🚩 Date of Occurrence: 19/3/2023

🚩 Description of Incident: The wife of a Muslim cleric was reportedly murdered by suspected armed bandits in Rugan Ardo Area of Kaduna State. Further investigations have revealed that the victim was abducted weeks ago by armed bandits.

🚩 Location: Rugan Ardo Area of Kaduna State.

🚩 Casualty [Male&female]:One female killed.

🚩 Property damaged/Affected population: No property damaged/community resident.

🚩 Coping Mechanism/Responses: The security operatives have been deployed to apprehend the perpetrators of the crime.

Preliminary investigations have revealed that the clash occurred after a female police officer who was reporting for duty her duty post at the Independent National Electoral Commission (INEC) state headquarters was stopped by military operatives at a checkpoint for oidentification.

✚ **Location:** Jalingo Metropolis of Taraba State.

✚ **Casualty [Male&female]:** Two police officers killed,three security officers injured.

✚ **Property damaged/Affected population:** No property damaged/security operatives.

✚ **Coping Mechanism/Responses:** The security operatives have been deployed to the affected area to strengthen peace and security,while investiagtions are onging to unravel the motive behind the attack.
