Title of Incident: ARMED ATTACK/ABDUCTION BY SUSPECTED ARMED BANDITS

Scale of incident: High

Date of Occurrence: 14/11/2021

Description of Incident: Forty-five (45) people were allegedly killed with three (3) females abducted in separate attacks carried out by suspected armed bandits at Kojiyo Community in Goronyo LGA and Runji, Kalmalo and Munwadata Communities in Illela LGA of Sokoto State.

Location: Kojiyo Community in Goronyo LGA and Runji, Kalmalo and Munwadata Communities in Illela LGA of Sokoto State.

Casualty [Male&female]: Forty-five males killed, three females abducted.

Property damaged/Affected population: No property damaged/community members.

Coping Mechanism/Responses: There is an ongoing security clearance operation in the affected LGAs to counter armed bandits' attack in the State.

Incident N*02:

Title of Incident: HOMICIDE

Scale of incident: Low

Date of Occurrence: 14/11/2021

Description of Incident: A male resident was reportedly stabbed to death by his wife at their residence in Jattu Community, Etsako West LGA of Edo State. The suspect stabbed her husband over issues of infidelity.

Location: Jattu Community in Etsako West LGA of Edo State.

Casualty [Male & female]: One male killed.

Property damaged/Affected population: No property damaged/male resident.

Coping Mechanism/Responses: The operatives of the State Police Command have arrested the female suspect for further investigation.

Incident N*03:

Title of Incident: ABDUCTION BY SUSPECTED ARMED BANDITS/RAPE

Scale of incident: Low

Date of Occurrence: 14/11/2021

Description of Incident: Six (6) people were reportedly abducted with several valuables looted in an attack carried out by suspected armed bandits in Kwarin Mai Saje Community, Tsafe LGA of Zamfara State. The attackers also allegedly raped an undisclosed number of women in the incident. Preliminary investigations have revealed that the armed bandits invaded the community over the failure of residents to pay the 3 million naira levy imposed on community members.

Location: Kwarin Mai Saje Community, Tsafe LGA of Zamfara State.

Casualty [Male & female]: Six people abducted, undisclosed number of women raped.

Property damaged/Affected population: Several valuables looted/community residents.

Coping Mechanism/Responses: The operatives of security agencies have been deployed to the affected community to maintain peace and security.

Scale of incident: Low

Date of Occurrence: 14/11/2021

Preliminary investigations have revealed that the suspected armed robbers were burnt to death following reports of recurring robbery incidents in the State.
- ✚ **Location:** Apapa/Mile 2 Road in Lagos State.
- ✚ **Casualty [Male & female]:** Two males killed.
- ✚ **Property damaged/Affected population:** No property damaged/suspected armed robbers.
- ✚ **Coping Mechanism/Responses:** There was no intervention as of reporting time.

✚ **Title of Incident:** MURDER/RITUAL KILLING

✚ **Scale of incident:** Low

✚ **Date of Occurrence:** 14/11/2021

✚ **Description of Incident:** The headless body of a 10-year-old boy was reportedly recovered in a bush at Azumini Community in Ikwerre LGA of Rivers State. Preliminary investigations have revealed that the victim was earlier declared missing in the LGA.

✚ **Location:** Azumini Community in Ikwerre LGA of Rivers State.

✚ **Casualty [Male & female]:** Ten-year-old male killed.

✚ **Property damaged/Affected population:** No property damaged/10-year-old boy.

✚ **Coping Mechanism/Responses:** The State Police Command has commenced investigations to apprehend the perpetrators of the crime.

✚ **Incident N*06:**

✚ **Title of Incident:** ABDUCTION BY SUSPECTED ARMED BANDITS

✚ **Scale of incident:** Low

✚ **Date of Occurrence:** 14/11/2021

✚ **Description of Incident:** Four (4) people including a health worker were reportedly abducted in an attack carried out by suspected armed bandits at a water factory at Tegina Community in Rafi LGA of Niger State. Kidnapping for ransom has largely been attributed as the motive behind the criminality in the State.

✚ **Location:** Tegina Community in Rafi LGA of Niger State.

✚ **Casualty [Male&female]:** Four males abducted.

✚ **Property damaged/Affected population:** No property damaged/factory workers.

✚ **Coping Mechanism/Responses:** The security operatives have been deployed to rescue the victims and apprehend the perpetrators of the crime.

✚ **Incident N*07:**

✚ **Title of Incident:** ARMED ATTACK BY SUSPECTED ARMED BANDITS/ARMED ACTION BY POLICE OPERATIVES

✚ **Scale of incident:** Low

✚ **Date of Occurrence:** 14/11/2021

✚ **Description of Incident:** The operatives of the State Police Command reportedly repelled an attack carried out by suspected armed bandits on Gidan Duka Community in Kankara LGA of Katsina State. The suspected armed bandits were intercepted at Danramabu Village with a motorcycle and livestock (38 cows and 11 sheep) recovered in the incident.

✚ **Location:** Gidan Duka Community in Kankara LGA of Katsina State.

✚ **Casualty [Male & female]:** No reported casualty.

✚ **Property damaged/Affected population:** No property damaged, livestock and a motorcycle recovered/community residents and suspected armed bandits.

