- Scale of incident: Low
- Date of Occurrence: 27/11/2022
- **Description of Incident:** The State Police Command reportedly confirmed the abduction of a 3-year-old girl by a 12-year-old male resident at Kara aAea of Magama Gumau Community in Toro LGA of Bauchi State. Kidnapping for ransom has largely been attributed as the motive behind the criminality in the State.
- Location: Kara Area of Magama Gumau Community in Toro LGA of Bauchi State.
- Casualty [Male & female]: One female child abducted.
- Property damaged/Affected population: No property damaged/community residents.
- Coping Mechanism/Responses: The operatives of the State Police Command have arrested the suspect in connection with the crime.

- Title of Incident: ARMED ACTION
- Scale of incident: Low
- ₽ Date of Occurrence: 27/11/2022
- Description of Incident: The Kaduna State Government confirmed the killing of four (4) suspected bandits by operatives of the Nigerian Army in a raid on the armed bandit's hideout at Tsohon Gaya Axis in Chikun LGA of Kaduna State. Arms and ammunition were recovered in the incident.
- Location: Tsohon Gaya Axis in Chikun LGA of Kaduna State.
- Casualty [Male & female]: Four males killed.
- Property damaged/Affected population: No property damaged/Suspected armed bandits.
- Coping Mechanism/Responses: There is an ongoing security clearance operation to counter armed bandits' attack in the State.

- Property damaged/Affected population: No property damaged/commuters.

- Description of Incident: The officials of the National Drug Law Enforcement Agency (NDLEA) reportedly arrested a total of sixteen (16) suspected drug peddlers including one (1) female during security raids across communities in Lagos, Ogun, Edo, Katsina, Rivers, Ekiti. Sokoto, Oyo, Ondo and the FCT-Abuja. At least 5,851.3kg of Indian Hemp and several quantities of cocaine, tramadol, methamphetamine, amongst others, were recovered from the suspects.

- Casualty [Male & female]: No reported casualty, fifteen people arrested.

An undisclosed number of community residents were internally displaced following the series of coordinated attacks in the LGA.
- Location: Eha-Amufu, Agu-Amede, Mgbuji and Umujiovu-Eboh Communities in Isi-Uzo LGA of Enugu State.
- Casualty [Male & female]: Three males killed.
- Property damaged/Affected population: No property damage reported/community residents.
- Coping Mechanism/Responses: The operatives of security agencies have been deployed to the affected area to maintain peace and security.

- Description of Incident: The operatives of the Nigerian Army reportedly rescued nine (9) kidnapped victims during a security raid on bandit' hideouts at Tantatu High Ground in Chikun LGA of Kaduna State. Preliminary investigations have revealed that the victims were abducted by suspected armed bandits at Gurara Dam Axis of Kaduna State. 90 rustled cattle and four (4) motorcycles were recovered in the incident.
- Location: Tantatu High Ground in Chikun LGA of Kaduna State.
- Casualty [Male & female]: No reported casualty, nine abducted victims rescued.
- Property damaged/Affected population: No property damaged/community residents.

- Coping Mechanism/Responses: There is an ongoing security clearance operation to counter terrorists' attacks in the State.
