged ill-treatment by the company in the State. However, the State Police Command has refuted claims that police operatives shot at the protesters.
- Location: Gokana LGA of Rivers State
- **Casualty [Male & female]:** One male killed, four males injured.
- **Property damaged/Affected population:** No property damaged/construction workers.
- **Coping Mechanism/Responses:** The Chairman of Gokana LGA has called on the State Police Command to carry out investigation into the shooting incident.

- **Title of Incident: MOB VIOLENCE**
- Scale of incident: Low
- **Date of Occurrence:** 20/9/2021

- **Casualty [Male & female]:** One male killed.
- **Property damaged/Affected population:** No property damaged/suspected IPOB member and angry traders.
- Coping Mechanism/Responses: The State Police Command has commenced investigations to apprehend the perpetrators of the crime.

### Incident N\*16:

- Title of Incident: MURDER
- Scale of incident: Low
- **Date of Occurrence:** 20/9/2021
- Description of Incident: A female resident was reportedly killed on her farm in an attack carried out by unidentified persons at Tafawa Balewa LGA of Bauchi State. The motive behind the attack is unknown.
- Location: Tafawa Balewa LGA of Bauchi State.
- **Casualty [Male & female]:** One female killed.
- Property damaged/Affected population: No property damaged/female resident.
- Coping Mechanism/Responses: The operatives of the State Police have arrested four (4) suspects in connection with the crime for further investigation.

### Incident N\*17:

- Title of Incident: ARREST OF SUSPECTED PIPELINE VANDALS
- Scale of incident: Low
- **Date of Occurrence:** 20/9/2021
- Description of Incident: The operatives of the Nigeria Navy reportedly arrested two (2) suspected pipeline vandals' during a security patrol along Effiat creek in Ibaka, Mbo LGA of Akwa Ibom State. Twenty (20) drums of petroleum products were recovered in the incident.
- Location: Effiat creek in Ibaka, Mbo LGA of Akwa Ibom State.
- **Casualty [Male & female]:** No casualty reported, two males arrested.
- Property damaged/Affected population: No property damaged/suspected pipeline vandals.
- Coping Mechanism/Responses: The arrested suspects are in the custody of the Economic and Financial Crimes Commission (EFCC) for further investigation.

- **4** Title of Incident: ARMED ACTION BY SECURITY OPERATIVES.
- Scale of incident: High
- 4 Date of Occurrence: 20/9/2021
- Description of Incident: The joint military-police operation reportedly killed forty-two (42) suspected armed bandits with several motorcycles and herds of cattle recovered during a security raid at Manganda junction in Shiroro LGA of Niger State. A military officer was allegedly killed with several security operatives injured in the incident.
- **Location:** Manganda junction in Shiroro LGA of Niger State.
- Casualty [Male & female]: Forty-two suspected armed bandits killed, one military officer killed, several security operatives injured.
- Property damaged/Affected population: No property damaged, several motorcycles and herds of cattle recovered/security operatives and suspected armed bandits.
- Coping Mechanism/Responses: There is an ongoing security clearance operation to counter armed bandits' attack in the State.

- **4** Title of Incident: SHUT DOWN OF TELECOMMUNICATION NETWORKS IN SOKOTO STATE
- Scale of incident: Low
- Date of Occurrence: 20/9/2021
- Description of Incident: The Sokoto State Government has shut down telecommunication networks in 14 of the 23 Local Government Areas (LGAs) of the State, as part of efforts to checkmate armed banditry. The affected LGAs include Dange Shuni, Tambuwal, Sabon Birni, Raba, Tureta, Goronyo, Tangaza and Isa LGA's, amongst others in the State<sup>1</sup>.
- **Location:** Sokoto State.
- **Casualty [Male & female]:** No casualty.
- Property damaged/Affected population: No property damaged/community residents.
- Coping Mechanism/Responses: There is an ongoing security clearance operation to counter armed bandits' attacks in the State.

### Incident N\*20:

- **Title of Incident: ARMED ATTACK BY UNKNOWN GUNMEN**
- **Scale of incident:** Low
- **Date of Occurrence:** 20/9/2021
- Description of Incident: Several passengers were reportedly injured in an attack carried out by unidentified gunmen along Ohafia-Bende-Umuahia Road in Bende LGA of Abia State. The motive behind the attack is unknown.
- Location: Ohafia-Bende-Umuahia Road in Bende LGA of Abia State.
- **Casualty [Male & female]:** Several people injured.
- Property damaged/Affected population: No property damaged/commuters.
- Coping Mechanism/Responses: The State Police Command has commenced further investigations into the incident.

- **Coping Mechanism/Responses:** The swift response of police operatives led to the rescue of the abducted victim.

- Description of Incident: The operatives of the State Police Command reportedly arrested a suspected ritual killer at Ogobiri-Toruebeni drive in Sagbama LGA of Bayelsa State for attempted murder of a female resident. Preliminary investigations have revealed that the suspect lured his victim to a nearby bush, tied her hands and was about to slit her throat when he was apprehended.
- Location: Toruebeni drive in Sagbama LGA of Bayelsa State
- **Casualty** [Male & female]: No casualty reported, one male arrested, one female rescued.
- Property damaged/Affected population: No property damaged/community residents.
- Coping Mechanism/Responses: The arrested suspect is in the custody of the State Police Command for further interrogation.

- Casualty [Male & female]: Two males killed.
- + Property damaged/Affected population: Police patrol vehicle burnt down/police operatives.
- Coping Mechanism/Responses: The State Police Command has commenced investigations to apprehend the perpetrators of the crime.

- **Property damaged/Affected population:** No property damage reported/community residents.
- Coping Mechanism/Responses: The National Primary Health Care Development Agency (NPHCDA) has continued the vaccination exercise of citizens and residents across States in Nigeria.
