- **棊** Title of Incident: ARMED ATTACK BY SUSPECTED FULANI MILITIA GANG
- Scale of incident: Low
- **Date of Occurrence:** 24/10/2021
- → **Description of Incident:** Two (2) people were allegedly killed with several others injured in an attack carried out by suspected Fulani militia gang in Ungwan Taila village, Zangon Kataf LGA of Kaduna State. The LGA has recorded attacks and counter attacks between community residents and ethnic Fulani militia gang in the State.
- Location: Ungwan Taila village, Zangon Kataf LGA of Kaduna State.
- **Casualty [Male&female]:** Two males killed, several people injured.
- **Property damaged/Affected population:** No property damaged/community members.
- **Coping Mechanism/Responses:** The security operatives have been deployed to apprehend the perpetrators of the crime.

Incident N*02:

- **Title of Incident: ARMED ATTACK/ABDUCTION BY SUSPECTED ARMED BANDITS**
- Scale of incident: Medium
- Date of Occurrence: 24/10/2021
- **Description of Incident:** Six (6) people were allegedly killed with several others abducted in an attack carried out by suspected armed bandits in Unguwar Samanja Village, Faskari LGA of Katsina State. Attacks by suspected armed bandits remain prevalent in the State.
- Location: Unguwar Samanja Village, Faskari LGA of Katsina State.
- **Casualty [Male & female]:** Six males killed, several others abducted.
- Property damaged/Affected population: No property damaged/community residents.
- **Coping Mechanism/Responses:** There is an ongoing security clearance operation to counter armed bandits attacks in the State.

- Location: Obada Oko area, Ewekoro LGA of Ogun State
- Casualty [Male&female]: Three people (2 females and 1 male) abducted.
- Property damaged/Affected population: No property damaged/community residents.
- **Coping Mechanism/Responses:** The security operatives have been deployed to rescue the victims and trail the perpetrators of the crime.

The motive behind the killing is unknown. The suspect was also injured by community residents in the incident.
- **Location:** Uburu Community in Ohaozara LGA of Ebonyi State.
- **Casualty [Male&female]:** Three people (2 females and 1 male) killed, one male injured.
- Property damaged/Affected population: No property damaged/community members.
- **Coping Mechanism/Responses:** The injured suspect has been taken to the hospital for medical treatment. The State Police Command has commenced investigations to ascertain the motive behind the attack.

The attackers reportedly abducted eighteen (18) people and destroyed several properties in the incident.
- Location: Maza-Kuka and Kaboji Villages in Mashegu LGA of Niger State.
- Casualty [Male&female]: Seventeen people (16 males and 1 female) killed, eighteen people abducted, three people injured.
- Property damaged/Affected population: No property damaged/community residents.
- **Coping Mechanism/Responses:** The security operatives have commenced investigations to rescue the voitims and apprehend the perpetrators of the crime.

- Casualty [Male&female]: 211,887 confirmed cases, 203,080 people treated and discharged, 2,895 people dead.
- Property damaged/Affected population: No property damage reported/community residents.
- Coping Mechanism/Responses: The National Primary Health Care Development Agency (NPHCDA) has continued the vaccination exercise of citizens and residents across States in Nigeria.
