- **Title of Incident: VIOLENT EXTREMIST ATTACK/ARSON BY SUSPECTED BOKO HARAM MEMBERS**
- Scale of incident: High
- **Date of Occurrence:** 19/12/2021
- → **Description of Incident:** Twenty (20) people were allegedly killed and several others injured in an attack carried out by suspected Boko Haram members in Askira Uba LGA of Borno state. The attackers also set ablaze several houses with food items and vehicles looted in the incident.
- **Location:** Askira Uba LGA of Borno state.
- Casualty [Male&female]: Twenty people killed, several others injured.
- Property damaged/Affected population: Several houses set ablaze, food items and vehicles looted/community members
- **Coping Mechanism/Responses:** There is an ongoing security clearance operation in the area to counter terrorist attacks.

Incident N*02:

- Title of Incident: ABDUCTION
- **Scale of incident:** Low
- **Date of Occurrence:** 19/12/2021
- Description of Incident: Eight (8) people were reportedly abducted in an attack carried out by suspected armed gang along Ubiaja-Ewohimi Road in Edo State. Kidnapping for ransom has largely been attributed as the motive behind the criminality in the State.
- Location: Ubiaja-Ewohimi Road in Edo State
- Casualty [Male & female]: Eight people abducted.
- **♣ Property damaged/Affected population:** No property damaged/commuters.
- ♣ Coping Mechanism/Responses: The swift response of police operatives led to the rescue of five (5) of the abducted victims with three (3) suspects arrested in the incident. The State Police Command has commenced investigation to rescue other abducted victims.

Incident N*03:

- **↓** Title of Incident: SCHOOLS SHUT DOWN OVER PLANNED ARMED BANDITRY ATTACK
- **Scale of incident:** Low
- **♣ Date of Occurrence:** 19/12/2021
- **Description of Incident:** The Chairman of Wushishi LGA of Niger State, Danjuma Suleiman Nalango, ordered the closure of all public and private primary, secondary and tertiary schools in Wushishi LGA of the State following a planned armed banditry attack on schools to abduct school children in the LGA.
- Location: Wushishi LGA of Niger State
- Casualty [Male & female]: No casualty.
- **Property damaged/Affected population:** No property damaged/teachers and students.
- **Coping Mechanism/Responses:** All schools in the LGA complied with the Chairman's directive to shut down schools.

- Casualty[Male & female]: No casualty reported.
- Property damaged/Affected population: Two vehicles and three motorcycles burnt down/community

- Location: Gassol Chiefdom in Gassol LGA of Taraba State.
- Casualty [Male & female]: No reported casualty.
- **Property damaged/Affected population:** Rice farms destroyed/farmers.
- Coping Mechanism/Responses: There was no intervention as of reporting time.

Incident N*60:

- Title of Incident: CORONAVIRUS
- Scale of incident: Low
- Date of Occurrence: 25/12/2021
- Description of Incident: The Nigeria Centre for Disease Control (NCDC) recorded three (3) deaths and 12,127 confirmed cases of coronavirus across the 36 states of Nigeria including the Abuja-FCT between 19 to 25 December, 2021. Also, as of December 25, 2021, 825 people have been treated and discharged. As of December 25 2021, a total of 9,643,974 COVID-19 vaccine doses have been administered in Nigeria. The National Primary Health Care Development Agency (NPHCDA) continues to vaccinate residents with the approved AstraZeneca and Moderna COVID-19 vaccine in Nigeria⁴.
- Location: Nigeria.
- Casualty [Male&female]: Three people dead, 12,127 confirmed cases, 825 people treated.
- **Property damaged/Affected population:** No property damage/community residents.
- Coping Mechanism/Responses: The National Primary Health Care Development Agency (NPHCDA) has continued the vaccination exercise of citizens and residents across States in Nigeria.
