Description of Incident: Thirteen (13) people were allegedly killed in an attack carried out by suspected armed herders at separate locations in Tse-Lgar, Tse-Magu and Tse Dudu in Guma LGA of Benue State. The motive behind the attack is unknown.

Location: Tse-Lgar, Tse-Magu and Tse Dudu in Guma LGA of Benue State.

Casualty [Male&female]: Thirteen males killed.

Property damaged/Affected population: No property damaged/community members.

Coping Mechanism/Responses: The security operatives have been deployed to forstall futher attack in the area and apprehend the perpetrators of the crime.
