- **♣ Date of Occurrence:** 16/10/2022
- **Description of Incident:** The operatives of the Nigeria Army reportedly killed six (6) suspected Boko Haram members in a security clearance operation along Kumshe-Banaki Axis at Banki Town in Bama LGA of Borno State.
- Location: Kumshe-Banaki Axis at Banki Town in Bama LGA of Borno State.
- Casualty [Male&female]: Six suspected Boko Haram members killed.
- **Property damaged/Affected population:** No property damaged/suspected terrorists.
- **Coping Mechanism/Responses:** There is an ongoing security clearance operation to counter terrorist activities in the State.
