- Title of Incident: ABDUCTION/ARREST
- Scale of incident: Low
- **Date of Occurrence:** 4/12/2022
- **Description of Incident:** Two (2) security guards were reportedly abducted in an attack carried out by suspected kidnappers at Jeje JiJipe Village in Karu LGA of Nasarawa State. Kidnapping for ransom has largely been attributed as the motive behind the criminality in the State.
- Location: Jeje JiJipe Village in Karu LGA of Nasarawa State.
- Casualty [Male&female]: Two security guards abducted.
- **♣ Property damaged/Affected population:** No property damaged/security guards.
- **Coping Mechanism/Responses:** The swift response of security operatives led to the arrest and rescue of the abducted victims.

Incident N*02:

- **Title of Incident: ARMED ATTACK BY SUSPECTED ARMED HERDERS**
- **Scale of incident:** Low
- Date of Occurrence: 4/12/2022
- → **Description of Incident:** A male resident was reportedly killed in an attack carried out by suspected armed herders on a farmland at Obelle Community in Emohua LGA of Rivers State. Preliminary investigations have revealed that the attack is alleged to be a reprisal over the killing of twenty (20) cows in the community.

- **Coping Mechanism/Responses:** The security operatives have been deployed to apprehend the perpetrators of the crime.
