##### **Incident N\*01:**

**Title of Incident: ABDUCTION**

**Scale of incident:** Medium

**Date of Occurrence:** 27/3/2022

**Description of Incident:** Forty-five (45) people including a Catholic priest were reportedly abducted in an attack carried out by suspected armed bandits at Sarkin Pawa-Gwada Road in Munya LGA of Niger State. The attackers also burnt down several food barns and a truck in the incident. Preliminary investigations have revealed that 44 of the abducted victims were among those who returned to their communities from IDP camps. Kidnapping for ransom has largely been attributed as the motive behind the criminality in the State.

In a related development, an undisclosed number of people including an elderly man was set ablaze in an attack carried out by suspected armed bandits in Zagzaga Community in Munya LGA of Niger State.

**Location:** Sarkin Pawa-Gwada Road and Zagzaga Community in Munya LGA of Niger State.

**Casualty [Male&female]:** Forty-five people abducted, undisclosed number of people including an elderly man killed.

**Property damaged/Affected population:** Several food barns and a truck burnt down/community members and a catholic priest.

**Coping Mechanism/Responses:** Operatives of security agencies have been deployed to rescue the abducted victims and apprehend the perpetrators of the crime.

##### **Incident N\*02:**

**Title of Incident: RIVAL CULT CLASH**

**Scale of incident:** Medium

**Date of Occurrence:** 27/3/2022

**Description of Incident:** Sixteen (16) people were reportedly killed in violent clashes between suspected cult gangs at Panseke, Onikoko, Onikolobo, Oluwo, Adigbe Areas of Abeokuta Metropolis in Ogun State. Supremacy tussle and revenge attacks have been attributed to the recurring cult clashes in the State.

**Location:** Panseke, Onikoko, Onikolobo, Oluwo, Adigbe Areas of Abeokuta Metropolis in Ogun State.

**Casualty [Male & female]:** Sixteen males killed.

**Property damaged/Affected population:** No property damaged/suspected cult members.

**Coping Mechanism/Responses:** Operatives of the State Police Command have been deployed to the affected areas to maintain peace and security.

##### **Incident N\*03:**

**Title of Incident: ARREST OF SUSPECTED DRUG TRAFFICKERS**

**Scale of incident:** Low

**Date of Occurrence:** 27/3/2022

**Description of Incident:** Operatives of the National Drug Law Enforcement Agency (NDLEA) reportedly arrested seven (7) suspected drug traffickers at the Murtala Muhammed International Airport in Ikeja LGA of Lagos State.

**Location:** Murtala Muhammed International Airport in Ikeja LGA of Lagos State.

**Casualty [Male&female]:** No casualty reported.

**Property damaged/Affected population:** No property damaged/suspected drug traffickers.

**Coping Mechanism/Responses:** The arrested suspects are in the custody of the NDLEA for further interrogation.

🚩 **Description of Incident:** A building belonging to the Incubation Centre Project of the National Board of Technology Incubation (NBTI) was reportedly damaged in a fire outbreak incident at Mabudi-Langtang South LGA of Plateau State. The cause of the fire incident is unknown. Preliminary investigations have revealed that suspected hoodlums were responsible for the fire incident.

🚩 **Location:** Langtang South LGA of Plateau State.

🚩 **Casualty [Male&female]:** No casualty reported.

🚩 **Property damaged/Affected population:** Properties destroyed/community members.

🚩 **Coping Mechanism/Responses:** Community members mobilized to douse the fire. Also, the State Police Command has commenced investigations to unravel the cause of the fire incident.

🚩 **Title of Incident:** ARMED ATTACK BY SUSPECTED ARMED BANDITS

🚩 **Scale of incident:** Medium

🚩 **Date of Occurrence:** 27/3/2022

🚩 **Description of Incident:** Fifteen (15) people were allegedly killed and several others injured in an attack carried out by suspected armed bandits at Hayin Kanwa Village of Yakawada Ward in Giwa LGA of Kaduna State. Attacks by suspected armed bandits remain prevalent in the State.

🚩 **Location:** Hayin Kanwa Village of Yakawada Ward in Giwa LGA of Kaduna State.

🚩 **Casualty [Male&female]:** Fifteen males killed, several people injured.

🚩 **Property damaged/Affected population:** No property damaged/community members.

🚩 **Coping Mechanism/Responses:** Operatives of security agencies have been deployed to apprehend the perpetrators of the crime.

