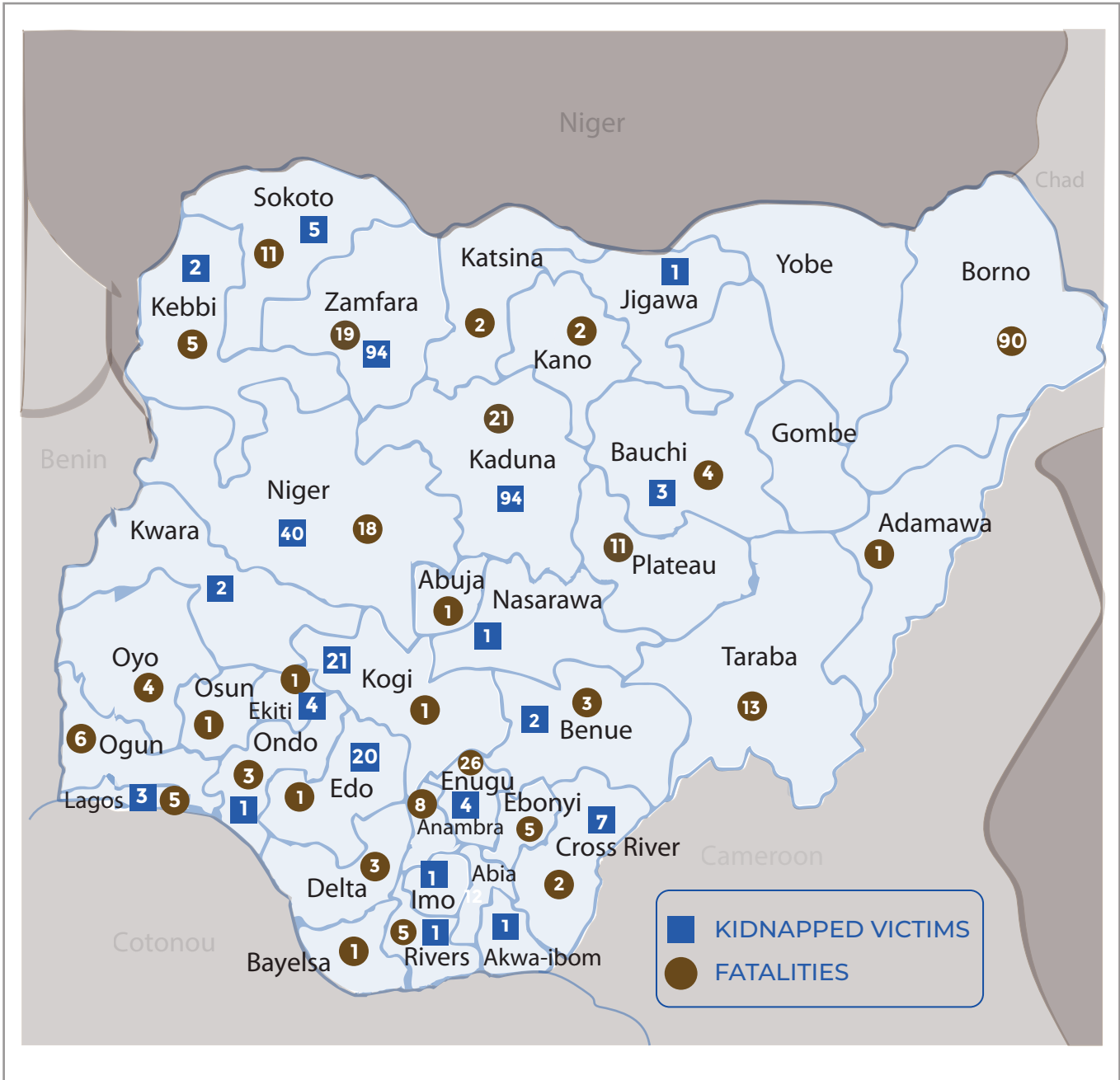
SUMMARY

The situation report, which provides a bi-weekly update on armed violence incidents and casualties in Nigeria, documented multiple security threats including terrorist-related attacks, banditry, kidnapping, violent clashes including cult-clash, land-related disputes, as well as sexual and gender-based violence (SGBV), particularly rape in the reporting period.

