#### **Incident N\*01:**

**Title of Incident: ABDUCTION**

**Scale of incident: Low**

**Date of Occurrence: 17/10/2021**

**Description of Incident:** Two (2) people (including a female) were reportedly abducted in an attack carried out by suspected armed gang at their residence in Kasuwan Yelwa and Kogin Mallam Garba areas in Jalingo Metropolis of Taraba State. Kidnapping for ransom has largely been attributed as the motive behind the criminality in the State.

**Location:** Kasuwan Yelwa and Kogin Mallam Garba areas in Jalingo Metropolis of Taraba State.

**Casualty [Male&female]:** Two people (1 male and 1 female) abducted.

**Property damaged/Affected population:** No property damaged/community residents.

**Coping Mechanism/Responses:** The security operatives have been deployed to rescue the victims.

#### **Incident N\*02:**

**Title of Incident: MURDER**

**Scale of incident: Low**

**Date of Occurrence: 17/10/2021**

**Description of Incident:** A-day old baby was reportedly killed by unknown persons with the body parts cut into pieces at Wudil Town in Kano State. The motive behind the incident is unknown.

**Location:** Wudil Town in Kano State

**Casualty [Male & female]:** One child killed.

**Property damaged/Affected population:** No property damaged/community resident.

**Coping Mechanism/Responses:** The State Police Command has commenced investigations to apprehend the perpetrators of the crime and to unravel the motive behind the crime.

#### **Incident N\*03:**

**Title of Incident: RESCUE OPERATIONS BY SECURITY OPERATIVES**

**Scale of incident: Medium**

**Date of Occurrence: 17/10/2021**

**Description of Incident:** The operatives of security agencies reportedly killed ten (10) suspected armed bandits with several other bandits injured during a security clearance operation at Kwanan Bataru axis of Fatika in Giwa LGA of Kaduna State. The security operatives also rescued an abducted victim in the incident.

**Location:** Kwanan Bataru axis of Fatika in Giwa LGA of Kaduna State.

**Casualty [Male & female]:** Ten suspected armed bandits killed, one abducted victim rescued.

**Property damaged/Affected population:** No property damaged/suspected armed bandits and a community resident.

**Coping Mechanism/Responses:** There is an ongoing security clearance operation to counter armed bandits attack in the State.

#### **Incident N\*04:**

**Title of Incident: ARMED ATTACK BY SUSPECTED ARMED GANG**

**Scale of incident: Low**

**Date of Occurrence: 17/10/2021**

✚ **Title of Incident:** ARMED ATTACK BY SUSPECTED ARMED ROBBERS

✚ **Scale of incident:** Low

✚ **Date of Occurrence:** 17/10/2021

✚ **Description of Incident:** A final year student of the University of Ibadan (UI) in Oyo State was allegedly killed with his mobile phone stolen in an attack carried out by suspected armed robbers at Preboye Complex in Ibadan axis of Oyo State.

✚ **Location:** Preboye Complex in Ibadan axis of Oyo State.

✚ **Casualty [Male&female]:** One male student killed.

✚ **Property damaged/Affected population:** A mobile phone stolen/student.

✚ **Coping Mechanism/Responses:** The State Police Command has commenced investigations to apprehend the perpetrators of the crime.

#### ✚ Incident N\*06:

✚ **Title of Incident:** ARMED ATTACK BY SUSPECTED ARMED BANDITS

✚ **Scale of incident:** High

✚ **Date of Occurrence:** 17/10/2021

✚ **Description of Incident:** Forty-three (43) people were reportedly killed with twenty others (20) injured in an attack carried out by suspected armed bandits at Goronyo market in Goronyo LGA of Sokoto State. Armed attack by suspected armed bandits remain prevalent in the State.

✚ **Location:** Goronyo market in Goronyo LGA of Sokoto State.

✚ **Casualty [Male&female]:** Forty-three people killed, twenty people injured.

✚ **Property damaged/Affected population:** No property damaged/community members.

✚ **Coping Mechanism/Responses:** There is an ongoing security clearance operation to counter armed bandits' attack in the State.

#### ✚ Incident N\*07:

✚ **Title of Incident:** ARMED ATTACK/ARSON BY SUSPECTED HOODLUMS

✚ **Scale of incident:** Low

✚ **Date of Occurrence:** 17/10/2021

✚ **Description of Incident:** A police officer was allegedly killed with a police station burnt down in an attack carried out by suspected hoodlums at Ohaukwu LGA of Ebonyi State. The attackers reportedly set free an undisclosed number of detainees with two vehicles and other properties set ablaze in the incident. Preliminary investigations have revealed that several cases of arson on government infrastructure in Ebonyi State have been blamed on members of the Indigenous People of Biafra (IPOB) whose leader, Nnamdi Kanu, is in detention over charges of treason.

✚ **Location:** Ohaukwu LGA of Ebonyi State.

✚ **Casualty [Male&female]:** One police officer killed, several detainees escaped.

✚ **Property damaged/Affected population:** Police station, vehicles and other properties burnt down/police officer.

✚ **Coping Mechanism/Responses:** The security operatives have been deployed to apprehend the perpetrators of the crime.

**Scale of incident:** Low

**Date of Occurrence:** 17/10/2021

**Description of Incident:** Four (4) people were allegedly killed with one (1) person injured during a shooting incident by operatives of the Ebonyi State Security Outfit at Amasiri Community in Afikpo North LGA of Ebonyi State. Preliminary investigations have revealed that the operatives shot at community youths on the allegation that they sealed off a Lebanese quarry company in the area.

