✚ **Title of Incident:** ABDUCTION

✚ **Scale of incident:** Low

✚ **Date of Occurrence:** 3/4/2022

✚ **Description of Incident:** Thirteen (13) people were reportedly abducted in an attack carried out by suspected armed gang at Aniagbala Community along Ubulu-Uku Express Road in Aniocha South LGA of Delta State. Kidnapping for ransom has largely been attributed as the motive behind the criminality in the State.

✚ **Location:** Aniagbala Community along Ubulu-Uku Express Road in Aniocha South LGA of Delta State.

✚ **Casualty [Male & female]:** No reported casualty, thirteen people abducted.

✚ **Property damaged/Affected population:** No property damaged/commuters.

✚ **Coping Mechanism/Responses:** The swift response of police officers led to the rescue of the abducted victims with one (1) suspected kidnapper killed in the incident.

✚ **Incident N*02:**

✚ **Title of Incident:** ARMED ATTACK BY SUSPECTED ARMED GANG

✚ **Scale of incident:** Low

✚ **Date of Occurrence:** 3/4/2022

✚ **Description of Incident:** Two (2) officials of the Federal Road Safety Corps (FRSC) were reportedly killed and one (1) other official injured in an attack carried out by suspected armed gang at Ezinifite-Igboukwu Community in Aguata LGA of Anambra State. The FRSC officials were attacked during their routine traffic rescue patrol operations in the area.

✚ **Location:** Ezinifite-Igboukwu Community in Aguata LGA of Anambra State.

✚ **Casualty [Male & female]:** Two males killed, one male injured.

✚ **Property damaged/Affected population:** No property damaged/FRSC officials.

✚ **Coping Mechanism/Responses:** The injured victim has been taken to the hospital for medical treatment. Also, the State Police Command has commenced investigations to apprehend the perpetrators of the crime.

✚ **Incident N*03:**

✚ **Title of Incident:** ARMED ATTACK BY SUSPECTED HOODLUMS

✚ **Scale of incident:** Low

✚ **Date of Occurrence:** 3/4/2022

✚ **Description of Incident:** Suspected hoodlums reportedly attacked the Amichi Divisional Police Headquarters in Nnewi South LGA of Anambra State. The attack was reportedly repelled by police officers in the incident. Members of the Indigenous People of Biafra (IPOB) agitating for a separate Biafra nation have been responsible for major cases of arson in the State.

✚ **Location:** Nnewi South LGA of Anambra State.

✚ **Casualty [Male & female]:** No reported casualty.

✚ **Property damaged/Affected population:** No property damaged/police officers.

✚ **Coping Mechanism/Responses:** Operatives of security agencies have been deployed to the affected area to forestall further attacks in the State.

The victims were on security patrol when the incident occurred.
- ✚ **Location:** Damboa/Biu Highway in Damboa LGA of Borno State
- ✚ **Casualty [Male & female]:** Four males killed, seven males injured.
- ✚ **Property damaged/Affected population:** Vehicle damaged/local hunters.
- ✚ **Coping Mechanism/Responses:** The injured victims have been taken to the hospital for medical treatment.

✚ **Location:** Anguwar Maji Area in Jere Town along Kaduna-Abuja Highway in Kagarko LGA of Kaduna State.

✚ **Casualty [Male&female]:** Twenty-two people (including five females) abducted.

✚ **Property damaged/Affected population:** No property damaged/community members.

✚ **Coping Mechanism/Responses:** Operatives of security agencies have been deployed to rescue the abducted victims and apprehend the perpetrators of the crime.

✚ **Incident N*10:**

✚ **Title of Incident: ARMED ATTACK BY SUSPECTED BANDITS**

✚ **Scale of incident:** Low

✚ **Date of Occurrence:** 3/4/2022

✚ **Description of Incident:** Three (3) people including the son of the Zamafra State Commissioner for Security and Home Affairs were allegedly killed in an attack carried out by suspected armed bandits in Tsafe Town, Tsafe LGA of Zamfara State.

