Title of Incident: ARMED ATTACK/ABDUCTION BY SUSPECTED ARMED BANDITS

Scale of incident: Medium

Date of Occurrence: 25/12/2022

Description of Incident: One (1) person was allegedly killed and 53 others abducted in an attack carried out by suspected armed bandits at Angwan Aku Village in Kajuru LGA of Kaduna State. Kidnapping for ransom has largely been attributed as the motive behind the criminality in the State.

Location: Angwan Aku Village in Kajuru LGA of Kaduna State.

Casualty [Male&female]: One male killed, fifty-three people abducted.

Property damaged/Affected population: No property damaged/community members.

Coping Mechanism/Responses: The security operatives have been deployed to rescue the abducted victims and apprehend the perpetrators of the crime. Also, seven (7) out of the 53 abducted victims escaped from captivity.

Scale of incident: Low

Date of Occurrence: 25/12/2022

Description of Incident: The operatives of the State Police Command reportedly killed two (2) suspected kidnappers durinh security clearance operation at Mountainous Area in Ngalga Village of Adamawa State.

Location: Mountainous Area in Ngalga Village of Adamawa State.

Casualty [Male&female]: Two suspected kidnappers killed.

Property damaged/Affected population: No property damaged/suspected kidnappers.

Coping Mechanism/Responses: There is an ongoing security clearance in the affected area to apprehend others kidnappers.
