**Title of Incident: ARMED ATTACK BY SUSPECTED HOODLUMS**

**Scale of incident:** Low

**Date of Occurrence:** 11/9/2022

**Description of Incident:** Seven (7) people including three police officers were reportedly killed and two (2) police officers injured in an attack carried out by suspected hoodlums on the convoy of a Senator representing Anambra South along Enugwu-Ukwu Road in Anambra State. The motive behind the attack is unknown.

**Location:** Enugwu-Ukwu Road of Anambra State.

**Casualty [Male&female]:** Seven males including three police officers killed, two police officers injured.

**Property damaged/Affected population:** No property damaged/police officers and community members.

**Coping Mechanism/Responses:** The security operatives have been deployed to apprehend the perpetrators of the crime. Also, the State Police Command has commenced investigations to ascertain the motive behind the attack.

#### **Incident N\*02:**

**Title of Incident: ARMED ACTION**

**Scale of incident:** Low

**Date of Occurrence:** 11/9/2022

**Description of Incident:** The members of the local vigilante/hunters group reportedly foiled an attack carried out by suspected armed bandits with several bandits killed during a shoot-out incident in Batsari Town, Batsari LGA of Katsina State. Six (6) motorcycles and weapons were recovered in the incident.

**Location:** Batsari Town in Batsari LGA of Katsina State.

**Casualty [Male&female]:** Several suspected armed bandits killed.

**Property damaged/Affected population:** Six motorcycles and weapons recovered/suspected armed bandits.

**Coping Mechanism/Responses:** There is an ongoing security clearance operation to counter armed bandits' attacks in the State.

**Casualty [Male&female]:** One male abducted.

**Coping Mechanism/Responses:** The security operatives have been deployed to rescue the abducted victim and apprehend the perpetrators of the crime.
