#### **Incident N\*01:**

**Title of Incident: ARMED ATTACK BY SUSPECTED ARMED BANDITS**

**Scale of incident:** High

**Date of Occurrence:** 20/3/2022

**Description of Incident:** Twenty-four (24) people including the village head and three (3) other traditional title holders were allegedly killed in an attack carried out by suspected armed bandits at Ganar-Kiyawa Village in Bukkuyum LGA of Zamfara State. Several domestic animals and valuables were looted in the incident.

**Location:** Ganar-Kiyawa Village in Bukkuyum LGA of Zamfara State.

**Casualty [Male&female]:** Twenty-four people killed.

**Property damaged/Affected population:** Several domestic animals and valuables stolen/community members.

**Coping Mechanism/Responses:** The security operatives have been deployed to apprehend the perpetrators of the crime.

#### **Incident N\*02:**

**Title of Incident: HOMICIDE**

**Scale of incident:** Low

**Date of Occurrence:** 20/3/2022

**Description of Incident:** An 18-year-old boy allegedly stabbed his elder brother to death following a misunderstanding at their residence around Games Village Area in Bauchi State.

**Location:** Games Village Area in Bauchi State.

**Casualty [Male & female]:** One male killed.

**Property damaged/Affected population:** No property damaged/community residents.

**Coping Mechanism/Responses:** The operatives of the State Police Command have arrested the suspect in connection with the crime.

#### **Incident N\*03:**

**Title of Incident: ARMED ATTACK/RESCUE OPERATIONS**

**Scale of incident:** Low

**Date of Occurrence:** 20/3/2022

**Description of Incident:** The woman leader of Koro Ward for the All Progressive Congress (APC) in Ekiti LGA of Kwara State was reportedly killed during a rescue operation by members of the local vigilante group in Kwara State. The victim was killed by stray bullets during an exchange of gunfire with the kidnapers. Preliminary investigations have revealed that the victim was among the three (3) ward women leaders earlier abducted in the State.

**Location:** Kwara State.

**Casualty [Male & female]:** One female killed.

**Property damaged/Affected population:** No property damaged/woman leader of the APC.

**Coping Mechanism/Responses:** The operatives of security agencies have been deployed to maintain peace and security in the State.

#### **Incident N\*04:**

**Title of Incident: ARMED ATTACK BY SUSPECTED ARMED HERDERS/RIOT/REPRISAL ATTACKS**

**Scale of incident:** High

**Date of Occurrence:** 20/3/2022

🚩 **Description of Incident:** Thirty-four (34) people were allegedly killed and seven (7) others injured in an attack carried out by suspected armed herders in Agban and Maraban Kagoro Communities in Kaura LGA of Kaduna State. Over 200 houses were reportedly burnt down in the incident. The attack also reportedly triggered reprisal attacks from community youths resulting in the death of three (3) people in Maraban Kagoro Axis in Kaura LGA with two (2) herders' settlements at Zauru and Kurdan Villages in Zango-Kataf LGA of Kaduna State burnt down in the incident. Out of the total fatalities (37) were two operatives of the Operation Safe Haven (OPS), 8 females and 2 children.

🚩 **Location:** Kaura and Zango-Kataf LGAs of Kaduna State.

🚩 **Casualty [Male&female]:** Thirty-seven people (including 2 security operatives, 8 females and 2 children) killed, seven people injured.

🚩 **Property damaged/Affected population:** Several properties and 200 houses destroyed/community members and security operatives.

🚩 **Coping Mechanism/Responses:** The security operatives have been deployed to forstall further attacks in the affected LGAs.

### 🚩 **Incident N\*05:**

🚩 **Title of Incident:** ARMED ATTACK BY SUSPECTED ARMED BANDITS/ARMED ACTION

🚩 **Scale of incident:** Low

🚩 **Date of Occurrence:** 20/3/2022

🚩 **Description of Incident:** Operatives of the Nigerian Army reportedly repelled an attack on traders by suspected armed bandits along Sokoto-Goronyo Road in Sokoto State. Preliminary investigations have revealed that the attackers had previously mounted road blocks along the road killing and abducting several traders that ply the road to Goronyo for their weekly market.

🚩 **Location:** Sokoto-Goronyo Road in Sokoto State.

🚩 **Casualty [Male & female]:** No reported casualty.

🚩 **Property damaged/Affected population:** Nor property damaged/traders.

🚩 **Coping Mechanism/Responses:** There is an ongoing security clearance operation in the State to counter armed bandits' attack.

