- **Title of Incident: ARMED ATTACK BY SUSPECTED ARMED ROBBERS**
- **♣ Scale of incident:** Low
- **♣ Date of Occurrence:** 10/4/2022
- **Description of Incident:** Suspected armed robbers reportedly invaded a radion station around Challenge Area in Ibadan South-East LGA of Oyo State and carted away several valuables in the incident.
- **Location:** Challenge Area in Ibadan South-East LGA of Oyo State.
- Casualty [Male&female]: No casualty reported.
- Property damaged/Affected population: Several valuables stolen/staff members.
- Coping Mechanism/Responses: The State Police Command has commenced investigations to apprehend the perpetrators of the crime.

Incident N*02:

- Title of Incident: MURDER
- **Scale of incident:** Low
- **Date of Occurrence:** 10/4/2022
- **Description of Incident:** Two (2) people including a mother and her 4-year-old daughter were reportedly killed in an attack carried out by unidentified assailants at their residence in Labana Rice Mills Area at Sani Abacha Bypass Road, Birnin Kebbi LGA of Kebbi State. Preliminary investigations have revealed that the body parts of the victims were severed. The motive behind the attack is unknown.
- Location: Labana Rice Mills Area in Sani Abacha Bypass Road in Birnin Kebbi LGA of Kebbi State.
- Casualty [Male & female]: Two people (1 female and a 4-year-old child) killed.
- **Property damaged/Affected population:** No property damaged/community residents.
- **Coping Mechanism/Responses:** The State Police Command has commenced investigations to apprehend the perpetrators of the crime.

Incident N*03:

- **Title of Incident: ARMED ATTACK BY SUSPECTED ARMED GANG**
- Scale of incident: High
- Date of Occurrence: 10/4/2022
- → Description of Incident: Twenty-six (26) people were reportedly killed and seventeen (17) houses destroyed in coordinated attacks carried out by suspected armed gang at Ohagelede, Umuezeoka, Ebbiaji and Ebbeta Villages in Effium/Ezza-Effium Community, Ohaukwu LGA of Ebonyi State. Preliminary investigations have revealed that the attack is linked to the protracted Effium/Ezza-Effium communal violence in the LGA.
- **Location:** Ohagelede, Umuezeoka, Ebbiaji and Ebbeta Villages in Effium/Ezza-Effium Community in Ohaukwu LGA of Ebonyi State.
- Casualty [Male & female]: Twenty-six people killed.
- **Property damaged/Affected population:** Seveenteen houses damaged/community residents.
- **Coping Mechanism/Responses:** The operatives of security agencies have been deployed to the affected villages to maintain peace and security.

Incident N*04:

- **Title of Incident: ARMED ATTACK/ABDUCTION/ARSON BY SUSPECTED ARMED BANDITS**
- Scale of incident: High
- **♣ Date of Occurrence**: 10/4/2022

- Description of Incident: 106 people were reportedly killed and over 20 people injured in coordinated attacks carried out by suspected armed bandits at Kyaram, Gyambau, Dungur, Kukawa and Shuwaka Villages in Garga District, Kanam LGA of Plateau State. The attackers also abducted 70 people with over 100 houses/shops and 8 motorcycles burnt down in the incident. However, there are conflicting reports on the statistics of fatalities in the incident.
 - According to the Ministry of Humanitarian Affairs, Disaster Management and Social Development, the coordinated attacks on the communities by suspected armed bandits resulted in the internal displacement of over 4800 people.
- **Location:** Kyaram, Gyambau, Dungur, Kukawa and Shuwaka Villages in Garga District, Kanam LGA of Plateau State.
- **Casualty [Male&female]:** 106 people killed, 20 people injured, 70 people abducted.
- ♣ Property damaged/Affected population: Over 100 houses/shops and 8 motorcycles burnt down/farmers and community members.
- **Coping Mechanism/Responses:** The operatives of security agencies have been deployed to the affected villages to forestall further attacks as well as maintain peace and security.

