- → **Description of Incident:** The Chairman of the Peoples Democratic Party (PDP) in Bokkos LGA of Plateau State was reportedly abducted in an attack carried out by suspected armed gang at his residence at Tangur Community in Bokkos LGA of Plateau State. Kidnapping for ransom has largely been attributed as the motive behind the criminality in the State.
