### Incident N\*01:

- **Title of Incident: RESCUE OPERATIONS**
- **♣ Scale of incident:** Low
- ♣ Date of Occurrence: 16/1/2022
- → Description of Incident: The operatives of the State Police Command reportedly rescued sixteen (16) victims abducted by suspected armed bandits around Masallaci Area, along Birnin Gwari Road in Chikun LGA of Kaduna State. Preliminary investigations have revealed that the victims are residents of Udawa and Gadagi Baggi Villages in Chikun LGA, while others were travellers from Lagos, Kano, Zamfara and Niger States.
- **Location:** Masallaci Area along Birnin Gwari Road in Chikun LGA of Kaduna State.
- Casualty [Male&female]: Sixteen abducted victims rescued.
- ♣ Property damaged/Affected population: No property damaged/abducted victims.
- Coping Mechanism/Responses: There is an ongoing security clearance operation by police operatives to rescue other abducted victims in the State.

## Incident N\*02:

- Title of Incident: HOMICIDE
- Scale of incident: Low
- **Date of Occurrence:** 16/1/2022
- → **Description of Incident:** A student of Elkanemi College of Islamic Theology in Maiduguri LGA of Borno State reportedly slit the throat of an 11-year-old junior student of the Islamic Theology College in the State. The motive behind the attack is unknown.
- **Location:** Borno State.
- **Casualty [Male & female]:** One male injured.
- **Property damaged/Affected population:** No property damaged/student.
- Coping Mechanism/Responses: The injured victim has been taken to the hospital for medical treatment. Also, the suspect has been arrested and in the custody of the State Police Command for further interrogation.

## Incident N\*03:

- **Title of Incident: ABDUCTION**
- Scale of incident: Low
- **Date of Occurrence:** 16/1/2022
- → **Description of Incident:** Seven (7) people including two employees of the Nigerian Council of Registered Insurance Brokers (NCRIB) were reportedly abducted in an attack carried out by suspected armed gang along Isara Axis of Lagos-Ibadan Expressway in Ogun State. Kidnapping for ransom has largely been attributed as the motive behind the criminality in the State.
- **Location:** Isara axis of Lagos-Ibadan Expressway in Ogun State.
- Casualty [Male & female]: No casualty reported, seven males abducted.
- **Property damaged/Affected population:** No property damaged/commuters.
- **Coping Mechanism/Responses:** The suspected kidnappers have released three (3) of the abducted victims. Also, the State Police Command has commenced investigations to rescue the other abducted victims.

- **Title of Incident: ARMED ATTACK BY SUSPECTED ARMED BANDITS/ARMED ACTION**
- **Scale of incident:** Low
- **♣ Date of Occurrence:** 16/1/2022

- **Scale of incident:** Low
- Date of Occurrence: 16/1/2022
- **Description of Incident:** Three (3) farmers were reportedly abducted in an attack carried out by suspected armed gang in Paikon Bassa Community, Abaji Area Council in Abuja-FCT. Kidnapping for ransom has largely been attributed as the motive behind the criminality in the State.
- Location: Paikon Bassa Community in Abaji Area Council in Abuja-FCT.
- Casualty [Male&female]: Three farmers abducted.
- **Property damaged/Affected population:** No property damaged/farmers.
- **Coping Mechanism/Responses:** The security operatives have been deployed to rescue the abducted victims and to apprehend perpetrators of the crime

## Incident N\*06:

- Title of Incident: ARREST/MURDER
- **Scale of incident:** Low
- **♣** Date of Occurrence: 17/1/2022
- **Description of Incident:** The State Police Command reportedly arrested a 32-year-old community resident for allegedly killing his younger brother for money ritual in Lagos State. The suspect was arrested during a stop-and-search operation along Itamaga axis of Ikorodu Road in Lagos State.
- **Location:** Itamaga axis of Ikorodu Road in Lagos State.
- **Casualty [Male&female]:** One male killed.
- Property damaged/Affected population: No property damaged/community residents.
- Coping Mechanism/Responses: The arrested suspect is in the custody of the State Police Command for further interrogation.

## Incident N\*07:

- Title of Incident: SHOOTING BY POLICE OPERATIVES/PEACEFUL DEMONSTRATION
- **♣ Scale of incident:** Low
- Date of Occurrence: 17/1/2022
- Description of Incident: A police operative reportedly shot a truck driver at a checkpoint in Dukku Area along Gombe-Darazo Expressway, Dukku LGA of Gombe State. The incident resulted in a peaceful protest by truck drivers in the area.
- **Location:** Dukku area along Gombe-Darazo expressway of Gombe State.
- Casualty [Male&female]: One male injured.
- **Property damaged/Affected population:** No properties damaged/truck driver.
- **Coping Mechanism/Responses:** The injured victim has been taken to the hospital for medical treatment.