Incident N*05:

- **Title of Incident: ABDUCTION**
- **Scale of incident:** Low
- **♣** Date of Occurrence: 10/4/2022
- **Description of Incident:** Two (2) people were reportedly abducted in an attack carried out by suspected armed gang at the venue of a local thrift contribution meeting locally called 'Bam' at Tine Nune Community, Mbatian Council Ward in Ukum LGA of Benue State. Kidnapping for ransom has largely been attributed as the motive behind the criminality in the State.
- **Location:** Tine Nune Community, Mbatian Council Ward in Ukum LGA of Benue State.
- Casualty [Male&female]: Two males abducted.
- **Property damaged/Affected population:** No property damaged/community members.
- **Coping Mechanism/Responses:** The security operatives have been deployed to rescue the abducted victims and apprehend the perpetrators of the crime.

Incident N*06:

- **▼** Title of Incident: ARMED ATTACK BY UNIDENTIFIED GUNMEN/REPRISAL ATTACKS
- ♣ Scale of incident: Medium
- **♣ Date of Occurrence:** 10/4/2022
- ♣ Description of Incident: A community leader was allegedly killed in an attack carried out by suspected armed bandits at his residence in Kakura Community, Chikun LGA of Kaduna State. Prior to the attack, the victim was installed as the new Head of the Community. The motive behind the attack is unknown.
 - In a reprisal attack, aggrieved natives of Gbagyi allegedly attacked a Fulani settlement in the LGA and killed fourteen (14) people in the incident.
- **Location:** Kakura Community in Chikun LGA of Kaduna State.
- Casualty [Male&female]: Fifteen people killed.
- **Property damaged/Affected population:** No property damaged/community leader.
- **Coping Mechanism/Responses:** The security operatives have been deployed to the affected community to apprehend the perpetrators of the crime and also unravel the motive behind the attack.

Incident N*07:

- **Title of Incident: ARMED ATTACK BY SUSPECTED HOODLUMS**
- **Scale of incident:** Medium
- **♣** Date of Occurrence: 10/4/2022
- **Description of Incident:** Six (6) people including a pregnant woman were allegedly killed and seven (7) houses set ablaze in an attack carried out by suspected hoodlums at Ohaogelode Community in Izzi LGA of Ebonyi State. Preliminary investigation revealed that the affected community have been enmeshed in a protracted intra-

- Description of Incident: An 18-year-old female was reportedly abducted in an attack carried out by suspected hoodlums in Lokoja LGA of Kogi State. Kidnapping for ransom has largely been attributed as the motive behind the criminality in the State.

- Casualty [Male&female]: 18-year-old female abducted.

The motive behind the attack is unknown.
- **Location:** Igangan Area of Atakumosa East LGA of Osun State.
- **Casualty [Male&female]:** One male killed, two people (1 female and 1 child) injured.
- **Property damaged/Affected population:** No property damaged/community members.
- **Coping Mechanism/Responses:** The security operatives have been deployed to apprehend the perpetrators of the crime.

- Description of Incident: A District head was reportedly killed and several others injured in an attack carried out by suspected armed gang during prayers at a mosque in Maisamari Town, Sardauna LGA of Taraba State. The motive behind the attack is unknown.
- **Location:** Maisamari Town in Sardauna LGA of Taraba State.
- **Casualty [Male&female]:** One male killed, several people injured.
- **Property damaged/Affected population:** No property damaged/district head and community residents.
- Coping Mechanism/Responses: The security operatives have been deployed to apprehend the perpetrators of the crime.

Incident N*26:

- **Title of Incident: ARMED ACTION**
- Scale of incident: Low
- Date of Occurrence: 11/4/2022
- **Description of Incident:** An undisclosed number of suspects were reportedly neutralized with sixteen (16) abducted victims including women and children rescued during security offensive operation conducted by the Nigerian Army in Kaduna State. Several arms, ammunition, money and mobile phones were reportedly recovered in the incident. Several suspected logistics suppliers were also arrested in the incident.
- **Location:** Kaduna State.
- Casualty [Male&female]: Several suspected armed bandits killed, sixteen abducted victims rescued.
