Title of Incident: ARMED ATTACK/ABDUCTION BY SUSPECTED ARMED BANDITS

Scale of incident: Low

Date of Occurrence: 30/1/2022

Description of Incident: The erstwhile administrator of Dogon Dawa Development Area in Birni Gwari LGA of Kaduna State was reportedly killed and several others injured in an attack carried out by suspected armed bandits at Damari Community in the LGA.

Location: Birni Gwari LGA of Kaduna State.

Casualty [Male & female]: One male killed, several people abducted.

Property damaged/Affected population: No property damaged/community residents.

Coping Mechanism/Responses: The State Police Command has commenced investigations to apprehend the perpetrators of the crime.

Incident N*02:

Title of Incident: COMMUNAL CLASH

Scale of incident: Low

Date of Occurrence: 30/1/2022

Description of Incident: Two (2) people including a father and son were reportedly killed in a violent clash between Abanwan and Urugbam Communities over land ownership in Biase LGA of Cross River State. Over six (6) houses and several properties were burnt down in the incident.

Location: Biase LGA of Cross River State.

Casualty [Male & female]: Two males killed.

Property damaged/Affected population: Six houses burnt down/community residents.

Coping Mechanism/Responses: The operatives of the State Police Command have been deployed to maintain peace and security in the affected area.

Incident N*03:

Title of Incident: RIVAL CULT CLASH

Scale of incident: Low

Date of Occurrence: 30/1/2022

Description of Incident: Five (5) people were allegedly killed and seven (7) others injured in a violent clash between suspected cult gangs over funds extorted from developers at Omi-Tuntun Area of Ilesa in Osun State.

Location: Omi-Tuntun Area of Ilesa in Osun State.

Casualty [Male & female]: Five males killed, seven males injured.

Property damaged/Affected population: No property damaged/suspected cult members.

Coping Mechanism/Responses: The operatives of the State Police Command have been deployed to the affected area to maintain peace and security.

Incident N*04:

Title of Incident: ARREST/MURDER

Scale of incident: Low

Date of Occurrence: 30/1/2022

Description of Incident: The operatives of the State Police Command reportedly arrested a male resident for allegedly killing his brother and setting the corpse ablaze in Ekwulobia Community, Aguata LGA of Anambra State. The victim was killed over a land dispute with his brother.

Location: Ekwulobia Community in Aguata LGA of Anambra State.

✚ **Casualty [Male&female]:** One military officer killed, two military officers injured.

✚ **Property damaged/Affected population:** No property damaged/military officers.

✚ **Coping Mechanism/Responses:** The security operatives have been deployed to apprehend the perpetrators of the crime.

✚ **Title of Incident: ARMED ATTACK BY SUSPECTED FULANI MILITIA GANG**

✚ **Scale of incident:** Medium

✚ **Date of Occurrence:** 30/1/2022

✚ **Description of Incident:** Eleven (11) people were reportedly killed and several others injured in an attack carried out by suspected Fulani militia gang at Atak Mawai Community in Zaman Dabo Village, Zango Kataf LGA of Kaduna State. The attackers reportedly burnt down over thirty (30) houses and several food items in the incident.

✚ **Location:** Atak Mawai Community in Zaman Dabo Village, Zango Kataf LGA of Kaduna State.

✚ **Casualty [Male & female]:** Eleven people killed, several people injured.

✚ **Property damaged/Affected population:** Thirty houses and several valuables destroyed/community residents.

✚ **Coping Mechanism/Responses:** The operatives of the State Police Command have been deployed to the affected area to maintain peace and security.

✚ **Incident N*07:**

✚ **Title of Incident: ARREST**

✚ **Scale of incident:** Low

✚ **Date of Occurrence:** 30/1/2022

✚ **Description of Incident:** The officials of the Ondo State Security Outfit 'Amotekun' reportedly arrested a 35-year-old suspected ritual killer for being in possession of human body parts at Ondo town motor park in Ondo State. The suspect was arrested while conveying human parts to Lagos State.

✚ **Location:** Ondo State.

✚ **Casualty [Male & female]:**

✚ **Property damaged/Affected population:** No property damaged/suspected ritual killer.

✚ **Coping Mechanism/Responses:** The arrested suspect is in the custody of the State Police Command for further interrogation.

✚ **Title of Incident: ARMED ATTACK BY SUSPECTED FULANI MILITIA GANG**

✚ **Scale of incident:** Medium

✚ **Date of Occurrence:** 30/1/2022

✚ **Description of Incident:** Eleven (11) people including four females were allegedly killed and several others injured in an attack carried out by suspected Fulani militia gang at Kagoro in Kaura LGA of Kaduna State. Over fifty (50) houses and properties were reportedly destroyed in the incident.

✚ **Location:** Kagoro in Kaura LGA of Kaduna State.

✚ **Casualty [Male&female]:** Eleven people (4 females and 7 females) killed, several people injured.

✚ **Property damaged/Affected population:** Over fifty houses and properties destroyed/community members.
