- **Description of Incident:** Thirty-seven (37) people were allegedly killed with over 100 houses and motorcycles burnt down in separate attacks carried out by suspected armed bandits in Malagum 1 and Sokwong Communities of Kagoro Chiefdom, Kaura Local Government Area (LGA) of Kaduna State.
- **Location:** Malagum 1 and Sokwong Communities of Kagoro Chiefdom in Kaura LGA of Kaduna State.
- Casualty [Male&female]: Thirty-seven people killed.
- **♣ Property damaged/Affected population:** 100 houses an dmotorcycles burnt down/community members.
- **Coping Mechanism/Responses:** The security operatives have been deployed to the affected area to strengthen peace and security and apprehend the perpetrators of the crime
