- **Description of Incident:** Two (2) security guards attached to a gas station were allegedly killed in an attack carried out by suspected armed gang at Ilisan Remo Area in Ikenne LGA of Ogun State. The motive behind the attack is unknown
- **Location:** Ilisan Remo Area in Ikenne LGA of Ogun State.
- ♣ Casualty [Male&female]: Two male security guards killed
- **Property damaged/Affected population:** No property damaged/security guards.
- Coping Mechanism/Responses: The security operatives have been deployed to apprehend the perpetrators of the crime.
