Incident N*1:

Title of Incident: ARMED ATTACK BY SUSPECTED CULT GANG

Scale of incident: Low

Date of Occurrence: 23/4/2023

Description of Incident: A community resident was reportedly killed and three (3) others injured in an attack carried out by a suspected cult gang at Omoda Community in Moro LGA of Kwara State. Revenge attack and supremacy tussle has been attributed as the motive behind the crime.

Location: Omoda Community in Moro LGA of Kwara State.

Casualty [Male & female]: One male killed, three males injured.

Property damaged/Affected population: No property damaged/community residents and suspected cultists.

Coping Mechanism/Responses: The operatives of the State Police Command have been deployed to strengthen peace and security.

Incident N*2:

Title of Incident: ARMED ACTION/ABDUCTION

Scale of incident: Low

Date of Occurrence: 23/4/2023

Description of Incident: A suspected kidnapper was reportedly killed and two (2) other kidnappers arrested by operatives of the State Police Command and the Department of State Services (DSS) at Ebonyi LGA of Ebonyi State. An abducted victim was reportedly rescued by security operatives in the incident. Arms, ammunition and 2 vehicles were recovered from the suspects.

Location: Ebonyi LGA of Ebonyi State.

Casualty [Male & female]: One male suspect killed.

Property damaged/Affected population: No property damaged/suspected kidnappers and community resident.

Coping Mechanism/Responses: The arrested suspects are in the custody of the State Police Command for further interrogation.

Incident N*3:

Title of Incident: ARMED ATTACK BY SUSPECTED ARMED GANG

Scale of incident: Medium

Date of Occurrence: 23/4/2023

Description of Incident: Twelve (12) people were reportedly killed and seven (7) others injured in separate attacks carried out by a suspected armed gang across communities in Barkin Ladi and Riyom LGAs of Plateau State. Several properties were destroyed by the suspects. The motive behind the attack is unknown.

Location: Barkin Ladi and Riyom LGAs of Plateau State.

Casualty [Male & female]: Twelve people killed, seven people injured.

Property damaged/Affected population: Several properties destroyed/community residents.

Coping Mechanism/Responses: The operatives of the State Police Command have been deployed to strengthen peace and security in the area.

Title of Incident: HOMICIDE

Scale of incident: Low

Description of Incident: An elderly community resident was reportedly killed by community youths at Ikyve Community in Konshisha LGA of Benue State. Preliminary investigations has revealed that allegations of witchcraft were leveled against the deceased.

Location: Ikyve Community in Konshisha LGA of Benue State.

Casualty [Male & female]: One male killed.

Property damaged/Affected population: No property damaged/community resident.

Coping Mechanism/Responses: The operatives of the State Police Command have been deployed to the area and two (2) suspects arrested for further interrogation.

Incident N*5:

Title of Incident: VIOLENT CLASH

Scale of incident: Low

Date of Occurrence: 24/4/2023

Description of Incident: Several persons were reportedly injured in a violent clash following a misunderstanding between commercial tricycle operators of Hausa and Gbagyi ethnicity at Gwarimpa Community in Abuja-FCT. The cause of the clash is unknown.

Location: Gwarimpa Community in Abuja-FCT.

Casualty [Male & female]: Several people injured.

Property damaged/Affected population: No property damage reported/commercial tricycle operators.

Coping Mechanism/Responses: The operatives of the State Police Command have been deployed to strengthen peace and security in the affected community.

Incident N*6:

Title of Incident: ARMED ATTACK BY SUSPECTED CULT GANG

Scale of incident: Low

Date of Occurrence: 23/4/2023

Description of Incident: A community resident was reportedly killed and several others injured in an attack carried out by suspected cult gang at Awkuzu/Lumbumber Street, Mile 1 Diobu in Port Harcourt LGA of Rivers State. The suspects also reportedly robbed community residents and motorists of their valuables.

Location: Awkuzu/Lumbumber Street, Mile 1 Diobu in Port Harcourt LGA of Rivers State.

Casualty [Male & female]: One male killed, several people injured.

Property damaged/Affected population: No property damage reported, several valuables stolen/community residents and motorists.

Coping Mechanism/Responses: The operatives of the State Police Command have been deployed to apprehend the perpetrators of the crime.

Incident N*7:

Title of Incident: SHOOTING

Scale of incident: Low

Date of Occurrence: 23/4/2023

Description of Incident: A commercial motorcyclist was reportedly killed by a member of a local vigilante group at Alagbaka Area in Akure North LGA of Ondo State. The motive behind the shooting is unknown.

Location: Alagbaka Area in Akure North LGA of Ondo State.

Casualty [Male & female]: One male killed.

Property damaged/Affected population: No property damaged/commercial motorcyclist.

Coping Mechanism/Responses: The State Police Command has commenced investigations to ascertain the motive behind the shooting.

