- **Title of Incident: ABDUCTION**
- **Scale of incident:** Low
- **♣** Date of Occurrence: 19/2/2023
- **Description of Incident:** Two (2) people including the ward chairman of the People's Democratic Party (PDP) and a community leader were reportedly abducted in an attack carried out by suspected armed bandits at Dan Mahawayi Community in Giwa LGA of Kaduna state.
- Location: Giwa LGA of Kaduna state
- **Casualty [Male&female]:** Two males abducted.
- Property damaged/Affected population: No property damaged/party members.
- Coping Mechanism/Responses: The security operatives have been deployed to rescue the abducted victims and apprehend the perpetrators of the crime.

Incident N*02:

- **Title of Incident: ARMED ACTION**
- Scale of incident: Low
- **Date of Occurrence:** 19/2/2023
- Description of Incident: The operatives of the Nigerian Army reportedly killed five (5) suspected hoodlums in a shootout at a Police Divisional Headquarters at Nkwelle-Ezunaka Area in Oyi LGA of Anambra State. A police officer was also reportedly killed while repelling the attack.
 - One vehicle, Ak47 rifles, charms and other items were recovered from the attackers.
- **Location:** Nkwelle-Ezunaka Area in Oyi LGA of Anambra State.
- **Casualty [Male&female]:** Five suspected hoodlums killed, one police officer killed.
- ♣ Property damaged/Affected population: No property damaged/suspected hoodlums.
- Coping Mechanism/Responses: The security operatives have been deployed to strengthen peace and security in the affected area.

Incident N*03:

- **Title of Incident: ARMED ATTACK BY SUSPECTED HOODLUMS**
- Scale of incident: Medium
- Date of Occurrence: 20/2/2023
- → Description of Incident: Seven (7) people including four (4) police officers and three (3) suspected hoodlums were reportedly killed in a shootout between security operatives and suspected hoodlums during an attack on Awada Police station in Idemili North LGA of Anambra State. Preliminary investigation have revealed that the attackers were repelled by security operatives in an attempt to set the police station ablaze.

 Two (2) AK-47 rifles recovered in the incident.
- Location: Idemili North LGA of Anambra State.
- **Casualty [Male&female]:** Seven people including four police officers and three suspected hoodlums killed.
- **♣ Property damaged/Affected population:** Two AK-47 rifles recovered/suspected hoodlums and police officers.
