- Description of Incident: One (1) suspected armed robber was reportedly killed in an attack carried out by community youths in Akwa Axis of Anambra State.

- Description of Incident: Five (5) people including an official of the Nigeria Security and Civil Defence Corps (NSCDC) and four inmates were reportedly killed and 16 others injured during a jail break by suspected members of the Islamic State West Africa Province (ISWAP) at the Kuje Medium Security Custodial Centre in Abuja-FCT. The attackers reportedly gained access into the prison facility using Improvised Explosive Devices (IED) in the incident. 879 inmates including 64 Boko Haram/ISWAP members reportedly escaped from Kuje Custodial Centre.
- Location: Abuja-FCT.
- **Casualty [Male&female]:** Five males killed, sixteen people injured.
- **Property damaged/Affected population:** Several properties destroyed/inmates and security personnel.
- Coping Mechanism/Responses: The operatives of security agencies have be deployed to apprehend the perpetrators of the crime. Also, over 400 of the escaped inmates have been recaptured in the incident.
