- **■** Title of Incident: ARMED ATTACK/ABDUCTION
- Scale of incident: Low
- Date of Occurrence: 29/5/2022
- **Description of Incident:** An erstwhile Commissioner of National Population Commission (NPC) was allegedly killed and his two (2) daughters abducted in an attack carried out by suspected armed gang at his residence in Azuba Bashayi Area in Lafia LGA of Nasarawa State. Kidnapping for ransom has largely been attributed as the motive behind the criminality in the State.
- **Location:** Azuba Bashayi Area in Lafia LGA of Nasarawa State.
- **Casualty [Male&female]:** One male killed, two females abducted.
- Property damaged/Affected population: No property damaged/community members.
- **Coping Mechanism/Responses:** The security operatives have been deployed to apprehend the perpetrators of the crime and also rescue the abducted victims.
