Date of Occurrence: 22/1/2023

Description of Incident: One (1) person was reportedly abducted and fifteen (15) cows shot dead in an attack carried out by suspected hoodlums at a cattle ranch in Awba-Ofemili Area of Awka North LGA of Anambra State. Kidnapping for ransom has largely been attributed as the motive behind the crime.

Location: Awba-Ofemili Area in Awka North LGA of Anambra State.

Casualty [Male&female]: One male abducted.

Property damaged/Affected population: Fifteen cows killed/community resident.

Coping Mechanism/Responses: The security operatives have been deployed to rescue the abducted victim apprehend the perpetrators of the crime.

Date of Occurrence: 22/1/2023

Description of Incident: The operatives of the Nigerian Air Force (NAF) reportedly killed several suspected armed bandits during airstrikes at their hideouts in Tshohon Kabula Community, Munya LGA of Niger State.



As of 25 January, 2023, a total of 65,679,094 COVID-19 vaccine doses have been administered in Nigeria. The National Primary Health Care Development Agency (NPHCDA) continues to vaccinate residents with the approved Johnson & Johnson, AstraZeneca and Moderna COVID-19 vaccines in Nigeria.
