- Title of Incident: ARMED ATTACK/ARSON
- Scale of incident: Low
- **▶ Date of Occurrence:** 9/10/2022
- Description of Incident: Four (4) people including two (2) police operatives were reportedly killed in an attack carried out by suspected hoodlums on a police station at Inyi in Oji River LGA of Enugu State. Weapons and ammunition were reportedly carted away with the police station set ablaze in the incident.
- Location: Inyi in Oji River LGA of Enugu State.
- Casualty [Male & female]: Four males killed.
- Property damaged/Affected population: Police station burnt down, weapons stolen/community residents and police operatives.
- Coping Mechanism/Responses: The operatives of the State Police Command have been deployed to the affected area to maintain peace and security.

#### Incident N\*02:

- **↓** Title of Incident: ABDUCTION/MURDER
- Scale of incident: Low
- **Date of Occurrence:** 9/10/2022
- **Description of Incident:** The corpse of a male resident was reportedly discovered by community residents at Badafi Ward in Kiru LGA of Kano State after he was killed by suspected kidnappers. Preliminary investigations have revealed that the deceased was abducted on October 2, 2022.
- Location: Badafi Ward in Kiru LGA of Kano State.
- Casualty [Male & female]: One (1) male killed.
- Property damaged/Affected population: No property damaged/community residents
- Coping Mechanism/Responses: The State Police Command has commenced investigations to apprehend the perpetrators
  of the crime.
