- Scale of incident: Low
- **♣ Date of Occurrence:** 1/1/2023
- Description of Incident: Three (3) people including an erstwhile Commandant of the Zamfara State Road Traffic Regulatory Agency and his two children were allegedly abducted in an attack carried out by suspected armed bandits along Gusau-Tsafe Road in Tsafe LGA of Zamfara State. Kidnapping for ransom has largely been attributed as the motive behind the criminality in the State.
- **Location:** Gusau-Tsafe Road in Tsafe LGA of Zamfara State.
- **Casualty [Male&female]:** Three males including two children abducted.
- Property damaged/Affected population: No property damaged/community members.
- Coping Mechanism/Responses: The security operatives have been deployed to rescue the abducted victims and apprehend the perpetrators of the crime.

Incident N*02:

- **■** Title of Incident: MURDER/ARSON/ABDUCTION
- Scale of incident: Low
- **♣ Date of Occurrence:** 1/1/2023
- Description of Incident: Two (2) people were allegedly killed and set ablaze in an attack carried out by unidentified gunmen at their residence at Ibara Area in Abeokuta LGA of Ogun State. The attackers also abducted their son and domestic staff. Further investigations have revealed that the abducted son was found dead in a river while their domestic staff escaped with injuries in the incident.

- **Casualty [Male&female]:** Three people (2 males and 1 female), one female injured.
- **Property damaged/Affected population:** No property damaged/community members.
- **Coping Mechanism/Responses:** The security operatives have been deployed to apprehend the perpetrators of the crime.

Kidnapping for ransom has largely been attributed as the motive behind the criminality in the State.
