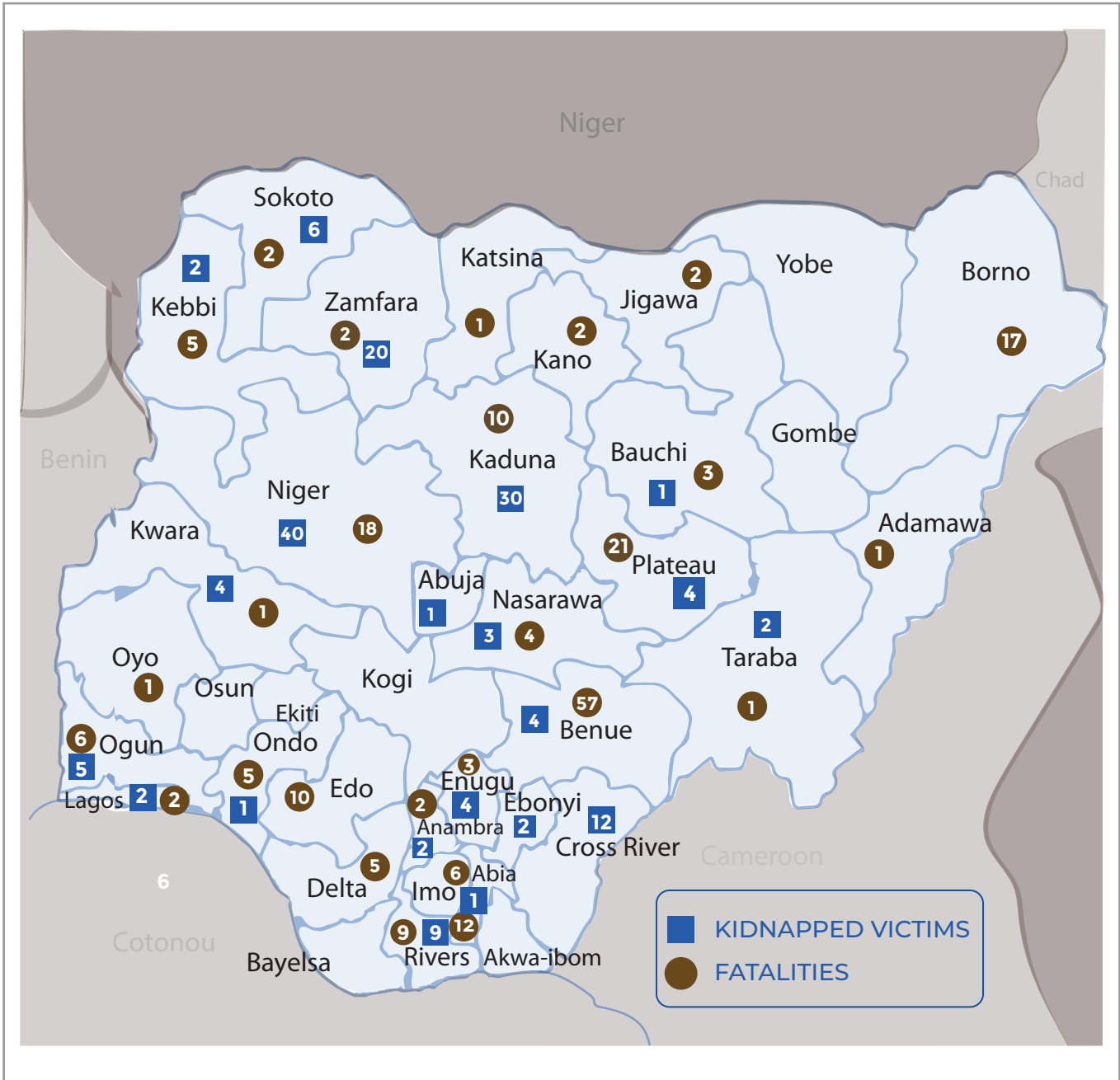
SUMMARY

The situation report, which provides a bi-weekly update on armed violence incidents and casualties in Nigeria, documented multiple security threats including terrorist attacks, armed banditry, kidnapping, cult clashes, communal clashes, as well as sexual and gender-based violence (SGBV), particularly rape in the reporting period.

Within the reporting period, a total of 91 armed violence incidents were recorded with 146 injuries and 207 fatalities including 7 security personnel, 23 females and 7 children. The North-Central recorded the highest fatality of 101, while the North-West and South-South accounted for 24 deaths each, and South-East with 23 deaths. The North-East and South-West recorded 21 and 14 deaths respectively. The period under review recorded an increase in fatalities (206) compared to the period of October 16-31, 2022, with 150 recorded fatalities. Non-state armed actors are not included in the statistics of recorded fatalities.