✚ **Location:** Tsafe Town, Tsafe LGA of Zamfara State.

✚ **Casualty [Male&female]:** Three males killed.

✚ **Property damaged/Affected population:** No property damaged/community members.

✚ **Coping Mechanism/Responses:** Operatives of security agencies have been deployed to apprehend the perpetrators of the crime.

✚ **Title of Incident: MOB ATTACK/ARMED ATTACK BY SUSPECTED ARMED ROBBERS**

✚ **Scale of incident:** Low

✚ **Date of Occurrence:** 3/4/2022

✚ **Description of Incident:** Two (2) suspected motorcycle thieves were reportedly killed in an attack carried out by community residents in Kwankwashe Community, Suleja LGA in Niger State. Preliminary investigations have revealed that the suspected thieves had stolen a motorcycle and killed the motorcyclist prior to the mob attack.

✚ **Location:** Kwankwashe Community of Suleja LGA in Niger State.

✚ **Casualty [Male & female]:** Three males killed.

✚ **Property damaged/Affected population:** Motorcycles stolen/suspected thieves and a motorcyclist.

✚ **Coping Mechanism/Responses:** There is no reported intervention as of reporting time.

✚ **Description of Incident:** Suspected hoodlums reportedly set ablaze the headquarters of Orsu LGA in Imo State with several properties and vehicles destroyed at Awo-Idemili Community, Orsu LGA of the State. Members of the IPOB agitating for a separate Biafra nation have been responsible for major cases of killings and arson in the State.

✚ **Location:** Awo-Idemili Community in Orsu LGA of Imo State.

✚ **Casualty [Male&female]:** No casualty reported.

✚ **Casualty [Male&female]:** Three males (including a police officer) abducted.

✚ **Property damaged/Affected population:** No property damaged/police officer, community members.

✚ **Coping Mechanism/Responses:** The abducted victims have been released following the payment of an undisclosed ransom.

✚ **Title of Incident:** ARMED ATTACK BY SUSPECTED ARMED BANDITS

✚ **Scale of incident:** Medium

✚ **Date of Occurrence:** 4/4/2022

✚ **Description of Incident:** Eleven (11) military operatives were reportedly killed and nineteen (19) others injured in an attack carried out by suspected armed bandits on a military base at Polwire Village in Birnin Gwari LGA of Kaduna State. The attackers also burnt down three (3) Armoured Personnel Carriers (APC) with several weapons carted away in the incident.

Further investigations have revealed that the bandits also killed three (3) people including two local vigilante members and a traveller during the attack.

✚ **Location:** Polwire Village in Birnin Gwari LGA of Kaduna State.

✚ **Casualty [Male&female]:** Fourteen males (including 11 military operatives killed), nineteen military operatives injured.

✚ **Property damaged/Affected population:** Three armoured personnel carriers burnt down and weapons carted away/military operatives.

✚ **Coping Mechanism/Responses:** The injured victims have been taken to the hospital for medical treatment. Also, there is an ongoing security clearance operation to counter armed bandits' attack in the State.

✚ **Title of Incident:** EXTRAJUDICIAL KILLING BY POLICE OFFICERS

✚ **Casualty [Male&female]:** Two security guards killed.

✚ **Property damaged/Affected population:** No property damaged/security guards.

✚ **Coping Mechanism/Responses:** Operatives of security agencies have been deployed to apprehend the perpetrators of the crime.

✚ **Property damaged/Affected population:** No property damaged/community resident.

✚ **Coping Mechanism/Responses:** The suspect is in the custody of the State Police Command for further investigation.

✚ **Title of Incident:** VIOLENT CLASH BETWEEN COMMERCIAL MOTORCYCLISTS

✚ **Description of Incident:** One (1) person was reportedly killed and several others injured in a violent clash between commercial motorcyclists in Baruwa-Gate Axis in Ipaja Area of Alimosho LGA of Lagos State. Preliminary investigations have revealed that the argument between a passenger and motorcycle rider deteriorated resulting in the clash.