## Incident N\*08:

- **Title of Incident: PHYSICAL ASSAULT BY SUSPECTED IPOB MEMBERS**
- ♣ Scale of incident: Low
- Date of Occurrence: 17/1/2022
- **Description of Incident:** Suspected members of the Indigenous People of Biafra (IPOB) reportedly assaulted traders at Obollo-Afor Town in Udenu LGA of Enugu State while enforcing the sit-at-home order in the area. The

- Location: Amauke and Ogrute Communities in Enugu Ezike and Igbo-Eze North LGAs of Enugu State.
- Casualty [Male & female]: Two males injured.
- Property damaged/Affected population: Motorcyclist stolen/community residents.
- **Coping Mechanism/Responses:** The operatives of the State Police Command have been deployed to maintain peace and security in the affected area.

### Incident N\*10:

- **♣** Title of Incident: ARMED ATTACK BY SUSPECTED ARMED GANG
- Scale of incident: Low
- Date of Occurrence: 17/1/2022
- **Description of Incident:** One (1) person was reportedly killed in an attack carried out by suspected armed gang at Sabo Gariin Damban Area in Gusau LGA of Zamafra State. The victim was shot while responding to a distress call by his neighbour.
- **Location:** Sabo Gariin Damban Area in Gusau of Zamafra State.
- Casualty [Male&female]: One male killed.
- Property damaged/Affected population: No property damaged/community member.
- **Coping Mechanism/Responses:** The security operatives have been deployed to apprehend the perpetrators of the crime.

## Incident N\*11:

- **■** Title of Incident: ARREST OF SUSPECTED ARMED ROBBERS
- Scale of incident: Low
- Date of Occurrence: 17/1/2022
- → **Description of Incident:** The operatives of the Nigeria Security and Civil Defence Corps (NSCDC) reportedly arrested four (4) suspected armed robbers following a distress call of an armed robbery incident along Isanlu-Isin Road in Kwara State.
- **Location:** Isanlu-Isin Road in Kwara State.
- **Casualty [Male & female]:** No reported casualty, four suspected armed robbers arrested.
- **Property damaged/Affected population:** No property damaged/suspected armed robbers.
- Coping Mechanism/Responses: The arrested suspects are in the custody of the State Police Command for further interrogation.

## Incident N\*12:

- **■** Title of Incident: ARMED ACTION BY SECURITY OPERATIVES
- **Scale of incident:** Low
- **♣ Date of Occurrence:** 17/1/2022
- **Description of Incident:** Several members of the proscribed Indigenous People of Biafra (IPOB) were reportedly killed in a shoot-out incident between security operatives and suspected IPOB members at Lilu forest in Ihiala LGA of Anambra State. Several arms and ammunition were reportedly recovered in the incident.

- **Description of Incident:** Five (5) people (including three police officers and two local vigilante members) were allegedly killed with several others injured in an attack carried out by suspected armed bandits in Kwanan Dutse Community, Mariga LGA of Niger State. The victims were killed while on security patrol in the area.
- **Location:** Kwanan Dutse Community in Mariga LGA of Niger State.
- **Casualty [Male&female]:** Five males (3 police officers, 2 vigilante members) killed.
- Property damaged/Affected population: No property damaged/police operatives and local vigilante members.
- **Coping Mechanism/Responses:** The security operatives have been deployed to apprehend the perpetrators of the crime.

### Incident N\*14:

- **単** Title of Incident: ABDUCTION
- Scale of incident: Low
- **♣ Date of Occurrence:** 17/1/2022
- **Description of Incident:** The District Head of Vwang in Jos South LGA of Plateau State was reportedly abducted in an attack carried out by suspected armed gang at Kuru Community in Jos South LGA of Plateau State. Kidnapping for ransom has largely been attributed as the motive behind the criminality in the State.
- Location: Kuru Community in Jos South LGA of Plateau State.
- Casualty [Male & female]: One male abducted.
- Property damaged/Affected population: No property damaged/District Head.
- **Coping Mechanism/Responses:** The State Police Command has commenced investigations to rescue the abducted victim.

