- **Description of Incident:** The operatives of the State Police Command reportedly killed three (3) suspected kidnappers during security clearance operation at their hideouts in Song and Maiha LGAs of Adamawa State. Arms and ammunition were recovered in the incident.
- Location: Song and Maiha LGAs of Adamawa State.
- Casualty [Male&female]: Three suspected kidnappers killed.
- Property damaged/Affected population: Arms and ammunition recovered/suspected kidnappers.
- **Coping Mechanism/Responses:** The security operatives have been deployed to apprehend other criminal suspects in the State.

### Incident N\*02:

- **Title of Incident: ARMED ATTACK BY SUSPECTED ARMED HERDERS**
- Scale of incident: Medium
- **♣ Date of Occurrence:** 31/7/2022
- **Description of Incident:** Eight (8) people were reportedly killed and two (2) others injured in an attack carried out by suspected armed herders at Danda Chugwi Village in Jos South LGA of Plateau State.
- Location: Danda Chugwi Village in Jos South LGA of Plateau State.
- Casualty [Male & female]: Eight people (including 4 children) killed, two males injured.
- **Property damaged/Affected population:** No property damaged/community residents.
- Coping Mechanism/Responses: The operatives of security agencies have been deployed to the affected area to maintain peace and security.

The decision by the broadcasting regulator sparked widespread condemnation with many industry stakeholders and other Nigerians condemning the federal government agency over what some of them described as "gagging of the press" and denying Nigerians the right to know<sup>2</sup>.
