Incident N*01:

- **Title of Incident: ARMED ATTACK BY SUSPECTED ARMED BANDITS**
- Scale of incident: High
- **Date of Occurrence:** 6/3/2022
- Description of Incident: Sixty-eight (68) members of local vigilante group known as 'Yansakai' were allegedly killed and several others injured in an attack carried out by suspected armed bandits in Sakaba/Wasagu LGA of Kebbi State. Preliminary investigations have revealed that the local vigilante members were ambushed while repelling an attack by armed bandits'in the community.
- Location: Sakaba/Wasagu LGA of Kebbi State.
- **Casualty [Male&female]:** Sixty-eight males (local vigilante members) killed, several people injured.
- Property damaged/Affected population: No property damaged/community members.
- **Coping Mechanism/Responses:** There is an ongoing security clearance operation in the region to counter armed bandits' attack in the State.

Incident N*02:

- **Title of Incident: DRUG TRAFFICKING**
- Scale of incident: Low
- Date of Occurrence: 6/3/2022
- **Description of Incident:** The operatives of the National Drug Law Enforcment Agency (NDLEA) reportedly intercepted 8,613kgs of Indian Hemp smuggled in from Ghana through the waterways at the Eko Atlantic Beach in Victoria Island, Lagos State. The seizure was made during a joint examination of a 20ft container with operatives of the Nigeria Customs Service (NCS) in the State.
- **Location:** Eko Atlantic Beach in Victoria Island of Lagos State.
- **Casualty [Male & female]:** No casualty.
- **Property damaged/Affected population:** No property damaged, 8,613kgs of Indian Hemp recovered/suspected drug traffickers.
- **Coping Mechanism/Responses:** The NDLEA has commenced further investigations to apprended members of the drug trafficking syndicate.

Incident N*03:

- Title of Incident: MURDER
- **Scale of incident:** Low
- **♣ Date of Occurrence:** 6/3/2022
- Description of Incident: A military officer was reportedly killed in an attack carried out by members of a loal vigilante group 'Onelga Security Peace and Advisory Committee' at the front of his residence in Obelle Community in Emohua LGA of Rivers State. Preliminary investigations have revealed that the victim was killed following an argument with the vigilante members over the detention of his relatives.
- Location: Obelle Community in Emohua LGA of Rivers State.
- **Casualty [Male & female]:** One male killed.
- Property damaged/Affected population: No property damaged/military officer.
- ← Coping Mechanism/Responses: In reaction to the death, the operatives of the Nigerian Army invaded the community and arrested an undisclosed number of persons with a camp belonging to the local vigilante group burnt down.

- **Description of Incident:** Two (2) people including a businessman and a suspected armed robber were reportedly killed in an attack carried out by suspected armed robbers at Naka Community in Gwer West LGA of Benue State.
- **Location:** Naka Community in Gwer West LGA of Benue State.
- Casualty [Male&female]: Two males killed.
- ♣ Property damaged/Affected population: No property damaged/community member and a suspected armed robber
- **Coping Mechanism/Responses:** The security operatives have been deployed to forestall further attacks in the area.

Incident N*05:

- Title of Incident: ARREST
- Scale of incident: Low
- Date of Occurrence: 6/3/2022
- **Description of Incident:** The operatives of the State Police Command reportedly arrested a 44-year-old male resident for allegedly supplying motorcycles to bandits in Zamfara State. Four (4) motorcycles were recovered in the incident.
- Location: Zamfara State.
- **Casualty [Male & female]:** No casualty.
- **Property damaged/Affected population:** No property damaged, four motorcycles recovered/bandit's logistics supplier.
- **Coping Mechanism/Responses:** The arrested suspect is in the custody of the State Police Command for discreet investigation.

Incident N*06:

- **Title of Incident: PRISON BREAK**
- Scale of incident: Low
- **Date of Occurrence:** 6/3/2022
- Description of Incident: Four (4) people (including three suspected armed bandits and a soldier) detained for refusing to fight against Boko Haram terrorists in Borno State reportedly escaped from the custody of the Nigerian Army at Chari Maigumeri Barracks, Lokoja LGA of Kogi State.
- Location: Chari Maigumeri Barracks, Lokoja LGA of Kogi State.
- **Casualty [Male&female]:** No casualty reported.
- **Property damaged/Affected population:** No property damaged/suspected prisoners.
- Coping Mechanism/Responses: The security operatives have been deployed to apprehend the fleeing prisoners.