**Location:** Amasiri Community in Afikpo North LGA of Ebonyi State.

**Casualty [Male&female]:** Four males killed, one male injured.

**Property damaged/Affected population:** No property damaged/community members.

**Coping Mechanism/Responses:** The State Police Command has commenced further investigations to ascertain the cause of the shooting.

#### **Incident N\*09:**

**Title of Incident: HOMICIDE**

**Scale of incident:** Low

**Date of Occurrence:** 17/10/2021

**Description of Incident:** One (1) person was reportedly stabbed to death by his cousin over a family dispute at Duburo community in Khana LGA of Rivers State.

**Location:** Duburo community in Khana LGA of Rivers State.

**Casualty [Male&female]:** One male killed.

**Property damaged/Affected population:** No property damaged/community member.

**Coping Mechanism/Responses:** The security operatives have been deployed to apprehend the perpetrator of the crime.

#### **Incident N\*10:**

**Title of Incident: RIVAL CULT CLASH**

**Scale of incident:** Low

**Date of Occurrence:** 17/10/2021

**Description of Incident:** Four (4) people were allegedly killed in a violent clash between suspected cult gangs 'Iceland and Debam confraternities' at Udianga Anem and Obon Ebot Villages in Etim Ekpo LGA and Ikot Unah and Ikot Ibekwe Villages in Ukanafun LGA of Akwa Ibom State. Supremacy tussle and revenge attacks have been attributed to the recurring cult clashes in the State.

**Location:** Etim Ekpo and Ukanafun LGA of Akwa Ibom State.

**Casualty [Male&female]:** Four males killed.

**Property damaged/Affected population:** No property damaged/suspected cult members.

**Coping Mechanism/Responses:** The operatives of security agencies have been deployed to apprehend the perpetrators of the crime.

#### **Incident N\*11:**

**Title of Incident: VIOLENT EXTREMIST ATTACK/ARMED ACTION BY THE NIGERIAN ARMY**

**Scale of incident:** Medium

**Date of Occurrence:** 18/10/2021

**Description of Incident:** Eight (8) suspected members of Boko Haram and Islamic State West Africa (ISWAP) members were reportedly killed in security clearance operations around 151 Battalion axis and Forward Operating Base (FOB) in Wulgo area of Borno State. Several weapons were recovered in the incident.

**Location:** Borno State.

**Casualty [Male & female]:** Eight suspected members of Boko Haram and ISWAP.

**Property damaged/Affected population:** No property damaged/suspected ISWAP and Boko Haram members.

✚ **Location:** Ugwujoro Nimbo and Awha-Ndiagu communities at Uzo-Uwani and Ezeagu LGAs of Enugu State.

✚ **Casualty [Male&female]:** One female farmer killed, one male injured.

✚ **Property damaged/Affected population:** No property damaged/farmer.

✚ **Coping Mechanism/Responses:** The security operatives have been deployed to apprehend the perpetrators of the crime.

#### ✚ **Incident N\*13:**

✚ **Title of Incident: ARREST**

✚ **Scale of incident:** Low

✚ **Date of Occurrence:** 18/10/2021

✚ **Description of Incident:** The operatives of the State Police Command reportedly arrested three (3) suspected armed robbers during a security raid on their hideout in Mowe area, Obafemi-Owode LGA of Ogun State.

✚ **Location:** Mowe area, Obafemi-Owode LGA of Ogun State.

✚ **Casualty [Male&female]:** Three male suspects arrested.

✚ **Property damaged/Affected population:** No property damaged/suspected armed robbers.

✚ **Coping Mechanism/Responses:** The arrested suspects are in the custody of the State Police Command for further interrogation.

 **Casualty [Male&female]:** Four people (3 males and one female) abducted.

 **Property damaged/Affected population:** No property damaged/NYSC members.


 **Coping Mechanism/Responses:** The abducted victims have been released by their abductors following the payment of an undisclosed amount.

 **Description of Incident:** Two (2) traditional rulers were allegedly killed with two (2) other rulers injured in an attack carried out by suspected armed gang at Njaba LGA of Imo State. The attackers reportedly abducted an undisclosed number of persons in the incident. The traditional rulers were holding a stakeholders' meeting when the incident occurred. The motive behind the attack is unknown.

 **Location:** Njaba LGA of Imo State

 **Casualty [Male&female]:** Two males killed, two males injured, several people abducted.

 **Property damaged/Affected population:** No property damaged/traditional rulers and community residents.


 **Coping Mechanism/Responses:** The operatives of security agencies have commenced investigations to apprehend the perpetrators of the crime.

#### **Incident N\*18:**

 **Title of incident: SECURITY CLEARANCE OPERATION BY THE NIGERIAN ARMY**


 **Scale of incident:** High


 **Date of Occurrence:** 19/10/2021

 **Description of incident:** Over fifty (50) suspected armed bandits were reportedly killed during a joint-security clearance operation at Birnin Gwari forest in Saulawa-Farin Ruwa axis, Birnin Gwari LGA of Kaduna State.

 **Location:** Birnin Gwari forest in Saulawa-Farin Ruwa axis, Birnin Gwari LGA of Kaduna State.

 **Casualty[Male & female]:** Fifty suspected armed bandits killed.

 **Property damaged/Affected population:** No property damaged/suspected armed bandits.


 **Coping mechanism/Responses:** There is an ongoing security clearance operation to counter armed banditry attacks' in the State.