Description of Incident: Three (3) people including two females were reportedly abducted in an attack carried out by suspected kidnappers at Ogbakiri Junction along the East-West Road in Emohua LGA of Rivers State. Kidnapping for ransom has been attributed as the motive behind the crime. One of the victims is the Federal Commissioner of the National Population Commission (NPC) for Bayelsa State.

Location: Ogbakiri Junction along the East-West Road in Emohua LGA of Rivers State.

Casualty [Male & female]: Three people (1 male, 2 females) abducted.

Property damaged/Affected population: No property damaged/community residents.

Coping Mechanism/Responses: The operatives of the State Police Command have been deployed to rescue the victims and apprehend the suspects.

Incident N*9:

Title of Incident: ARMED ATTACK BY SUSPECTED LAND GRABBERS

Scale of incident: Low

Date of Occurrence: 24/4/2023

Description of Incident: A community resident was reportedly injured in an attack carried out by suspected land grabbers at FESTAC Area in Amuwo-Odofin LGA of Lagos State. Several properties belonging to the victim were allegedly destroyed in the attack.

Location: FESTAC Area in Amuwo-Odofin LGA of Lagos State.

Casualty [Male & female]: One male injured

Property damaged/Affected population: Several properties damaged/community resident.

Coping Mechanism/Responses: The operatives of the State Police Command have been deployed to strengthen peace and security at the affected area.

Title of Incident: ARMED ATTACK/ARMED ROBBERY

Scale of incident: Low

Date of Occurrence: 23/4/2023

Description of Incident: A farmer was reportedly killed and eight (8) others injured in an attack carried out by suspected hoodlums at Ago Oyinbo Axis in Ala Forest Reserve, Akure North LGA of Ondo State. The attackers also stole several mobile phones belonging to the farmers in the incident.

Location: Ago Oyinbo Axis in Ala Forest Reserve, Akure North LGA of Ondo State.

Casualty [Male & female]: One male killed, eight people injured.

Property damaged/Affected population: No property damaged/farmers.

Coping Mechanism/Responses: The operatives of the State Police Command have been deployed to the affected area to strengthen peace and security.

Incident N*11:

Title of Incident: VIOLENT CLASH

Scale of incident: Low

Date of Occurrence: 24/4/2023

Description of Incident: One (1) person was reportedly injured in a violent clash among commercial bus drivers at Okela Community, Ikare Akoko in Akoko North-East LGA of Ondo State. The attack occurred following a misunderstanding among commercial drivers.

Location: Okela Community, Ikare Akoko in Akoko North East LGA of Ondo State.

Casualty [Male & female]: One male injured.

Property damaged/Affected population: No property damage reported/community residents and commercial bus operators.

Coping Mechanism/Responses: The operatives of the State Police Command have been deployed to strengthen peace and security in the affected area. Also, the injured victim has been taken to the hospital for medical treatment.

 **Casualty [Male & female]:** Two males abducted.


 **Property damaged/Affected population:** No property damaged, one vehicle stolen/community residents and suspected kidnappers


 **Coping Mechanism/Responses:** The operatives of the State Police Command have rescued the abducted victims. Also, the State Police Command has commenced investigation to apprehend the fleeing suspects. 26 mobile phones, arms, ammunition and a stolen vehicle, amongst others were also recovered from the suspects.

 **Description of Incident:** One (1) person was reportedly killed and several others injured in an attack carried out by suspected hoodlums at Minna Axis in Chachanga LGA of Niger State. Several stores were reportedly looted and valuables stolen in the attack.

 **Location:** Minna Axis in Chachanga LGA of Niger State.

 **Casualty [Male & female]:** One male killed.


 **Property damaged/Affected population:** Several properties damaged and stolen/community residents and suspected hoodlums.


 **Coping Mechanism/Responses:** The operatives of the State Police Command have arrested 37 suspects in connection with the crime.

 **Location:** Abayawo Area in Ilorin East LGA of Kwara State.

 **Casualty [Male & female]:** One male killed.


 **Property damaged/Affected population:** No property damaged/commercial tricycle operator.


 **Coping Mechanism/Responses:** The State Police Command have commenced investigations to apprehend the perpetrators of the crime.

Incident N*15:

 **Title of Incident: VIOLENT EXTREMIST ATTACK/ARMED ATTACK BY SUSPECTED TERRORISTS**

 **Scale of incident:** Low

 **Date of Occurrence:** 24/4/2023

 **Description of Incident:** Three (3) operatives of the Nigerian Army were reportedly killed and several others injured following the explosion of an Improvised Explosive Device (IED) allegedly planted by suspected Boko Haram terrorists along Damask-San San Road in Borno State. An Armoured Personnel Carrier (APC) and several military weapons were destroyed in the incident.

Coping Mechanism/Responses: There is an ongoing security clearance operation by military operatives to rescue the abducted victims.

Casualty [Male & female]: One male killed, several males injured.

Coping Mechanism/Responses: The operatives of the State Police Command have been deployed to strengthen peace and security in the affected area.
