🚩 Date of Occurrence: 9/4/2023

🚩 Description of Incident: The operatives of the National Drug Law Enforcement Agency (NDLEA) reportedly arrested three (3) suspected drug traffickers in Kaduna and Lagos State. Several consignments of illicit drugs were impounded and recovered from the suspects.

🚩 Location: Kaduna and Lagos State.

🚩 Casualty [Male & female]: No casualty reported.

🚩 Property damaged/Affected population: No properties destroyed/Suspected drug traffickers.

🚩 Coping Mechanism/Responses: The arrested suspects are in the custody of the NDLEA for further investigations.
