Date of Occurrence: 02/04/2023

Description of Incident: The operatives of the Economic and Financial Crimes Commission (EFCC) reportedly arrested seventeen (17) suspected internet fraudsters following their involvement in cybercrime at Makurdi LGA in Benue State. Two (2) vehicles and other incriminating exhibits were recovered from the suspects.

Location: Makurdi LGA in Benue State.

Casualty [Male & female]: No casualty reported.

Property damaged/Affected population: No property damaged/Suspected internet fraudsters.

Coping Mechanism/Responses: The arrested suspects are in the custody of the EFCC for further interrogation.

Date of Occurrence: 02/04/2023

Description of Incident: The operatives of the State Police Command reportedly arrested five (5) suspected members of a criminal gang for robbery, illicit drug peddling and illegal possession of firearms at Ise- Ekiti in Ise/Orun LGA of Ekiti State. Two (2) firearms, ammunition and Indian hemp were recovered.

The attackers also destroyed about 50 houses in the incident.

🚩 **Location:** Oganenigwu Community in Dekina LGA of Kogi State.

🚩 **Casualty [Male & female]:** Eight people killed.

🚩 **Property damaged/Affected population:** Several houses destroyed/Community members and the APC Ward chairman

🚩 **Coping Mechanism/Responses:** The operatives of security agencies have been deployed to affected area to strengthen peace and security.