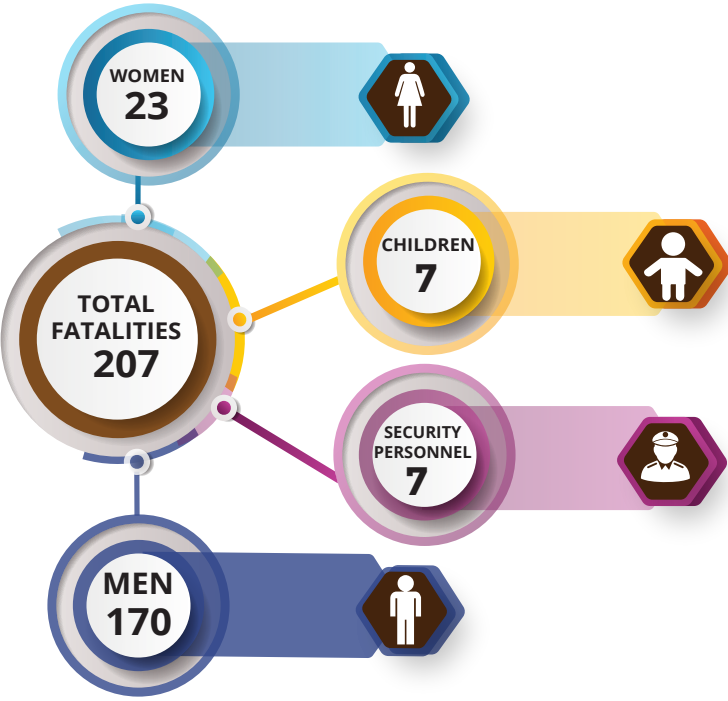
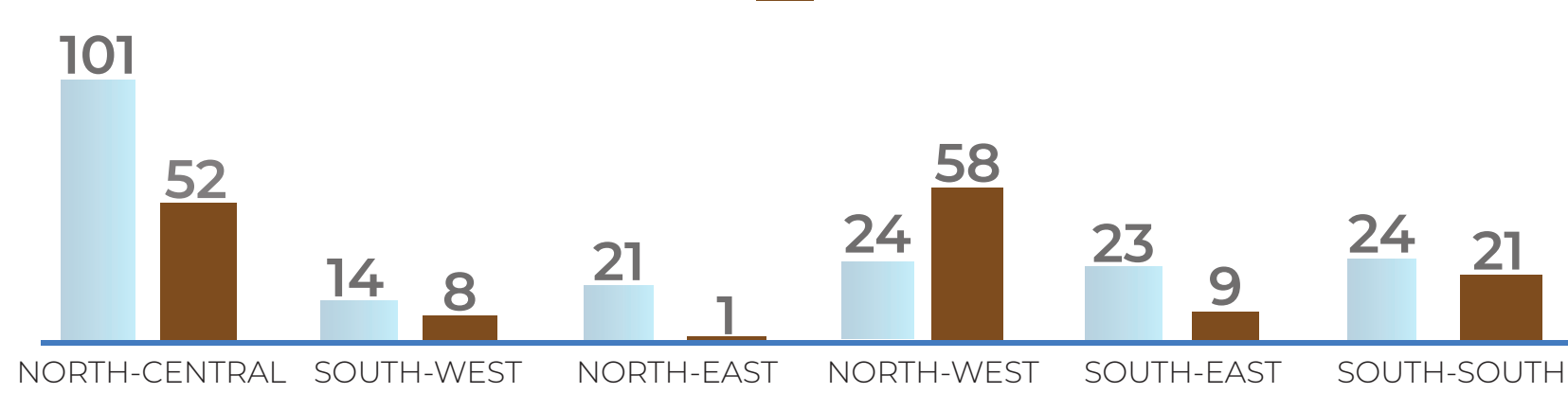
The WANEP NEWS also recorded 38 incidents of kidnapping across 19 States with 149 people abducted in the reporting period. Out of the 149 kidnapped victims, 24 were children, 7 females and 1 security personnel. Further analysis reveals that the North-West and North-Central recorded the highest number with 58 and 52 kidnapped victims. The South-South accounted for 21 kidnapped victims while the South-East, South-West and North-East recorded the lowest figures of 9, 8 and 1 respectively.

AFFECTED LOCATIONS

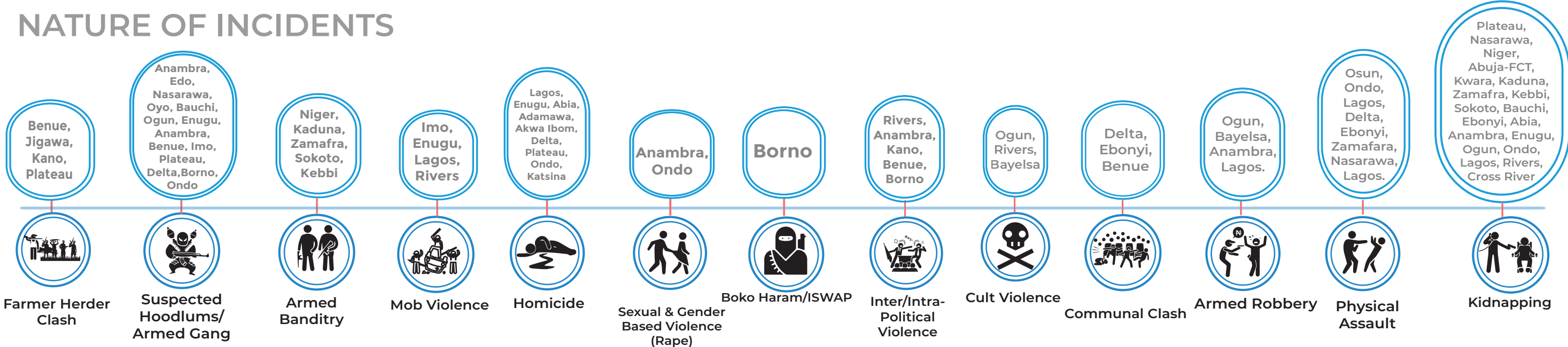


FATALITIES PER REGION (207)
