- Scale of incident: Medium
- **Date of Occurrence:** 16/4/2023
- Description of Incident: Seven (7) people including a female were reportedly abducted in an attack carried out by suspected kidnappers at Owukpa Community in Ogbadibo LGA of Benue State. Kidnapping for ransom has been attributed as the motive behind the crime.
- Location: Owukpa Community in Ogbadibo LGA of Benue State.
- **Casualty [Male & female]:** Seven people (6 males, 1 female) abducted.
- Property damaged/Affected population: No property damaged/community residents.
- Coping Mechanism/Responses: The operatives of the State Police Command have been deployed to rescue the abducted victims and arrest the perpetrators of the crime.

Incident N*2:

- Title of Incident: ABDUCTION
- Scale of incident: Low
- **Date of Occurrence:** 16/4/2023
- Description of Incident: An official of the Ogun State Traffic Compliance and Enforcement Corps (TRACE) was reportedly abducted in an attack carried out by unknown gunmen at Eledumare-Fidiwo Axis along the Lagos-Ibadan Road in Obafemi Owode LGA of Ogun State. The motive behind the kidnap is unknown.
- **Location:** Eledumare-Fidiwo Axis along the Lagos-Ibadan Road in Obafemi Owode LGA of Ogun State.
- **Casualty [Male & female]:** One male abducted.
- Property damaged/Affected population: No property damaged/Official of TRACE.
- Coping Mechanism/Responses: The operatives of the State Police Command have been deployed to rescue the abducted victim and arrest the perpetrators of the crime.

- Title of Incident: ARMED ATTACK BY SUSPECTED GUNMEN
- Scale of incident: Low
- **Date of Occurrence:** 16/4/2023
- Description of Incident: Several community residents were reportedly killed and several others injured in an attack carried out by suspected gunmen at Mai Tumbi Community in Mangu LGA of Plateau State. Hundreds of community residents were internally displaced with several houses set ablaze in the incident.
- **Location:** Mai Tumbi Community in Mangu LGA of Plateau State.
- Casualty [Male & female]: Several people killed, several people injured.
- **Property damaged/Affected population:** Several houses damaged/community residents.
- Coping Mechanism/Responses: The operatives of the State Police Command have been deployed to strengthen peace and security in the affected area. Also, the injured victims have been taken to the hospital for medical treatment.

The erstwhile NBA president was abducted and his vehicle stolen by the suspects.
- Location: Jephtha East West Road in Obio-Akpor LGA of Rivers State.
- Casualty [Male & female]: Two males killed, two males injured, one male abducted.