### 🚩 **Incident N\*06:**

🚩 **Title of Incident:** ARMED ACTION

🚩 **Scale of incident:** Low

🚩 **Date of Occurrence:** 20/3/2022

🚩 **Description of Incident:** Operatives of the State Police Command reportedly killed four (4) hoodlums suspected to be members of the Indigenous People of Biafra (IPOB) and several other hoodlums injured in shootout incident following an attack on Omuma Police Station in Oru East LGA of Imo State. Several arms and ammunition including explosives devices were also recovered from the attackers.

🚩 **Location:** Oru East LGA of Imo State.

🚩 **Casualty [Male&female]:** Four male suspected IPOB members killed, several suspected IPOB members injured.

🚩 **Property damaged/Affected population:** Several arms and ammunition recovered/suspected IPOB members.

🚩 **Coping Mechanism/Responses:** The security operatives have been deployed to apprehend the perpetrators of the crime.

### 🚩 **Incident N\*07:**

🚩 **Title of Incident:** ABDUCTION

🚩 **Scale of incident:** Low

🚩 **Date of Occurrence:** 20/3/2022

🚩 **Description of Incident:** Five (5) people were reportedly abducted in an attack carried out by suspected armed gang along Ubijaja-Ewatto Road in Ubijaja Esan South-East LGA of Edo State. Kidnapping for ransom has largely been attributed as the motive behind the criminality in the State.

🚩 **Location:** Ubijaja-Ewatto Road in Ubijaja Esan South-East LGA of Edo State.

🚩 **Casualty [Male & female]:** Five males abducted.

🚩 **Property damaged/Affected population:** No property damaged/university lecturer and commuters.

✚ **Description of Incident:** Two (2) people were allegedly killed and several others injured in an attack carried out by members of a suspected rival cult gang at Adio Bus Stop in Ijanikin Ile-Oba Area of Lagos State. Supremacy tussle and revenge attacks have been attributed to the recurring cult clashes in the State.

✚ **Location:** Adio Bus Stop in Ijanikin Ile-Oba Area of Lagos State.

✚ **Casualty [Male&female]:** Two males killed, several people injured.

✚ **Property damaged/Affected population:** No property damaged/suspected cult members.

✚ **Coping Mechanism/Responses:** The security operatives have been deployed to apprehend the perpetrators of the crime.

#### ✚ **Incident N\*09:**

✚ **Title of Incident: VIOLENT CLASH**

✚ **Scale of incident:** Low

✚ **Date of Occurrence:** 20/3/2022

✚ **Description of Incident:** Two (2) people were allegedly killed and two (2) others injured in a violent clash between community youths and operatives of the State Joint Security Task Force at Iluju Community in Oriire LGA of Oyo State. The clash occurred following a misunderstanding between community youths which deteriorated resulting in the killing of a community resident by security operatives. In a reprisal attack, a security operative was killed and a security patrol vehicle damaged in the incident.

✚ **Location:** Iluju Community in Oriire LGA of Oyo State.

✚ **Casualty [Male&female]:** Two males killed, two people injured.

✚ **Property damaged/Affected population:** No property damaged/community members.

✚ **Coping Mechanism/Responses:** The injured victims have been taken to the hospital for medical treatment. Also, police operatives have been deployed to the affected area to maintain peace and security.

#### ✚ **Incident N\*10:**

✚ **Title of Incident: MURDER**

✚ **Scale of incident:** Low

✚ **Date of Occurrence:** 20/3/2022

✚ **Description of Incident:** One (1) female was reportedly killed in an attack carried out by unknown assailants at a hotel along Nyiman Layout of Makurdi LGA of Benue State. The motive behind the attack and the identity of the assailants is unknown.

✚ **Location:** Nyiman Layout of Makurdi LGA in Benue State.

✚ **Casualty [Male & female]:** One female killed.

✚ **Property damaged/Affected population:** No property damaged/female resident.

✚ **Coping Mechanism/Responses:** Operatives of the State Police Command has arrested three (3) suspects in connection with the crime.

#### ✚ **Incident N\*11:**

✚ **Title of Incident: ABDUCTION BY SUSPECTED ARMED BANDITS**

✚ **Scale of incident:** Low

✚ **Date of Occurrence:** 20/3/2022

✚ **Description of Incident:** One (1) person was reportedly abducted with his 40 cows stolen in an attack carried out by suspected armed bandits at Unguwar Fulani in Barkiya Village, Kurfi LGA of Katsina State.

✚ **Location:** Unguwar Fulani in Barkiya Village, Kurfi LGA of Katsina State.

✚ **Casualty [Male&female]:** No casualty reported, one male abducted.

✚ **Property damaged/Affected population:** Forty cows stolen/community member.

