- 4 Title of Incident: ARMED ATTACK BY SUSPECTED HOODLUMS
- **.** Scale of incident: Low
- 4 Date of Occurrence: 15/5/2022
- Description of Incident: Two (2) military operatives were allegedly killed in an attack carried out by hoodlums suspected to be members of the Indigenous People of Biafra (IPOB) at a military checkpoint at 3-3 Estate, Nkwelle Ezunaka Area in Oyi LGA of Anambra State. Several cases of armed attacks in the State have been attributed to members of the IPOB.
- Location: 3-3 Estate, Nkwelle Ezunaka Area in Oyi LGA of Anambra State.
- Casualty [Male&female]: Two males killed.
- Property damaged/Affected population: No property damaged/military operatives.
- Coping Mechanism/Responses: The operatives of security agencies have been deployed to apprehend the perpetrators of the crime.

Incident N*02:

- Title of Incident: ARMED ATTACK BY SUSPECTED ARMED BANDITS
- 4 Scale of incident: Low
- 4 Date of Occurrence: 15/5/2022
- Description of Incident: Three (3) people were reportedly killed in an attack carried out by suspected armed bandits along Sarkin-Pawa Road in Munya LGA of Niger State.
- Location: Sarkin-Pawa Road in Munya LGA of Niger State.
- Casualty [Male & female]: Three people (1 female and 2 males) killed.
- Property damaged/Affected population: No property damaged/community residents.
- Coping Mechanism/Responses: The operatives of security agencies have been deployed to the affected area to maintain peace and security in the State.

- Title of Incident: ARMED ATTACK/ABDUCTION
- 4 Scale of incident: Low
- Date of Occurrence: 15/5/2022
- **Description of Incident:** One (1) person was reportedly killed and two (2) others including a female and her 8year-old son abducted in an attack carried out by suspected armed gang at Tarabu Village in Kirikasamma LGA of Jigawa State. Kidnapping for ransom has largely been attributed as the motive behind the criminality in the State.
- Location: Tarabu Village in Kirikasamma LGA of Jigawa State.
- Casualty [Male&female]: One male killed, two people (1 female and 1 child) abducted.
- Property damaged/Affected population: No property damaged/community members.
- Coping Mechanism/Responses: The swift response of the security operatives led to the rescue of the female victim while investigations have commenced to rescue the other abducted victim.

An undisclosed quantity of cocaine, methamphetamine as well as arms and ammunition were recovered in the incident.

- Description of Incident: The Enugu Electricity Distribution Company (EEDC) in Ogidi District in Anambra State was reportedly set ablaze by hoodlums suspected to be members of the Indigenous People of Biafra (IPOB). The State has continued to witness several cases of arson by hoodlums suspected to be IPOB members.
- Location: Ogidi District in Anambra State.
- **Casualty [Male & female]:** No casualty.
- Property damaged/Affected population: Several properties destroyed/EEDC staff members.
- Coping Mechanism/Responses: The operatives of security operatives have been deployed to the affected area to maintain peace and security.
