- Title of Incident: ARMED ATTACK BY SUSPECTED ARMED GANG
- Scale of incident: High
- **Date of Occurrence:** 5/6/2022
- **Description of Incident:** Forty (40) christian worshippers were allegedly killed and 87 others injured in an attack carried out by suspected armed gang at a church premises along Owa-luwa Street in Owo LGA of Ondo State. Several properties and vehicles were damaged in the incident. The motive behind the attack is unknown.
- **Location:** Owa-luwa Street in Owo LGA of Ondo State.
- **Casualty [Male&female]:** Forty people killed (including 17 females and 11 children), eighty-seven people injured.
- **Property damaged/Affected population:** Several properties and vehicles destroyed/christian worshipers.
- **Coping Mechanism/Responses:** The security agencies have commenced investigations to apprehend the perpetrators of the crime.

Incident N*02:

- **■** Title of Incident: ABDUCTION
- Scale of incident: Low
- **♣ Date of Occurrence:** 5/6/2022
- **Description of Incident:** One (1) female was reportedly abducted in an attack carried out by suspected armed gang at her residence in Rangazu Ward of Zaura Village in Ungogo LGA of Kano State. The victim is the mother of a senatorial candidate under the platform of the All Progressive Congress (APC) in the State.
- Location: Rangazu Ward of Zaura Village in Ungogo LGA of Kano State.
- Casualty [Male & female]: One female abducted.
- **Property damaged/Affected population:** No property damaged/female resident.
- **Coping Mechanism/Responses:** The State Police Command has commenced investigations to rescue the abducted victim.

- Scale of incident: Low
- **♣ Date of Occurrence:** 5/6/2022
- **Description of Incident:** Twenty (20) people were reportedly abducted in an attack carried out by suspected armed bandits at Furfuri Village in Bungudu LGA of Zamfara State. Kidnapping for ransom has largely been attributed as the motive behind the criminality in the State.
- Location: Furfuri Village in Bungudu LGA of Zamfara State.
- **Casualty [Male&female]:** Twenty people (including 10 females) abducted.
- Property damaged/Affected population: No property damaged/community members.
- Coping Mechanism/Responses: The security operatives have been deployed to rescue the abducted victims.

Incident N*04:

- **Title of Incident: ARMED ATTACK BY SUSPECTED ARMED GANG**
- **Scale of incident:** Low
- **♣ Date of Occurrence:** 5/6/2022
- Description of Incident: A police officer was allegedly killed and a motorcycle rider injured in an attack carried out by suspected armed gang along Uti Road in Effurun Axis, Uvwie LGA of Delta State. The attackers also carted away with the rifle of the police officer.
- Location: Uti Road in Effurun Axis of Uvwie LGA of Delta State.

- Property damaged/Affected population: No property damaged/suspected kidnapper.
- **Coping Mechanism/Responses:** The State Police Command has commenced investigations to apprehend other members of the criminal syndicate.

- Date of Occurrence: 5/6/2022
- Description of Incident: Four (4) people were reportedly abducted in an attack carried out by suspected armed gang at separate locations in Orumba North LGA and Aguata LGA of Anambra State. Kidnapping for ransom has largely been attributed as the motive behind the criminality in the State.
- **Location:** Orumba North LGA and Aguata LGA of Anambra State.
- Casualty [Male&female]: Four people abducted.
- **Property damaged/Affected population:** No property damaged/community members.
- **Coping Mechanism/Responses:** The security operatives have been deployed to rescue the abducted victims and apprehend the perpetrators of the crime.

Incident N*07:

- **♣** Title of Incident: ARMED ATTACK BY SUSPECTED ARMED BANDITS
- **♣** Scale of incident: High
- **Date of Occurrence:** 5/6/2022
- Description of Incident: Thirty-two (32) people were reportedly killed and several others injured in coordinated attacks carried out by suspected armed bandits at separate locations in Maikori, Dogon Noma, and Ungwan Doma Villages in Kajuru LGA of Kaduna State. The attackers also set ablaze several properties including houses and livestock in the incident.
- Location: Maikori, Dogon Noma, and Ungwan Doma Villages in Kajuru LGA of Kaduna State.
- Casualty [Male&female]: Thirty-two people (including 5 females and 4 children) killed.
- **Property damaged/Affected population:** Houses and livestock set ablaze/community members.
- **Coping Mechanism/Responses:** The security operatives have been deployed to apprehend the perpetrators of the crime.

Incident N*08:

- **Title of Incident: HOMICIDE/ARREST**
- **Scale of incident:** Low
- **Date of Occurrence:** 5/6/2022
- **Description of Incident:** The operatives of the State Police Command reportedly arrested two (2) local hunters for killing a female resident and her son for alleged witchcraft in Madagali LGA of Adamawa State.
- **Location:** Madagali LGA of Adamawa State.
- Casualty [Male&female]: Two people (1 female and 1 male child) killed.

- **Coping Mechanism/Responses:** The security operatives have been deployed to the affected area to maintain peace and security.

Kidnapping for ransom has largely been attributed as the motive behind the criminality in the State.
- **Location:** Gidan-Giye Village along Gusau-Tsafe -Wanzamai Road in Tsafe LGA of Zamfara State.
- **Casualty [Male&female]:** Two males abducted.
- Property damaged/Affected population: No property damaged/community residents.

Preliminary investigations have revealed that the attackers ambushed commuters and also looted food items in the incident.
- Location: Maiduguri-Damaturu Road in Kaga LGA of Borno State
- **Casualty [Male & female]:** Five males abducted.
- **Property damaged/Affected population:** Four vehicles set ablaze/community residents.
- **Coping Mechanism/Responses:** The swift response of security operatives led to the rescue of the abducted victims.

- Description of Incident: A truck loaded with bags of cement was reportedly set ablaze in an attack carried out by hoodlums suspected to be members of the Indigenous People of Biafra (IPOB) while enforcing the sit-at-home order at Beach Junction in Nsukka LGA of Enugu State.
- Location: Beach Junction in Nsukka LGA of Enugu State.
- Casualty [Male&female]: No casualty reported.
- **Property damaged/Affected population:** No property damaged/community members.
- **Coping Mechanism/Responses:** The security operatives have been deployed to the affected area to forestall further attacks and apprehend the perpetrators of the crime.