✚ **Description of Incident:** A 60-year-old female was reportedly abducted in an attack carried out by suspected armed bandits at Gambanda Magero Area in Gummi LGA of Zamfara State. Kidnapping for ransom has largely been attributed as the motive behind the criminality in the State.

✚ **Location:** Gambanda Magero Area in Gummi LGA of Zamfara State.

✚ **Casualty [Male & female]:** One female abducted.

✚ **Property damaged/Affected population:** No property damaged/60-year-old female.

✚ **Coping Mechanism/Responses:** The State Police Command has commenced investigations to rescue the abducted victim.

✚ **Incident N\*13:**

✚ **Title of Incident: CURFEW DECLARED BY THE KADUNA STATE GOVERNMENT**

✚ **Scale of incident:** Low

✚ **Date of Occurrence:** 21/3/2022

✚ **Description of Incident:** The Kaduna State Government has declared a 24-hour curfew in Jema'a and Kaura LGA of Kaduna State to curb the spread of violence to other communities and avert further loss of lives and properties<sup>1</sup>. The curfew was declared following the attack by suspected militia herders and reprisal attacks in Agban and Maraban Kagoro Communities in Kaura LGA of Kaduna State that resulted in the death of 37 people with 7 others injured.

✚ **Location:** Kaduna State.

✚ **Casualty [Male & female]:** No reported casualty.

✚ **Property damaged/Affected population:** No property damaged/community residents.

✚ **Coping Mechanism/Responses:** The operatives of security agencies have been deployed to the LGAs to enforce the curfew declared by the State Government.

✚ **Incident N\*14:**

✚ **Title of Incident: ARSON/CATTLE RUSTLING/ABDUCTION BY SUSPECTED ARMED GANG**

✚ **Scale of incident:** Low

✚ **Date of Occurrence:** 21/3/2022

✚ **Description of Incident:** Several houses and food items were reportedly burnt down in an attack carried out by suspected armed gang at Pinua Village in Wase LGA of Plateau State. The attackers also abducted two (2) herders and rustled about 400 cattle in the area.

✚ **Location:** Pinua Village in Wase LGA of Plateau State.

✚ **Casualty [Male & female]:** No reported casualty, two male herders abducted.

✚ **Property damaged/Affected population:** Several houses and food items burnt down, 400 cattle rustled/community residents.

✚ **Coping Mechanism/Responses:** The operatives of security agencies have been deployed to the affected area to maintain peace and security.

✚ **Incident N15:**

✚ **Date of Occurrence:** 21/3/2022

🚧 **Property damaged/Affected population:** No property damaged/community resident.

🚧 **Coping Mechanism/Responses:** The State Police Command has commenced investigations to ascertain the motive behind the killing. Also, members of the Arewa Progressive Forum conducted a peaceful protest at the Agbor Police Area Command in Agbor-Obi Axis of the State to demand justice for the victim.

🚧 **Casualty [Male & female]:** Four people (3 police officers and 1 female) killed.

🚧 **Property damaged/Affected population:** No property damaged/police operatives and a female resident.

🚧 **Coping Mechanism/Responses:** The operatives of security agencies have been deployed to the affected LGA to maintain peace and security.

#### 🚧 **Incident N\*18:**

🚧 **Title of Incident:** EXTRAJUDICIAL KILLING/ARREST

🚧 **Scale of incident:** Medium

🚧 **Date of Occurrence:** 22/3/2022

🚧 **Description of Incident:** Operatives of the Nigerian Army reportedly arrested a military operative for allegedly killing seven (7) people including a three-year-old girl with sixteen (16) others injured in shooting incident at Mafa Market in Mafa LGA of Borno State. The Nigerian Army attributed the incident to 'post-traumatic stress disorder' and drug abuse.

🚧 **Location:** Mafa Market in Mafa LGA of Borno State.

🚧 **Casualty [Male&female]:** Seven people (6 males and a 3-year-old child), sixteen people injured.

🚧 **Property damaged/Affected population:** No property damaged/community members.

🚧 **Coping Mechanism/Responses:** The arrested suspect is in the custody of the Nigerian Army for further investigation. Also, the injured victims have been taken to the hospital for medical treatment.

#### 🚧 **Incident N\*19:**

Preliminary investigations have revealed that the victim was earlier abducted and killed after he resisted their attempt to steal his vehicle.

✚ **Location:** Rumuodogo Community in Emohua LGA of Rivers State.

✚ **Casualty [Male & female]:** One male killed.

✚ **Property damaged/Affected population:** No property damaged/community resident.

✚ **Coping Mechanism/Responses:** The State Police Command has commenced investigations to apprehend the perpetrators of the crime.
