Title of Incident: ARMED ROBBERY

Scale of incident: Low

Date of Occurrence: 17/4/2022

Description of Incident: Suspected armed robbers reportedly attacked a restaurant at Oko Community in Ekwulobia Axis of Anambra State and dispossessed staff members and customers of their valuables and money

Location: Oko Community in Ekwulobia Axis of Anambra State.

Casualty [Male&female]: No casualty reported.

Property damaged/Affected population: Several valuables and money stolen/community members.

Coping Mechanism/Responses: The security operatives have been deployed to apprehend the perpetrators of the crime.

Title of Incident: ARMED ATTACK/ABDUCTION BY SUSPECTED ARMED BANDITS

Scale of incident: Low

Date of Occurrence: 17/4/2022

Description of Incident: Four (4) people were allegedly killed and four (4) others abducted in an attack carried out by suspected armed bandits at Angwar Bulus Community in Kajuru LGA of Kaduna State. Kidnapping for ransom has largely been attributed as the motive behind the criminality in the State.

Location: Angwar Bulus Community in Kajuru LGA of Kaduna State.

Casualty [Male&female]: Four males killed, four males abducted.

Property damaged/Affected population: No property damaged/community members.

Coping Mechanism/Responses: The security operatives have been deployed to rescue the abducted victims and apprehend the perpetrators of the crime.

Incident N*03:

Title of Incident: SHOOTING BY MILITARY OPERATIVES

Scale of incident: Low

Date of Occurrence: 17/4/2022

Description of Incident: Four (4) people were reportedly killed in a shoot-out between military operatives and suspected members of the Indigenous People of Biafra (IPOB) at Ihioma Community in Orlu LGA of Imo State. Preliminary investigations have revealed that the military operatives invaded several communities in the LGA in search of suspected IPOB members.

Location: Ihioma Community in Orlu LGA of Imo State.

Casualty [Male & female]: Four males killed.

Property damaged/Affected population: No property damaged/community residents.

Coping Mechanism/Responses: There is an ongoing security operation across volatile communities to apprehend suspected IPOB members causing mayhem in the State.

Description of Incident: The State Police Command reportedly rescued a suspected kidnapper from being

Members of the IPOB agitating for a separate Biafra nation have been responsible for major cases of killings and arson in the State.

Preliminary investigations have revealed that the victims were among the twenty-six (26) villagers abducted on March 21, 2022.

✚ **Location:** Dutse Community along Kaduna-Abuja Highway of Kaduna State.

✚ **Casualty [Male&female]:** Three males killed

✚ **Property damaged/Affected population:** No property damaged/community members.

✚ **Coping Mechanism/Responses:** There is an ongoing security clearance operation in the State to counter armed bandits' attacks and also rescue other abducted victims.

✚ **Casualty [Male&female]:** Seven males killed, nineteen people injured.

✚ **Property damaged/Affected population:** Several properties destroyed/community members.

✚ **Coping Mechanism/Responses:** The security operatives have been deployed to the affected area to maintain peace and security. Also, the affected area has been cordoned off by security operatives.