## Incident N\*15:

- **Title of Incident: ARSON/ARMED ATTACK BY SUSPECTED HOODLUMS**
- Scale of incident: Low
- Date of Occurrence: 17/1/2022
- Description of Incident: Several vehicles were reportedly damaged with a house set ablaze in an attack carried out by suspected hoodlums at Ezinifitte Area in Nnewi South LGA of Anambra State. Further investigations revealed that the incident occurred during a funeral ceremony in the State. The motive behind the attack is unknown.
- **Location:** Ezinifitte Area in Nnewi South LGA of Anambra State.
- Casualty [Male & female]: No reported casualty.
- Property damaged/Affected population: Several vehicles and a house damaged/community residents
- **← Coping Mechanism/Responses:** The operatives of security agencies have been deployed to apprehend the perpetrators of the crime.

## Incident N\*16:

- **単** Title of Incident: ABDUCTION BY SUSPECTED SEA PIRATES
- Scale of incident: Low
- **♣** Date of Occurrence: 17/1/2022
- **Description of Incident:** Seventeen (17) people were reportedly abducted in an attack carried out by suspected sea pirates along Safe Journey beach in Calabar Axis of Cross River State. Kidnapping for ransom has largely been attributed as the motive behind the criminality in the State.

- **♣ Date of Occurrence:** 17/1/2022
- **Description of Incident:** A community youth was reportedly shot dead by a local vigilante member at a drinking bar in Bomadi area, Bomadi LGA of Bayelsa State. The motive behind the attack is unknown. However, the death of the community youth has triggered riot by residents resulting in the destruction of properties with several houses burnt down. The local vigilante member was reportedly injured by community youths in the incident.
- Location: Bomadi area in Bomadi LGA of Bayelsa State.
- Casualty [Male & female]: One male killed, one male injured.
- **Property damaged/Affected population:** Several properties destroyed and burnt down/community resident and local vigilante member.
- **Coping Mechanism/Responses:** The operatives of the State Police Command were deployed to forestall further attacks and also maintain peace and security.

#### Incident N\*18:

- **■** Title of Incident: ARMED ATTACK/ABDUCTION BY SUSPECTED ARMED GANG
- Scale of incident: Low
- ♣ Date of Occurrence: 17/1/2022
- Description of Incident: Two (2) local vigilante members were reportedly killed and four (4) farmers abducted in an attack carried out by suspected armed gang at Rafindaji Village in Abaji Area Council of Abuja-FCT. The motive behind the attack is uknown. However, kidnapping for ransom has largely been attributed as the motive behind the criminality in the State.
- Location: Rafindaji Village in Abaji Area Council of Abuja-FCT.
- **Casualty [Male & female]:** Two males killed, four males abducted.
- Property damaged/Affected population: No property damaged/local vigilante members and farmers.
- **Coping Mechanism/Responses:** The State Police Command has commenced investigations to rescue the abducted victims

## Incident N\*19:

- Title of Incident: ARMED ATTACK BY SUSPECTED ARMED BANDITS
- Scale of incident: High
- Date of Occurrence: 17/1/2022
- Description of Incident: The State Governor of Niger State, Abubakar Sani Bello, issued a report of the statistics of fatalities emanating from armed bandits' attacks between January 1 and 17, 2022. The State Governor indicated that 220 people (including 165 civilians, 25 security officers and 30 local vigilante members) were killed and 200 others including three Chinese nationals abducted within the reviewed period across 300 communities in Niger State.
- **Location:** Niger State.
- **Casualty [Male & female]:** 200 people killed, 200 people abducted.
- **Property damaged/Affected population:** Several properties destroyed/community residents, local vigilantes and security officers.
- **Coping Mechanism/Responses:** There is an ongoing security clearance operation to counter armed bandits' attacks in the State.

- **Description of Incident:** A 41-year-old male resident was reportedly found dead in a hotel room at Amichi Area in Nnewi North LGA of Anambra State with his body parts severed. The motive behind his death is unknown.
- Location: Amichi Area in Nnewi North LGA of Anambra State.
- Casualty [Male & female]: One male dead.
- Property damaged/Affected population: No property damaged/community resident.
- **Coping Mechanism/Responses:** The State Police Command has commenced investigation to apprehend the perpetrators of the crime.

## Incident N\*21:

- Title of Incident: EXTRAJUDICIAL KILLING AND PEACEFUL PROTEST
- Scale of incident: Low
- Date of Occurrence: 18/1/2022
- **Description of Incident:** A truck driver was reportedly shot dead and two (2) others injured by an officer of the Department of State Services (DSS) following a misunderstanding along Tipper Garage in Ikpoba Slope in Benin-City of Edo State. The shooting reportedly triggered a peaceful protest by truck drivers in the affected area.
- Location: Tipper Garage in Ikpoba Slope in Benin-City of Edo State.
- **Casualty [Male & female]:** One male killed, two males injured.
- Property damaged/Affected population: No property damages/truck drivers.
- **Coping Mechanism/Responses:** The operatives of security agencies have been deployed to the affected area to forestall further attacks in the State.

