Title of Incident: ARSON BY SUSPECTED HOODLUMS

Scale of incident: Low

Date of Occurrence: 8/1/2023

Description of Incident: Suspected hoodlums reportedly burnt down Umuchu Police Station along Umuchu-Achina Road in Aguata Local Government Area (LGA) of Anambra State.

Location: Umuchu-Achina Road in Aguata LGA of Anambra State.

Casualty [Male&female]: No casualty reported.

Property damaged/Affected population: Several properties destroyed/police officers.

Coping Mechanism/Responses: The security operatives have been deployed to apprehend the perpetrators of the crime.

Date of Occurrence: 8/1/2023

Description of Incident: Twelve (12) security operatives including operatives of the Nigeria Security and Civil Defence Corps (NSCDC), Nigerian Police Force (NPF), Nigerian Army and local vigilantes were allegedly killed and one (1) officer injured in an attack carried out by suspected armed bandits in Brinin-Gwari LGA of Kaduna State.

Location: Brinin-Gwari LGA of Kaduna State.

Casualty [Male&female]: Twelve security operatives killed.

Property damaged/Affected population: No property damaged/security operatives.

Coping Mechanism/Responses: The security operatives have been deployed to the affected area to strengthen peace and security.

Title of Incident: COMMUNAL CLASH

Scale of incident: Low

Date of Occurrence: 8/1/2023

Description of Incident: A farmer was allegedly killed and one (1) other injured in a violent clash between farmers and herders in Eshijiko Axis of Pada district in Pategi LGA of Kwara State. A Fulani settlement was reportedly set ablaze by angry youths in reprisal attack. Preliminary investigations have revealed that skirmishes occurred when a farmer instructed herders grazing on his farmland to leave.

Casualty [Male&female]: One male killed, one male injured.

Property damaged/Affected population: Fulani settlement (RUGA) set ablaze/community members.

Coping Mechanism/Responses: The security operatives have been deployed to the affected area to strengthen peace and security.
