- Description of Incident: A catholic priest was reportedly burnt to death with one (1) other injured in an attack carried out by suspected armed bandits along Daza Road in Kafin-Koro Area, Paikoro Local Government Area (LGA) of Niger State.
- Location: Daza Road in Kafin-Koro Area, Paikoro Local Government Area (LGA) of Niger State.
- Casualty [Male&female]: One male killed, one male injured.
- Property damaged/Affected population: No property damaged/Christian clerics.
- Coping Mechanism/Responses: The security operatives have been deployed to strengthen peace and security in the affected area.