Incident N*07:

- **Title of Incident: SHOOTING BY DSS OPERATIVES**
- Scale of incident: Low
- **♣ Date of Occurrence:** 7/3/2022
- Description of Incident: An unidentified officer of the Department of State Service (DSS) reportedly shot a military operative in Lekki Area of Lagos State. The victim who had been unconscious since the incident occurred three-weeks ago died on March 7, 2022.
- Location: Lekki Area of Lagos State.
- Casualty [Male&female]: One military operative dead.
- Property damaged/Affected population: No propery damaged/army officer.
- **Coping Mechanism/Responses:** The Nigerian Army has commenced further investigation into the incident to ascertain the motive behind the attack.

- **Scale of incident:** Low

- **Description of Incident:** The security operatives of the Nigerian Army reportedly killed several suspected members of the Islamic State West Africa Province (ISWAP) group with two vehicles recovered along Damboa-Biu Axis in Damboa LGA of Borno State. The attackers were repelled while trying to invade Damboa town.
- Location: Damboa-Biu Axis in Damboa LGA of Borno State.
- Casualty [Male&female]: Several terrorists killed.
- Property damaged/Affected population: Two vehicles recovered/terrorists.
- **Coping Mechanism/Responses:** There is an ongoing security clearance operation to counter terrorist attacks in the LGA.

Incident N*09:

- Title of Incident: MURDERScale of incident: Low
- **Date of Occurrence:** 7/3/2022
- ♣ Description of Incident: The head of Gbagura Community in Abeokuta North LGA of Ogun State was reportedly killed in an attack carried out by suspected hoodlums at his residence in the LGA. The attackers reportedly set ablaze the victim in the incident. The motive behind the attack is unknown.
- Location: Abeokuta North LGA of Ogun State
- Casualty [Male & female]: One male killed.
- **Property damaged/Affected population:** No property damaged/traditional ruler.
- **Coping Mechanism/Responses:** The State Police Command has commenced investigations to apprehend the perpetrators of ther crime.

Incident N*10:

- **Title of Incident: ARMED ATTACK BY SUSPECTED ARMED BANDITS**
- Scale of incident: Medium
- Date of Occurrence: 8/3/2022
- **Description of Incident:** Nineteen (19) security operatives were allegedly killed and eight (8) other operatives injured in a shootout between security operatives and suspected armed bandits following an attack on the convoy of the Deputy Governor of Kebbi State at Kanya Village in Dangu Wasagu LGA of Kebbi State. The victims include, thirteen military operatives, six police officers and a local vigilante member.
- Location: Kanya Village in Wasagu LGA of Kebbi State.
- **Casualty [Male&female]:** Nineteen security operatives killed, eight operatives injured.
- ♣ Property damaged/Affected population: No property damaged/security operatives.
- **Coping Mechanism/Responses:** The security operatives have been deployed to forestall further attacks in the area

Incident N*11:

- **♣** Title of Incident: VIOLENT CLASH BETWEEN ETHNIC YORUBA AND HAUSA YOUTHS/ARSON
- **Scale of incident:** Low
- **♣ Date of Occurrence:** 8/3/2022
- → Description of Incident: Several people were reportedly injured and several shops set ablaze in a violent clash between ethnic Yoruba and Hausa youths at Lafenwa market in Abeokuta LGA of Ogun State. Preliminary investigations have revealed that the fight between two (2) people from the ethnic groups deteriorated into violence following a rumour that an ethnic Hausa man was killed in the incident.
- Location: Lafenwa market in Abeokuta LGA of Ogun State.
- Casualty [Male&female]: Several people injured.
- Property damaged/Affected population: Several shops set ablaze/community members.
- **Coping Mechanism/Responses:** The security operatives have been deployed to restore peace and security in the affected area.

