- Title of Incident: ARMED ATTACK BY SUSPECTED ARMED GANG
- **Scale of incident:** Low
- ♣ Date of Occurrence: 24/4/2022
- Description of Incident: One (1) person was allegedly killed and a military officer injured in an attack carried by suspected armed gang at a facility owned by Shell Petroleum Development Company (SPDC) along Ogboinbiri waterways in Southern Ijaw LGA of Bayelsa State.
- Location: Southern Ijaw LGA of Bayelsa State.
- Casualty [Male&female]: One male killed, one military operative injured.
- Property damaged/Affected population: No property damaged/ community member and a military operative.
- Coping Mechanism/Responses: The security operatives have been deployed to apprehend the perpetrators of the crime.

### Incident N\*02:

- Title of Incident: ARMED ATTACK/ABDUCTION
- Scale of incident: Low
- **♣ Date of Occurrence:** 24/4/2022
- Lescription of Incident: One (1) person was reportedly killed and seven (7) others abducted in an attack carried out by suspected armed gang at Adagba Community in Yaba Ward, Abaji Area Council of Abuja-FCT. The motive behind the attack is unknown.
- Location: Adagba Community in Yaba Ward, Abaji Area Council of Abuja-FCT.
- Casualty [Male & female]: One male killed, seven people abducted.
- **Property damaged/Affected population:** No property damaged/community residents.
- ♣ Coping Mechanism/Responses: The State Police Command has commenced investigations to rescue the abducted victims and apprehend the perpetrators of the crime.

## Incident N\*03:

- Title of Incident: RIVAL CULT CLASH
- Scale of incident: Low
- **♣ Date of Occurrence:** 24/4/2022
- **Description of Incident:** One (1) person was reportedly killed in a violent clash between suspected cult gangs 'Eiye and Aiye confraternites' at Elega-Iberekodo Axis of Abeokuta Metropolis in Ogun State. Supremacy tussle and revenge attacks have been attributed to the recurring cult clashes in the State.
- Location: Elega-Iberekodo Axis of Abeokuta Metropolis in Ogun State.
- Casualty [Male & female]: One male killed.
- Property damaged/Affected population: No property damaged/suspected cult members.
- **Coping Mechanism/Responses:** The operatives of the State Police Command have been deployed to the affected area to apprehend the perpetrators of the crime.

## Incident N\*04:

- Title of Incident: EXTRAJUDICIAL KILLING
- Scale of incident: Low
- Date of Occurrence: 24/4/2022
- Description of Incident: The operatives of the State Police Command reportedly killed a local vigilante member following disagreement with a lady at Osemede Street in Ewa Road, Benin-City Area of Edo State.

- Coping Mechanism/Responses: The arrested suspects are in the custody of the State Police Command for further interrogation.

- → **Description of Incident:** One (1) person was reportedly killed and seven (7) others including four females injured following the explosion of an Improvised Explosive Device (IED) planted by suspected Islamic State West Africa Province (ISWAP) terrorists at a local drinking bar in Abasha Ward of Gashua Area, Bade LGA of Yobe State.
- **Location:** Abasha Ward in Gashua Area, Bade LGA of Yobe State.
- Casualty [Male&female]: One male killed, seven people (4 females and 3 males) injured.
- ♣ Property damaged/Affected population: No property damaged/community members.
- Coping Mechanism/Responses: The operatives of security agencies have been deployed to maintain peace and security in the affected area.

## Incident N\*07:

- **■** Title of Incident: SHOOTING BY A POLICE OFFICER
- **Scale of incident:** Low
- **♣ Date of Occurrence:** 24/4/2022
- ▶ Description of Incident: Two (2) people were reportedly killed and two (2) others injured by a drunk police officer at a party in La Silva Bar at Gowon Estate, Egbeda Axis of Alimosho LGA of Lagos State. Preliminary investigations have revealed that the police officer had attempted to shoot into the air but accidentally shot at the victims.
- **Location:** Alimosho LGA of Lagos State.
- **♣ Casualty [Male & female]:** Two males killed, two males injured.
- Property damaged/Affected population: No property damaged/party guests.
- **← Coping Mechanism/Responses:** The injured victims have been taken to the hospital for medical treatment. Also, the State Police Command has commenced investigations to apprehend the police officer who fled the scene of incidence.

- **Property damaged/Affected population:** 52 houses burnt down, several fooditems and livestock stolen/community residents.
- Coping Mechanism/Responses: The operatives of security agencies have been deployed to the affected area to forestall further attacks and maintain peace and security.
