**Scale of incident: Low**

**Date of Occurrence: 13/11/2022**

**Description of Incident:** A military officer was reportedly abducted in an attack carried out by hoodlums suspected to be members of the Indigenous People of Biafra (IPOB) in Anambra State. Kidnapping for ransom has largely been attributed as the motive behind the criminality in the State.

**Location:** Anambra State.

**Casualty [Male&female]:** One military officer abducted.

**Property damaged/Affected population:** No property damaged/military officer.

**Coping Mechanism/Responses:** The security operatives have been deployed to rescue the abducted victim and apprehend the perpetrators of the crime.

#### **Incident N\*02:**

**Title of Incident: ARMED ACTION**

**Scale of incident: Low**

**Date of Occurrence: 13/11/2022**

**Description of Incident:** The operatives of the Nigerian Army reportedly killed several suspected armed bandits and several others injured in a shootout with suspected armed bandits at Kankomi Axis in Chikun LGA of Kaduna State. Arms and ammunition were reportedly recovered in the incident.

**Location:** Kankomi Axis in Chikun LGA of Kaduna State.

**Casualty [Male&female]:** Several suspected armed badits killed, several bandits injured.

**Property damaged/Affected population:** Several weapons recovered/suspected armed bandits.

**Coping Mechanism/Responses:** There is an ongoing security clearance operation in the affected area to counter armed bandits attack.

**Location:** Gwagwada-Chikun-Sarkin Pawa Axis in Chikun LGA of Kaduna State.

**Casualty [Male&female]:** One suspected armed bandit killed.

**Property damaged/Affected population:** No property damaged/suspected armed bandit.

**Coping Mechanism/Responses:** There is an ongoing security clearance operation to counter armed bandits' attack in the State.
