Title of Incident: ARSON BY SUSPECTED HOODLUMS

Scale of incident: Low

Date of Occurrence: 8/5/2022

Description of Incident: Hoodlums suspected to be members of the Indigenous People of Biafra (IPOB) reportedly set ablaze a truck loaded with cattle at Ezinifite-Uga Road in Aguata LGA of Anambra State. Several occupants of the truck reportedly sustained injuries in the incident. Members of the IPOB have continued to carry out criminal attacks in the State following the continued detention of their leader, Nnamdi Kanu, in the custody of the Nigerian Government.

Location: Ezinifite/Uga Road in Aguata LGA of Anambra State.

Casualty [Male&female]: Several people injured.

Property damaged/Affected population: Truck set ablaze/traders.

Coping Mechanism/Responses: The State Police Command has arrested one (1) suspect in connection with the crime.

Incident N*02:

Title of Incident: MURDER/MOB ATTACK

Scale of incident: Low

Date of Occurrence: 8/5/2022

Description of Incident: One (1) person was reportedly burnt to death following reports of his alleged involvement in the robbery and killing of a commercial motorcyclist in Otukpo Town in Benue State.

Location: Otukpo Town in Benue State.

Casualty [Male & female]: Two males killed.

Property damaged/Affected population: No property damaged/community residents.

Coping Mechanism/Responses: The operatives of the State Police Command have been deployed to the affected area to maintain peace and security. Also, some community residents conducted a protest against the mob violence meted on the suspect.

Title of Incident: ARREST

Scale of incident: Low

Date of Occurrence: 8/5/2022

Description of Incident: The operatives of the State Police Command reportedly arrested a 45-year-old suspected kidnapper in Nasarawa State following reports of his involvement in criminal activities in Akwanga and Wamba LGA of the State. Preliminary investigations have revealed that the arrested suspect had earlier escaped from the prison in Jos Axis of Plateau State.

Location: Akwanga and Wamba LGA of Nasarawa State.

Casualty [Male&female]: No casualty reported.

Property damaged/Affected population: No property damaged/suspected kidnapper.

Coping Mechanism/Responses: The arrested suspect is in the custody of the State Police Command for further interrogation.

🚩 **Description of Incident:** One (1) person was reportedly killed and six (6) others abducted in an attack carried out by suspected armed bandits in Takakume Community in Goronyo LGA of Sokoto State. In retaliation, members of the local vigilante group in the community mobilized and killed one (1) of the attackers in the incident. Preliminary investigations have also revealed that the abducted victims were killed following the death of the bandit leader.

🚩 **Location:** Takakume Community in Goronyo LGA of Sokoto State.

🚩 **Casualty [Male&female]:** Eight males (7 community residents and 1 bandit) killed.

🚩 **Property damaged/Affected population:** No property damaged/community residents and a suspected armed bandit.