### 🚩 **Incident N\*06:**

🚩 **Title of Incident:** PRISON BREAK/ARREST

🚩 **Scale of incident:** Low

🚩 **Date of Occurrence:** 27/3/2022

🚩 **Description of Incident:** Five (5) suspects reportedly escaped from Awak Divisional Police Station in Kaltungo LGA of Gombe State. The suspects were arrested for shop breaking and theft in the State.

🚩 **Location:** Kaltungo LGA of Gombe State.

🚩 **Casualty [Male&female]:** No casualty reported.

🚩 **Property damaged/Affected population:** No property damaged/suspects.

🚩 **Coping Mechanism/Responses:** The swift response of police operatives led to the arrest of three (3) members of the gang while efforts are ongoing to apprehend other fleeing suspects.

### 🚩 **Incident N\*07:**

🚩 **Title of Incident:** ARMED ATTACK/BOMB EXPLOSION BY SUSPECTED ARMED BANDITS

🚩 **Scale of incident:** Medium

🚩 **Date of Occurrence:** 28/3/2022

🚩 **Description of Incident:** Eight (8) people were allegedly killed and forty-six (46) others injured in an attack carried out by suspected armed bandits on a rail track around Kateri-Rijana Area in Chikun LGA of Kaduna State. The bandits reportedly detonated improvised explosive device (IEDs) on the rail track which immobilized the Abuja-Kaduna bound train conveying over 390 travellers coupled with gunshots fired at passengers. The Nigerian Railway Corporation (NRC) is yet to establish contact with 163 passengers and 7 crew members allegedly abducted in the incident.

🚩 **Location:** Kateri-Rijana Area in Chikun LGA of Kaduna State.

🚩 **Casualty [Male&female]:** Eight people (6 males and 2 females) killed, forty-six people injured, several others abducted.

🚩 **Property damaged/Affected population:** Rail tracks damaged/commuters.

🚩 **Coping Mechanism/Responses:** Operatives of security agencies have been deployed to rescue the abducted

🚒 **Casualty [Male&female]:** Two police officers injured.

🚒 **Property damaged/Affected population:** No property damaged/police officers.

🚒 **Coping Mechanism/Responses:** The injured police officers have been taken to the hospital for medical treatment. Also, the State Police Command has commenced investigations to apprehend the perpetrators of the crime.

🚒 **Location:** Ewreni Community on the East-West Road in Ughelli North LGA of Delta State.

🚒 **Casualty [Male & female]:** One male injured, eighteen people abducted.

🚒 **Property damaged/Affected population:** No property damaged/commuters.

✚ **Property damaged/Affected population:** No property damaged/community resident.

✚ **Coping Mechanism/Responses:** The State Police Command has commenced investigations to ascertain the motive behind the attack and to apprehend the perpetrators of the crime.

✚ **Title of Incident:** ARMED ATTACK BY SUSPECTED HERDERS

✚ **Scale of incident:** Low

✚ **Date of Occurrence:** 28/3/2022

✚ **Description of Incident:** A farmer was reportedly injured in an attack carried out by suspected armed herders at Ikakumo-Akoko Community in Akoko North East LGA of Ondo State. The victim was attacked for interrogating the herders harvesting cashews into sack bags on his farmland.

✚ **Coping Mechanism/Responses:** Operatives of security agencies have been deployed to the affected area to maintain peace and security.

✚ **Location:** Kabawa Area in Lokoja LGA of Kogi State.

✚ **Casualty [Male&female]:** Four males killed.

✚ **Property damaged/Affected population:** Five houses burnt down/suspected cult members.

✚ **Coping Mechanism/Responses:** The swift response of security operatives led to the arrest of fifteen (15) suspected cult members in the incident.

#### ✚ **Incident N\*21:**

✚ **Title of Incident:** ARMED ACTION

✚ **Scale of incident:** Low

✚ **Date of Occurrence:** 29/3/2022

✚ **Description of Incident:** Operatives of the State Police Command reportedly killed two (2) suspected hoodlums following an attack on the Dangote Refinery in Lekki Area, in Eti-Osa LGA of Lagos State. The suspected hoodlums attempted to cart away installed armoured cables in the refinery and were repelled by security operatives.

✚ **Location:** Lekki Area in Eti-Osa LGA of Lagos State.

✚ **Casualty [Male&female]:** Two males killed.

✚ **Property damaged/Affected population:** No property damaged/suspected hoodlums.