- Description of Incident: One (1) suspected drug trafficker was reportedly killed and seven (7) NDLEA operatives injured in a shootout between operatives of the Nigeria Drug Law Enforcement Agency (NDLEA) and suspected illicit drug traffickers at ATC Axis in Jalingo LGA of Taraba State. Preliminary investigation have revealed that the suspected drug traffickers attacked NDLEA operatives following the arrest of a suspected drug trafficker in the area. The NDLEA operatives had invaded Nukai market along Jalingo-Wukari Road in Taraba State to arrest the drug trafficker and also evacuate illicit substances from the suspects' warehouse.
- **Location:** ATC Axis in Jalingo LGA of Taraba State.
- **← Casualty [Male&female]:** One male killed, seven males injured
- **Property damaged/Affected population:** No property damaged/suspected illicit drug traffickers.
- 4 Coping Mechanism/Responses: The attack was repelled by NDLEA operatives in the area.

Incident N*13

- Title of Incident: ABDUCTION
- Scale of incident: Low
- Date of Occurrence: 8/3/2022
- Description of Incident: Two (2) siblings aged 20 and 15-years-old were reportedly abducted in an attack carried out by suspected armed gang at Oremeji Street in Joga Area of Ayetoro, Yewa North LGA of Ogun State. The attackers also reported injured an aged man in the incident. Kidnapping for ransom has largely been attributed as the motive behind the criminality in the State.
- **Location:** Joga Area of Ayetoro in Yewa North LGA of Ogun State.
- **Casualty [Male & female]:** Two people abducted, one male injured.
- Property damaged/Affected population: No property damaged/community residents.
- **Coping Mechanism/Responses:** The State Police Command has commenced investigations to rescue the abducted victims.

Incident N*14:

- **Title of Incident: ARMED ACTION**
- Scale of incident: Low
- **♣ Date of Occurrence:** 8/3/2022
- **Description of Incident:** The operatives of the State Police Command reportedly repelled an attack carried out by suspected armed bandits on Barewa Village in Batagarawa LGA of Katsina State and recovered six (6) motorcycles in the incident. Several suspected armed bandits escaped with gunshot injuries in the incident. Preliminary investigations have revealed that the bandits were seen riding on motorcycles and armed with AK-47 rifles heading to Barewa Village when police operatives were alerted.
- ♣ Location: Barewa Village in Batagarawa LGA of Katsina State
- **Casualty [Male & female]:** No reported casualty, several suspected armed bandits injured.
- Property damaged/Affected population: No property damaged/suspected armed bandits.
- **Coping Mechanism/Responses:** There is an ongoing security clearance operation to counter armed bandits attack in the State.

- **Description of Incident:** An operative of the Ogun State security outfit 'So-Safe Corps' was reportedly killed in an attack carried out by suspected armed gang during security patrol at Areke Area in Sagamu LGA of Ogun State.
- Location: Areke Area in Sagamu LGA of Ogun State.
- Casualty [Male&female]: One male killed.
- **Property damaged/Affected population:** No property damaged/security operative.
- Coping Mechanism/Responses: The security operatives have been deployed to apprehend the perpetrators of the crime.

Preliminary investigations have revealed that the victims were assaulted for not paying the fee demanded by the hoodlums. The association has further raised an alarm following the collection of illegal multiple levies from bus drivers in
- Location: Upper Iweka Axis in Onitsha, Anambra State.
- Casualty [Male & female]: Three people injured.
- Property damaged/Affected population: No property damaged/officials of the Drivers Welfare Association.
- Coping Mechanism/Responses: The operatives of security agencies have been deployed to maintain peace and security in the affected area.

Title of Incident: COMMUNAL CLASH

Scale of incident: Medium Date of Occurrence: 8/3/2022

- ♣ Description of Incident: Eight (8) people were allegedly killed and four (4) others injured in a violent clash over land ownership between Alesi Community in Ikom LGA and Ochon Community in Obubra LGA of Cross River State. Over 2,008 people were internally displaced from their ancestral homes with several houses destroyed in the incident.
- Location: Cross River State.
- Casualty [Male & female]: Eight people killed, four people injured, 2,008 people internally displaced.
- Property damaged/Affected population: Several houses destroyed/community residents.
- Coping Mechanism/Responses: There is an ongoing on-the-spot assessment of the crisis in the affected communities by security agencies and officials of the National Emergency Management Agency (NEMA) in the State.