✚ **Coping Mechanism/Responses:** There is an ongoing security clearance operation to counter armed bandits attacks in the State.

The victims are the children of the clan head of Gege ward in the LGA. The motive behind the attack is unknown.

🚩 **Location:** Ikpomolokpo Palace in Gege ward, Ado LGA of Benue State.

🚩 **Casualty [Male&female]:** One male killed, one female abducted.

🚩 **Property damaged/Affected population:** No property damaged/children of the monarch.

🚩 **Coping Mechanism/Responses:** The security operatives have been deployed to rescue the abducted victim and apprehend the perpetrators of the crime.

🚩 **Title of Incident:** ARMED ATTACK

🚩 **Scale of incident:** Low

🚩 **Date of Occurrence:** 15/11/2021

🚩 **Description of Incident:** The body of a yet-to-be-identified man was reportedly recovered from Asa River along Emir's Road in Ilorin axis of Kwara State. Preliminary investigations have revealed that the body was found with his two hands tied on his back and head covered with cloth.

🚩 **Location:** Asa River along Emir's Road in Ilorin axis of Kwara State.

🚩 **Casualty [Male&female]:** One male dead.

🚩 **Property damaged/Affected population:** No property damaged/community member.

🚩 **Coping Mechanism/Responses:** The operatives of the State Fire Service have evacuated the body from the river and have handed it over to the Nigeria Police Force (NPF) for investigations.

🚩 **Incident N*10:**

🚩 **Title of Incident:** ARSON BY SUSPECTED HOODLUMS

🚩 **Scale of incident:** Low

🚩 **Date of Occurrence:** 15/11/2021

🚩 **Description of Incident:** The Magistrate Court in Ubulu area, Orlu-West LGA of Imo State was reportedly set ablaze in an attack carried out by suspected hoodlums in the State. The motive behind the attack is unknown.

🚩 **Location:** Orlu West LGA of Imo State.

🚩 **Casualty [Male&female]:** No casualty reported.

🚩 **Property damaged/Affected population:** Magistrate Court set ablaze/staff members.

🚩 **Coping Mechanism/Responses:** The security operatives have commenced investigations to apprehend the perpetrators of the crime.

🚩 **Title of Incident:** ARMED ATTACK/INVASION BY AMBAZONIA SEPARATISTS FROM SOUTHERN CAMEROUN

🚩 **Scale of incident:** Medium

🚩 **Date of Occurrence:** 15/11/2021

🚩 **Description of Incident:** Eleven (11) people including a traditional ruler were allegedly killed with several houses destroyed and burnt down in an attack carried out by suspected Ambazonia rebels, a separatist group from Southern Cameroon in Manga Village, Takum LGA of Taraba State¹. The attack has resulted in the internal displacement of community residents. The motive behind the attack is unknown. Manga Village is a border community between Taraba State in Nigeria and the Republic of Cameroun.

🚩 **Location:** Manga Village in Takum LGA of Taraba State.

🚩 **Casualty [Male & female]:** Eleven people killed.

🚩 **Property damaged/Affected population:** Several houses and properties destroyed and burnt down/community residents.

🚩 **Coping Mechanism/Responses:** The Nigerian Military has commenced investigations into the incident.

🚩 Casualty [Male&female]: Two females (mother and her 7-year-old daughter) abducted.

🚩 Property damaged/Affected population: No property damaged/community members.

🚩 Coping Mechanism/Responses: The swift response of security operatives led to the rescue of the abducted victims. Also, three suspects in connection with the crime have been arrested for further interrogation.

🚩 Title of Incident: ARMED ATTACK/ABDUCTION BY SUSPECTED HERDERS

🚩 Scale of incident: Low

🚩 Date of Occurrence: 15/11/2021

🚩 Description of Incident: Two (2) people were allegedly killed with one (1) other injured in an attack carried out by suspected herders at Ajudasi area in Ala axis, Akure North LGA of Ondo State. The attackers also abducted one (1) person in the incident. Preliminary investigations have revealed that the attackers had invited four (4) butchers to the area to purchase livestock (cow) and were subsequently attacked in the incident. The motive behind the attack is unknown.

🚩 Location: Ajudasi area in Ala axis, Akure North LGA of Ondo State.

🚩 Casualty [Male&female]: Two males killed, one male injured, one male abducted.

🚩 Property damaged/Affected population: No property damaged/Livestock sellers.

🚩 Coping Mechanism/Responses: The security operatives have been deployed to apprehend the perpetrators of the crime. Also, the injured victim has been taken to the hospital for medical treatment.

🚩 Incident N*14:

🚩 Title of Incident: ARMED ATTACK BY SUSPECTED ARMED MILITIA GANG

🚩 Scale of incident: Low

🚩 Date of Occurrence: 16/11/2021

🚩 Location: Rafinkada Community in Wukari LGA of Taraba State.

🚩 Casualty [Male&female]: Two males killed, several people injured.

🚩 Property damaged/Affected population: Several houses set ablaze/community members.

🚩 Coping Mechanism/Responses: The security operatives have been deployed to apprehend the perpetrators of the crime.
