- 4 Title of Incident: ARMED ATTACK/ARSON BY SUSPECTED HOODLUMS
- Scale of incident: Low
- 4 Date of Occurrence: 13/2/2022
- Description of Incident: Suspected hoodlums reportedly set ablaze the house of a leader of the Oodua Peoples Congress (OPC) in Osun State. The motive behind the attack is unknown.
- Location: Osun State.
- 4 Casualty [Male&female]: No reported casualty.
- Property damaged/Affected population: Several properties destroyed/community member.
- Coping Mechanism/Responses: The security operatives have been deployed to apprehend the perpetrators of the crime.

Incident N*02:

- Title of Incident: ABDUCTION BY SUSPECTED ARMED BANDITS/ARMED ACTION
- Scale of incident: Low
- Date of Occurrence: 13/2/2022
- Description of Incident: Three (3) people were reportedly abducted in an attack carried out by suspected armed bandits at Hayin Gada Village in Shika Giwa LGA of Kaduna State. The attack was also repelled by officials of the Kaduna State Vigilance Service (KADVS) which resulted in the death of three (3) suspected armed bandits in the incident. The abducted victims include a staff member of the Ahmadu Bello University, Zaria and his two (2)
- Location: Hayin Gada Village in Shika Giwa LGA of Kaduna State.
- Casualty [Male & female]: Three people (1 male and 2 children) abducted, three suspected armed bandits killed.
- Property damaged/Affected population: No property damaged/community residents.
- Coping Mechanism/Responses: The swift response of KADVS officials led to the rescue of the abducted victims.

- Date of Occurrence: 13/2/2022
- Description of Incident: A female resident reportedly killed her husband at a Fulani settlement in Iyana Ilewo Community at Abeokuta-North LGA of Ogun State. Preliminary investigations have revealed that the suspect poured hot water on her husband which led to his death.
- **Location:** Iyana Ilewo Community at Abeokuta-North LGA of Ogun State.
- Casualty [Male & female]: One male killed.
- Property damaged/Affected population: No property damaged/community resident.
- Coping Mechanism/Responses: The operatives of the State Police Command has commenced investigations to arrest the fleeing suspect.
