- **Title of Incident: VIOLENT EXTREMIST ATTACK/ARMED ATTACK BY SUSPECTED ISWAP MEMBERS**
- 4 Scale of incident: Low
- **Date of Occurrence:** 22/5/2022
- Description of Incident: Three (3) police officers were allegedly killed and four (4) others injured in an attack carried out by suspected ISWAP members at Goni Matari Village in Kaga LGA of Borno State. The attackers also set ablaze two (2) security patrol vehicles in the incident. Preliminary investigations have revealed that the terrorists attacked the convoy of police officers travelling from Abuja-FCT to Borno State for a presidential campaign.
- Location: Goni Matari Village in Kaga LGA of Borno State.
- **Casualty [Male&female]:** Three males killed, four males injured.
- Property damaged/Affected population: Two security patrol vehicles set ablaze/police officers.
- **Coping Mechanism/Responses:** The injured victims have been taken to the hospital for medical treatment.

Incident N*02:

- **Title of Incident: MOB ATTACK**
- Scale of incident: Low
- **Date of Occurrence:** 22/5/2022
- Description of Incident: A suspected armed robber was reportedly beaten to death by community youths for dispossessing a community resident of his vehicle at Charanchi LGA of Katsina State. Other members of the robbery gang fled the scene of incidence.
- Location: Charanchi LGA of Katsina State.
- **Casualty [Male & female]:** One male killed.
- **Property damaged/Affected population:** No property damaged/suspected armed robber.
- Coping Mechanism/Responses: The operatives of the State Police Command have been deployed to the affected area to maintain peace and security.

- **Title of Incident: VIOLENT EXTREMIST ATTACK/ARMED ATTACK BY SUSPECTED BOKO HARAM MEMBERS**
- Scale of incident: Low
- **Date of Occurrence:** 22/5/2022
- Description of Incident: Four (4) ethnic Fulani herders were reportedly killed in an attack carried out by suspected Boko Haram members around Abujan Gorgi Axis of Borno State. Boko Haram has increasingly targeted farmers, herders and loggers, accusing them of spying and passing information to the Nigerian Military.
- **Location:** Abujan Gorgi Axis of Borno State.
- Casualty [Male & female]: Four males killed.
- Property damaged/Affected population: No property damaged/ethnic Fulani herders.
- Coping Mechanism/Responses: There is an ongoing security clearance operation to counter terrorist attacks in the State.

- Description of Incident: Community residents of Kairu in Bukuyum LGA of Zamafara State were forcibly evicted from their farmlands by suspected armed bandits for failing to pay the 30 million naira peace levy as demanded by the bandits. Preliminary investigations have revealed that the leader of a bandits' gang had initially issued a three-day ultimatum to community residents to pay the demanded sum or vacate their farmlands¹.
- **Location:** Kairu Community in Bukuyum LGA of Zamfara State.
- Casualty [Male & female]: No reported casualty.
- Property damaged/Affected population: No property damaged/community residents.
- **Coping Mechanism/Responses:** There is no reported intervention as of reporting time.
