- **Title of Incident: ARMED ATTACK BY SUSPECTED ARMED HERDERS**
- Scale of incident: High
- **Date of Occurrence:** 12/6/2022
- **Description of Incident:** Thirty-seven (37) people were allegedly killed and several buildings set ablaze in a coordinated attack carried out by suspected armed herders at Igama Community in Edumoga Ehaje District of Okpokwu LGA of Benue State. The motive behind the attack is unknown.
- Location: Igama community, Edumoga Ehaje district in Okpokwu LGA of Benue State.
- Casualty [Male&female]: Thirty-seven people killed.
- Property damaged/Affected population: Several buildings set ablaze/community members.
- **Coping Mechanism/Responses:** The security operatives have been deployed to forstall further attacks and apprehend the perpetrators of the crime.

## Incident N\*02:

- **Title of Incident: ABDUCTION**
- Scale of incident: Low
- **♣ Date of Occurrence:** 12/6/2022
- **Description of Incident:** Three (3) people (including a Christian cleric and his wife) were reportedly abducted in an attack carried out by suspected armed gang along Oyo-Ogbomoso Expressway in Oyo State. Kidnapping for ransom has largely been attributed as the motive behind the criminality in the State.
- **Location:** Oyo-Ogbomoso Expressway in Oyo State.
- **Casualty [Male&female]:** Three people (2 males and 1 female) abducted.
- ♣ Property damaged/Affected population: No property damaged/community members.
- **Coping Mechanism/Responses:** The security operatives have been deployed to rescue the abducted victims and apprehend the perpetrators of the crime.

Kidnapping for ransom has largely been attributed as the motive behind the criminality in the State.
- Location: Toro LGA of Bauchi State.
- **Casualty [Male&female]:** Two males including a village head and his son abducted.
- Property damaged/Affected population: No property damaged/community members.
- Coping Mechanism/Responses: The security operatives have been deployed to rescue the abducted victims and apprehend the perpetrators of the crime.

- Title of Incident: RESCUE OPERATIONS/HUMAN TRAFFICKING
- Scale of incident: Low
- Date of Occurrence: 12/6/2022
- Description of Incident: The officials of the National Agency for the Prohibition of Trafficking in Persons (NAPTIP) rescued ten (10) victims of human trafficking in Kano State. The victims who were between the ages of 9 and 28 years old were rescued while on their way to Niger Republic for labour exploitation. Preliminary investigations have revealed that the victims were recruited from Kogi, Delta, Kwara, Oyo, Ondo, Lagos, Ogun and Osun States.
- Location: Kano State.
- Casualty [Male & female]: No casualty reported, ten people (2 males and 8 females) rescued.
- Property damaged/Affected population: No property damaged/victims of human trafficking.
- Coping Mechanism/Responses: The rescued victims are currently undergoing counselling in a shelter, while efforts are ongoing to reunite them with their families.

### **Incident N\*59:**

- Title of incident: RAPE/VIOLENT DEMONSTRATION/ARSON
- Scale of incident: Low
- Date of Occurrence: 13/6/2022
- Description of Incident: Ccommunity youths of Umuduruewuewuru in Umuezeala Nsu Axis of Ehime Mbano LGA in Imo State reportedly conducted a violent protest and set ablaze a house belonging to a 22-year old suspected internet fraudster for allegedly defiling a 14-year-old female. The suspect reportedly raped the victim to death at his residence.
- Location: Umuduruewuewuru in Umuezeala Nsu Axis of Ehime Mbano LGA in Imo State
- Casualty[ Male & female]: 14-year-old female killed.
- Property damaged/Affected population: One building set ablaze/14-year-old female.
- Coping Mechanism/Responses: The operatives of the State Police Command have been deployed to the affected area to disperse the protesters. Also, the State Police Command has commenced investigations to apprehend the perpetrator of the crime.

- Casualty [Male & female]: No casualty.
- Property damaged/Affected population: No property damaged/20-year-old male resident.
- Coping Mechanism/Responses: The suspect has been remanded at the Kirikiri Correctional Centre in the State.

- Description of incident: Community residents under the aegis of the Coalition of Islamic Scholars and Organisations reportedly conducted a peaceful protest against the incessant ritual killings at Iwo Axis in Ola Oluwa LGA of Osun State. The protesters also issued complaints of being labelled perpetrators of ritual killings in
- Location: Iwo Axis in Ola Oluwa LGA of Osun State.
- Casualty[Male & female]: No casualty reported.
- Property damaged/Affected population: No property damaged/members of the Coalition of Islamic Scholars and
- **Coping mechanism/Responses:** There is no reported intervention sa of reporting time.

## Incident N\*67:

- Title of Incident: STRIKE Scale of incident: Low
- Date of Occurrence: 14/6/2022
- ♣ Description of Incident: The National Executive Council of the Colleges of Education Academic Staff Union (COEASU) reportedly embarked on a one-month strike over the failure of the Federal Government to implement agreements reached with the Union including the non-release of the N15 billion revitalisation fund for the colleges in Nigeria. The Colleges of Education lecturers are also aggrieved at the Federal Government's insistence on using the Integrated Personnel Payroll and Information System (IPPIS) as the payment platform against the Universities Transparency and Accountability Solution (UTAS), which they claimed is a more reliable alternative that captures the peculiarity of tertiary institutions<sup>1</sup>.

- Location: Ilabere Road in Ikoyi Area, Eti-Osa LGA of Lagos State.

- Coping Mechanism/Responses: The officials of the State Fire Service have been deployed to douse the fire.

- Description of Incident: A 7-year-old male was reported dead and over 100 houses and properties destroyed in a storm incident occasioned by heavy rainfall in Jahun and Gwiwa LGAs of Jigawa State.
- Location: Jahun and Gwiwa LGAs of Jigawa State.
- Casualty [Male&female]: A 7-year-old male dead.

### Incident N\*78:

- ♣ Title of Incident: CORONAVIRUS
- Scale of incident: Low
- **♣ Date of Occurrence:** 18/6/2022
- **Description of Incident:** The Nigeria Centre for Disease Control (NCDC) recorded no death and 359 confirmed cases of coronavirus across the 36 states of Nigeria including the Abuja-FCT between 12 and 18 June , 2022. Also, as of June 18, 2022, 21 people have been treated and discharged.
  - As of June 18, 2022, a total of 28,427,564 COVID-19 vaccine doses have been administered in Nigeria. The National Primary Health Care Development Agency (NPHCDA) continues to vaccinate residents with the approved AstraZeneca, Johnson Johnson, Pfizer and Moderna COVID-19 vaccines in Nigeria<sup>2</sup>.
- Location: Nigeria.
- **Casualty [Male&female]:** One person dead, 359 confirmed cases, 21 people treated.
- **Property damaged/Affected population:** No property damaged/community residents.
- **Coping Mechanism/Responses:** The National Primary Health Care Development Agency (NPHCDA) has continued the vaccination exercise of citizens and residents across States in Nigeria.