## Incident N\*22:

- **単** Title of Incident: ARMED ATTACK/ABDUCTION BY SUSPECTED ARMED BANDITS/ARMED ACTION
- Scale of incident: Low
- **Date of Occurrence:** 18/1/2022
- Description of Incident: Ten (10) people were reportedly abducted in an attack carried out by suspected armed bandits in Unguwar Musa Tudun Wada Kudansa Maraban Rido Area, Chikun LGA of Kaduna State.
  In a related development, three (3) suspected armed bandits were killed in separate security operations carried out by military operatives in Chikun, Igabi and Giwa LGAs of Kaduna State.
- Location: Kaduna State.
- **Casualty [Male & female]:** Three suspected armed bandits killed, ten people abducted.
- Property damaged/Affected population: No property damaged/community residents and suspected armed bandits.
- **Coping Mechanism/Responses:** The swift response of security operatives led to the rescue of the abducted victims. Also, there is an ongoing security clearance operation to counter armed bandits' attack in the State.

## Incident N\*23:

- Title of Incident: EXTRAJUDICIAL KILLING/VIOLENT DEMONSTRATION
- Scale of incident: Low
- **Date of Occurrence:** 18/1/2022
- → **Description of Incident:** One (1) person was reported dead following an assault by a team of Ebubeagu operatives in Ivo LGA of Ebonyi State. Community youths alleged that the victim who stole bamboo from the community was arrested and killed by Ebubeagu operatives in the State. The victims' death reportedly triggered violent demonstrations resulting in the destruction of several properties.
- Location: Ivo LGA of Ebonyi State.
- Casualty [Male & female]: One male killed.
- **Property damaged/Affected population:** Several properties destroyed/community youths.
- **Coping Mechanism/Responses:** The operatives of the State Police Command have been deployed to disperse the protesters and maintain peace and security in the affected area.

- Location: Onicha LGA of Ebonyi State.
- **Casualty [Male&female]:** Four males killed.
- **Property damaged/Affected population:** Several properties damaged/community members.
- **Coping Mechanism/Responses:** The security operatives have been deployed to forestall further attacks and apprehend the perpetrators of the crime.

### Incident N\*25:

- Title of Incident: ABDUCTION
- Scale of incident: Low
- Date of Occurrence: 18/1/2022
- **Description of Incident:** Three (3) farmers were reportedly abducted in an attack carried out by suspected armed gang while conveying yams from Paikon Bassa Community in Abaji Area Council of Abuja-FCT to Lambata market in Niger State. Kidnapping for ransom has largely been attributed as the motive behind the criminality in the State.
- **Location:** Lambata market in Niger State.
- **Casualty [Male & female]:** Three males abducted.
- **Property damaged/Affected population:** No property damaged/farmers.
- **Coping Mechanism/Responses:** The State Police Command has commenced investigations to rescue the abducted victims.

## Incident N\*26:

- **■** Title of Incident: ARMED ATTACK BY SUSPECTED ARMED BANDITS
- Scale of incident: Low
- Date of Occurrence: 18/1/2022
- Description of Incident: Two (2) people including a military operative and a Civil Defence officer were allegedly killed and several others injured in an attack carried by suspected armed bandits on a military base in Shinfida Community, Jibia LGA of Katsina State. The attackers reportedly burnt down two (2) patrol vehicles and carted away with one patrol vehicle in the incident.
- Location: Shinfida Community in Jibia LGA of Katsina State.
- **Casualty [Male&female]:** Two males killed, several people injured.
- ₽ Property damaged/Affected population: Two vehicles burnt down, one patrol vehicle stolen/security operatives.
- Coping Mechanism/Responses: The security operatives have been deployed to maintain peace and security in the affected area.

## Incident N\*27:

- **単** Title of Incident: ARREST
- Scale of incident: Low
- **Date of Occurrence:** 18/2/2022
- **Description of Incident:** The operatives of the Nigeria Security and Civil Defense Corps (NSCDC) reportedly arrested four (4) suspected illegal gold miners during a security raid at Ojirame Area in Akoko-Edo LGA of Edo State. Preliminary investigations have revealed that the Edo State Government imposed a ban on mining to avoid security challenges following the influx of strangers to the locality.