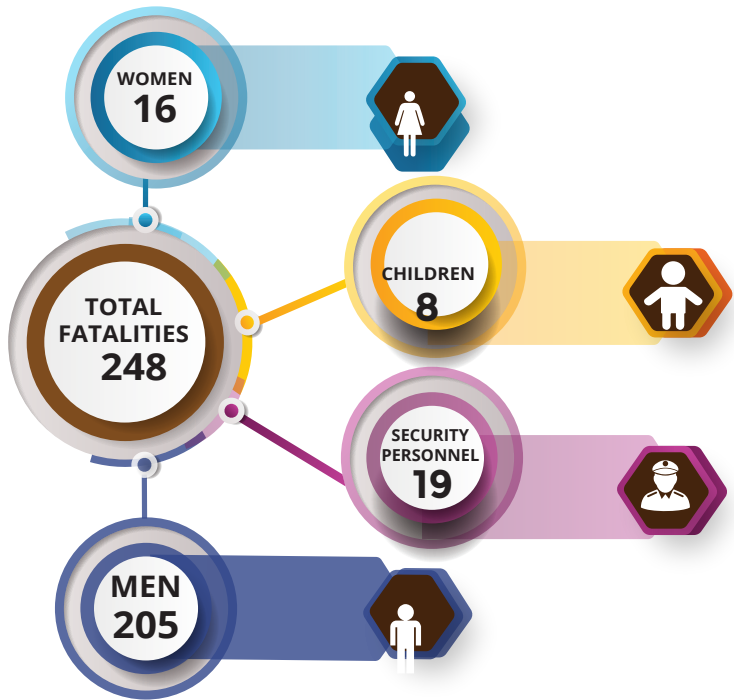
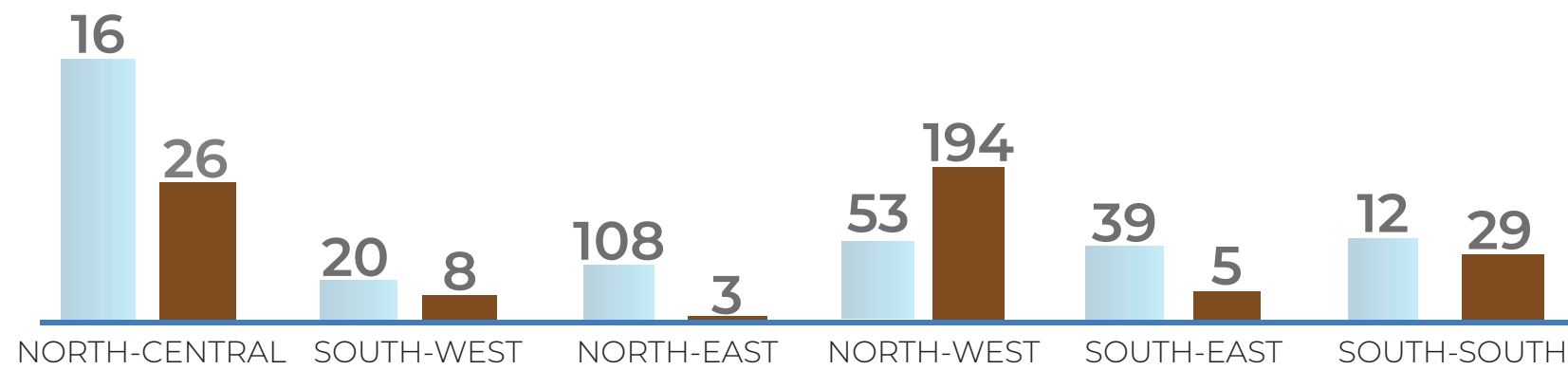
Within the reporting period, a total of 111 armed violence incidents were recorded with 129 injuries and 248 fatalities including 16 women, 8 children and 19 security personnel. The North-East accounted for the highest fatality of 108, while the North-West and South-East recorded 53 and 39 deaths respectively. The period under review recorded an increase in fatalities (248) compared to the period of November 1-15, 2022, with 207 recorded fatalities. Non-state armed actors are not included in the statistics of recorded fatalities.

The WANEP NEWS also recorded 32 incidents of kidnapping across 18 States with 265 people abducted in the reporting period. Out of the 265 kidnapped victims, 73 were women and 9 children. Further analysis reveals that the North-West accounted for the highest number with 194 kidnapped victims, while the South-South and the North-Central recorded 29 and 26 kidnapped victims. The South-West, South-East and North-East recorded the lowest figures of 8, 5 and 3 respectively.
