Title of Incident: MOB ATTACK

Scale of incident: Low

Date of Occurrence: 2/10/2022

Description of Incident: Two (2) suspected bandits were reportedly lynched to death by community residents following allegations that the victims were linked to bandit activities in Birnin Gwari LGA of Kaduna State.

Location: Birnin Gwari LGA of Kaduna State.

Casualty [Male & female]: Two males killed.

Property damaged/Affected population: No property damaged/herders

Coping Mechanism/Responses: The Kaduna State Governor has ordered investigation into the incident to unravel the motive behind the attack and to apprehend the perpetrators of the crime.

Title of Incident: ARMS CONTROL/ARREST

Scale of incident: Low

Date of Occurrence: 2/10/2022

Description of Incident: The operatives of the State Police Command reportedly arrested a suspected gunrunner at Sabon Gaya Axis along Kaduna-Abuja Road in Chikun LGA of Kaduna State. An assault rifle, 18 magazines and 241 rounds of live ammunition were recovered from the suspect.

Location: Sabon Gaya Axis along Kaduna-Abuja Road in Chikun LGA of Kaduna State.

Casualty [Male & female]: One male arrested.

Property damaged/Affected population: No property damaged/Suspected gunrunner.

Coping Mechanism/Responses: The arrested suspect and exhibits are in the State Police Command for investigation.

Title of Incident: MANSLAUGHTER

Scale of incident: Low

Date of Occurrence: 2/10/2022

Description of Incident: A 12-year-old boy was reportedly shot dead by his elder brother at Dutse Gogo Village in Kaiama LGA of Kwara State. The incident occurred while the suspect attempted to test the efficacy of a newly procured bullet protective charm.

Location: Dutse Gogo Village in Kaiama LGA of Kwara State

Casualty [Male & female]: One male child killed.

Property damaged/Affected population: No property damaged/12-year-old boy.

Coping Mechanism/Responses: The State Police Command has commenced investigations to arrest the fleeing suspect.

Title of Incident: ARMED ASSAULT/POLITICAL VIOLENCE

Scale of incident: Low

Date of Occurrence: 2/10/2022

Description of Incident: Two (2) supporters of the Labour Party (LP) reportedly sustained injuries following an attack by suspected political thugs at Oshodi in Oshodi/Isolo LGA of Lagos State. The attack allegedly occurred when the victims waved the LP flag during campaigns.

Location: Oshodi in Oshodi/Isolo LGA of Lagos State.

Casualty [Male & female]: Two males injured.

Property damaged/Affected population: No property damaged/Labour Party supporters.

Coping Mechanism/Responses: The injured victims have been taken to the hospital for medical treatment.

⚠ **Date of Occurrence:**2/10/2022

⚠ **Description of Incident:** Twelve (12) persons were reportedly killed and eight (8) others declared missing in an attack carried out by suspected bandits/terrorists in local vigilante camouflage at a herders' community in Bali LGA of Taraba State. 130 cattle were rustled with an undisclosed number of motorcycles and food supplies carted away.

⚠ **Location:** Bali LGA of Taraba State

⚠ **Casualty [Male & female]:** Twelve people killed, eight people declared missing.

⚠ **Property damaged/Affected population:** No property damaged/Community residents.

⚠ **Coping Mechanism/Responses:** The operatives of the State Police Command arrested four (4) suspected in connection with the crime for further investigation.

⚠ **Title of Incident: ABDUCTION**

⚠ **Scale of incident:** Low

⚠ **Date of Occurrence:** 2/10/2022

⚠ **Description of Incident:** Two (2) people including a 16-year-old boy were reportedly abducted in an attack carried out by suspected kidnapers at Kes Village in Mikang LGA of Plateau State. Kidnapping for ransom has largely been attributed as the motive behind the criminality in the State.

⚠ **Location:** Kes Village in Mikang LGA of Plateau State.

⚠ **Casualty [Male & female]:** Two males abducted.

⚠ **Property damaged/Affected population:** No property damaged/Community residents

✚ **Description of Incident:** The twenty-three (23) remaining victims of the Kaduna train attack held hostage by suspected terrorists have been reportedly rescued following concerted efforts of the Chief of Defense Staff Action Committee (CDSAC). The Kaduna train attack occurred on March 28, 2022, in Kaduna State.

✚ **Location:** Kaduna State.

✚ **Casualty [Male & female]:** No casualty recorded.

✚ **Property damaged/Affected population:** No property damaged/victims of train attack.

✚ **Coping Mechanism/Responses:** The CDSAC has reunited the rescued victims with their families.

✚ **Date of Occurrence: 5/10/2022**

✚ **Description of Incident:** Twenty-seven (27) staff members of the Dangote Cement factory reportedly sustained gunshot injuries following an invasion of the factory by members of the State security outfit and local vigilantes at Obajana Community of Oworo District in Lokoja LGA of Kogi State. Preliminary investigations have revealed that officials of the State security outfits and local vigilantes were deployed to temporarily shut down operations at the factory over unresolved issues between the Kogi State Government and Dangote Cement Company.

✚ **Location:** Obajana Community of Oworo District in Lokoja LGA of Kogi State.

✚ **Casualty [Male & female]:** Twenty-seven persons injured.

✚ **Property damaged/Affected population:** Several trucks and equipment at the facility damaged/Dangote cement factory staff members.

✚ **Coping Mechanism/Responses:** The injured victims have been taken to the hospital for medical treatment.

Incident N*16:

✚ **Title of Incident: VIOLENT CLASH BETWEEN FARMERS AND HERDERS**

✚ **Scale of incident: Low**

✚ **Date of Occurrence: 5/10/2022**

✚ **Description of Incident:** A military operative was reportedly killed in a violent clash between farmers and herders at Guri LGA of Jigawa State. The incident occurred when a team of military operatives were deployed to the affected area to resolve a reported case of farmland encroachment by herders during cattle grazing. The attackers also carted away with the rifle belonging to the murdered military operative in the incident.

✚ **Location:** Guri LGA of Jigawa State.

✚ **Casualty [Male & female]:** One male killed.

Further investigations have revealed that the victims had fled their community following an attack by suspected armed bandits. In a related development, twenty-seven (27) community residents were also abducted by suspected armed bandits in Rugaje, Danzamau and Maikulki Communities in the LGA.

✚ **Location:** Rugaje, Danzamau, Maikulki and Birnin Waje Communities in Bukkuyum LGA of Zamfara State.

✚ **Casualty [Male & female]:** Twenty-six people (5 females and 21 children) dead, 27 people abducted.

✚ **Property damaged/Affected population:** Two canoes damaged/community residents.

✚ **Coping Mechanism/Responses:** There is an ongoing security clearance operation to counter armed bandits' attack in the State.
