**Date of Occurrence:** 23/1/2022

**Description of Incident:** Two (2) people were reportedly killed in an attack carried out by suspected armed herders at Okeluse Village in Ose LGA of Ondo State. The motive behind the attack is unknown.

**Location:** Okeluse Village in Ose LGA of Ondo State.

**Casualty [Male&female]:** Two males killed.

**Property damaged/Affected population:** No property damaged/community members.

**Coping Mechanism/Responses:** The security operatives have been deployed to apprehend the perpetrators of the crime.

#### **Incident N\*02:**

**Title of Incident: ARMED ATTACK BY SUSPECTED ARMED HERDERS**

**Scale of incident:** Low

**Date of Occurrence:** 23/1/2022

**Description of Incident:** Two (2) people were reportedly killed in an attack carried out by suspected armed herders at Igama Community in Ojugo Ward of Okpokwu LGA in Benue State. The attackers also burnt down several houses in the incident. The motive behind the attack is unknown. However, attacks by suspected herders remain prevalent in Benue State.

**Location:** Igama Community in Ojugo Ward of Okpokwu LGA of Benue State.

**Casualty [Male & female]:** Two people (1 male, 1 female) killed.

**Property damaged/Affected population:** Several houses burnt down/community residents.

**Coping Mechanism/Responses:** The State Police Command has commenced investigations to apprehend the perpetrators of the crime.

**Title of Incident: ARMED ATTACK BY SUSPECTED ARMED GANG**

**Scale of incident:** Low

**Date of Occurrence:** 23/1/2022

**Description of Incident:** A 14-year-old herder was reportedly killed in an attack carried out by suspected armed gang in Dong Community, Jos North LGA of Plateau State. The motive behind the attack is unknown.

**Location:** Dong Community, Jos North LGA of Plateau State.

**Casualty [Male & female]:** 14-year-old male killed.

**Property damaged/Affected population:** No property damaged/herder.

**Coping Mechanism/Responses:** The State Police Command has commenced investigations to apprehend the perpetrators of the crime.

🚩 **Description of Incident:** Four (4) people were allegedly killed by stray bullets fired by operatives of the Ebubeagu security outfit during a protest by community youths in Akaeze Community, Ivo LGA of Ebonyi State. The protest reportedly deteriorated with several vehicles, eleven (11) houses and two (2) gas stations burnt down by the protesters in the incident. Preliminary investigations have revealed that the protest occurred following the torture and death of a robbery suspect by Ebubeagu operatives in the State.