Incident N*18:

- Title of Incident: ARMED ATTACK BY SUSPECTED ARMED HERDERS
- Scale of incident: Medium **♣ Date of Occurrence:** 8/3/2022
- Description of Incident: Seven (7) people were reportedly killed and several others injured in an attack carried out by suspected armed herders at Tor Damisa Village in Donga LGA of Taraba State. Preliminary investigations have revealed that the reprisal attack by armed herders occurred following the injury of a herder by suspected ethnic Tiv militia gang while rearing his cattle.
- Location: Tor Damisa Village in Donga LGA of Taraba State.
- Casualty [Male & female]: Seven males killed, several people injured.
- Property damaged/Affected population: No property damaged/community residents.
- Coping Mechanism/Responses: The injured victims have been taken to the hospital for medical treatment. Also, security operatives have been deployed to the affected village to maintain peace and security.

Incident N*19:

- Title of Incident: ARMED ATTACK/ABDUCTION BY SUSPECTED ARMED BANDITS
- Scale of incident: Low
- Date of Occurrence: 8/3/2022
- Description of Incident: Two (2) people including a security guard were allegedly killed and four (4) others including a catholic priest abducted in an attack carried out by suspected armed bandits in Kudendan Community of Kaduna Metropolis in Kaduna State. Kidnapping for ransom has largely been attributed as the motive behind the criminality in the State.

- Casualty [Male&female]: One male killed, one male injured
- Property damaged/Affected population: No property damaged/motorcycle thief and a community resident.
- **Coping Mechanism/Responses:** The State Police Command has arrested four (4) suspects in connection with the crime for further investigation.

Incident N*21:

- **↓** Title of Incident: ARMED ATTACK BY SUSPECTED ARMED HERDERS
- Scale of incident: Medium
- **Date of Occurrence:** 9/3/2022
- ♣ Description of Incident: Thirteen (13) people were reportedly killed and two (2) others injured in separate attacks carried out by suspected armed herders at Tse-Ahentse, Iye and Udei Communities in Ndzorov Council Ward in Guma LGA of Benue State. The motive behind the attack is unknown.
- Location: Tse-Ahentse, Iye and Udei Communities in Ndzorov Council Ward in Guma LGA of Benue State
- **Casualty [Male&female]:** Thirteen people killed, two people injured.
- Property damaged/Affected population: No property damaged/community members.
- **Coping Mechanism/Responses:** The security operatives have been deployed to forestall further attacks in the affected area. Also, the injured victims have been taken to the hospital for medical treatment.

Incident N*22:

- **Title of Incident: ARMED ATTACK BY SUSPECTED ARMED BANDITS**
- **Scale of incident:** Low
- Date of Occurrence: 9/3/2022
- Description of Incident: Three (3) people were reportedly killed and several others injured in an attack carried out by suspected armed bandits in Anguwan-Toma Community in Munya LGA of Niger State. The attackers also carted away with several food items in the incident.
- Location: Anguwan-Toma Community in Munya LGA of Niger State.
- **Casualty [Male & female]:** Three people killed, several people abducted.
- Property damaged/Affected population: Several food items stolen/community residents.
- **Coping Mechanism/Responses:** The operatives of security agencies have been deployed to the affected area to maintain peace and security.

- **Property damaged/Affected population:** No property damaged, several cattle rustled/community residents.
- **Coping Mechanism/Responses:** The operatives of security agencies have been deployed to maintain peace and security in the affected community.

- **Description of Incident:** A poultry farmer was reportedly killed in an attack carried out by suspected armed gang at his poultry farm in Ago Aduloju Area in Ado-Ekiti LGA of Ekiti State. The motive behind the attack is unknown.
- Location: Ago Aduloju Area in Ado-Ekiti LGA of Ekiti State.
- Casualty [Male&female]: One male killed.
- **Property damaged/Affected population:** No property damaged/poutry farmer.
- Coping Mechanism/Responses: The security operatives have commenced investigations to ascertain the motive behind the attack and to apprehend the perpetrators of the crime.

- **Casualty [Male&female]:** One male killed.
- Property damaged/Affected population: No property damaged/newspaper vendor.
- **Coping Mechanism/Responses:** The security operatives have been deployed to apprehend the perpetrators of the crime.
